SECTION ASSEMBLY: REFER TO QUILT DIAGRAM WHILE PIECING SECTIONS.

1. Section 1: **(make 1)** Sew (1) **F** 1-1/2" X 40-1/2" strip to each side of (1) **A** 10-1/2" X 40-1/2" rectangle. Square to 12-1/2" X 40-1/2".

For Sections 2-7, sew following pieces together along the 5-1/2" side, and then proceed with additional directions as noted.

2. Section 2 (make 2): D 5-1/2" X 10-1/2" rectangle – **F** 1-1/2" X 5-1/2" strip – **E** 3-1/2" X 5-1/2" rectangle – **F** 1-1/2" X 5-1/2" xtrip – **B** 5-1/2" X 10-1/2" rectangle – **F** 1-1/2" X 5-1/2" strip – **E** 3-1/2" X 5-1/2" rectangle - **F** 1-1/2" X 5-1/2" strip – **D** 5-1/2" X 10-1/2" rectangle, then sew (1) **F** 1-1/2" X 40-1/2" strip to left or right side.

- **3. Section 3 (make 2): C** 5-1/2" X 18" rectangle **F** 1-1/2" X 5-1/2" strip **D** 3-1/2" X 5-1/2" rectangle **F** 1-1/2" X 5-1/2" strip **C** 5-1/2" X 18" rectangle. Square to 6-1/2" X 40-1/2".
- **4. Section 4: (make 1) A** 5-1/2" X 15" rectangle **F** 1-1/2" X 5-1/2" strip **D** 3-1/2" X 5-1/2" rectangle **F** 1-1/2" X 5-1/2" strip **A** 5-1/2" X 15" rectangle, then sew (1) **F** 1-1/2" X 34-1/2" strip to bottom. Square to 5-1/2" X 40-1/2".
- **5.Section 5:** (make 1) A 5-1/2" X 15" rectangle **F** 1-1/2" X 5-1/2" strip **D** 3-1/2" X 5-1/2" rectangle **F** 1-1/2" X 5-1/2" strip **A** 5-1/2" X 15" rectangle, then sew (1) **F** 1-1/2" X 34-1/2" strip to top. Square to 6-1/2" X 34-1/2".
- **6. Section 6 (make 2): E** 5-1/2" X 26" rectangle **F** 1-1/2" X 5-1/2" strip **E** 5-1/2" X 26" rectangle, then sew (1) **F** 1-1/2" X 52-1/2" strip to left or right side. Square to 6-1/2" X 52-1/2",
- **7. Section 7 (make 2): B** 5-1/2" square **F** 1-1/2" X 5-1/2" strip **E** 5-1/2" X 17" rectangle **F** 1-1/2" X 5-1/2" strip **E** 5-1/2" X 17" rectangle **F** 1-1/2" X 5-1/2" strip **B** 5-1/2" square, then sew (1) **F** 1-1/2" X 46-1/2" strip to top or bottom. Square to 6-1/2" X 46-1/2".

QUILT ASSEMBLY: REFER TO QUILT DIAGRAM FOR PROPER PLACEMENT AND ROTATION.

- **8.** Sew (1) **SECTION 2** to each side of **SECTION 1**, then sew (1) **SECTION 3** to each side.
- **9.** Sew **SECTION 4** to top, then sew **SECTION 5** to bottom.
- **10**. Sew (1) **SECTION 6** to each side, then sew (1) **SECTION 7** to top and bottom.

BORDER ASSEMBLY: *MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF QUILT TOP TO ENSURE BORDER CUTTING SIZES. BELOW ARE OUR MEASUREMENTS.*

11. Sew (1) **F** 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " X (64 $\frac{1}{2}$ ") strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) **F** 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " X (48 $\frac{1}{2}$ ") strip to top and bottom.

FINISHING: Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. Quilt as desired. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.
