1 yard	Floral Vine - Red (C)	8272-88
3/4 yard	Petite Nosegay - Cream/Red (D)	8275-48
3/4 yard	Pin Stripe - Cream (E)	8276-44
⅓ yard	Floral Vine - Taupe (F)	8272-34
1 1/8 yards	Jacobean Vine - Cream (G)	8273-44
1 ½ yards	Pin Stripe - Lt. Red (H)	8276-88*

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Petite Nosegay - Red (A), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (9) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- (8) 2" x WOF strips.

From the Tossed Buds - Taupe (B), cut:

- (8) 2" x WOF strips.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (7) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Floral Vine - Red (C), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (6) 4 ½" squares.
- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (10) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- (5) 4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (41) 4" squares.

From the Petite Nosegay - Cream/Red (D), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (7) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- (5) 4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (41) 4" squares.

From the Pin Stripe - Cream (E), cut:

- (2) 2" x 36 ½" WOF strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut (2) 2" x 45 ½" strips.
- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut (2) 2 ½" x 56 ½" strips.
- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut (2) 2 ½" x 48 ½" strips.

From the Floral Vine - Taupe (F), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (7) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (46) 2" squares.

From the Jacobean Vine - Cream (G), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (8) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- (8) 1 ³/₄" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (184) 1 ³/₄" squares.
- (8) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (184) 1 3/4" x 2" strips.

From the Pin Stripe - Lt. Red (H), cut:

- (16) 1 ³/₄" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (368) 1 ³/₄" squares.
- (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Tossed Buds - Red (I), cut:

• (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (9) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Floral Vine - Cream (J), cut:

• (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (7) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Jacobean Vine - Taupe (K), cut:

• (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 4 ½" squares and (5) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Jacobean Vine - Red (L), cut:

• (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (10) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Tossed Buds - Cream (M), cut:

• (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (5) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Petite Nosegay - Cream (N), cut:

• (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (5) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Pin Stripe - Dk. Red (O), cut:

• (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (11) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.


From the Jacobean Vine - Cream (Backing), cut:

• (2) 64" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 64" x 76" back.



Sewing Instructions


1. Sew (1) 2" x WOF Fabric A strip and (1) 2" x WOF Fabric B strip together, lengthwise, to make (1) AB strip set (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (8) AB strip sets total. Sub-cut the strips sets into (166) 2" x 3 ½" AB units (Fig. 2).




2. Sew (2) AB units together to make (1) AB block (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (83) AB blocks total.




3. Place (1) 4" Fabric C square on top of (1) 4" Fabric D square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 4). Sew ¼" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 4). Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 5) to make two CD blocks (Fig. 6). Trim the CD blocks to measure 3 ½" square. Repeat to make (82) CD blocks total.




4. Place (1) 1 ³/₄" Fabric H square on the left side of (1) 1 ³/₄" x 2" Fabric G strip, right sides together (Fig. 7). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 7). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 8). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¹/₄" seam allowance.



5. Place another 1 ¾" Fabric H square on the right side of the 1 ¾" x 2" Fabric G strip, right sides together (Fig. 9). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 9). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 10). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance to make one HGH unit.



- 6. Repeat to make (184) HGH units total.
- 7. Sew (4) 1 3/4" Fabric G squares, (4) HGH units and (1) 2" Fabric F square together to make (1) F-block (Fig. 11). Repeat to make (46) F-blocks total.



Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

- 8. Sew (6) AB blocks and (5) CD blocks together, alternating them, to make Row One. Repeat to make Rows Three, Five, Seven, Nine, Eleven, Thirteen and Fifteen.
- 9. Sew (6) CD blocks and (5) AB blocks together, alternating them, to make Row Two. Repeat to make Rows Four, Six, Eight, Ten, Twelve and Fourteen.
- 10. Sew the fifteen rows together, in numerical order, to make the center block.
- 11. Sew (1) 2" x 45 ½" Fabric E strip to each side of the center block. Sew (1) 2" x 36 ½" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the center block.
- 12. Sew (12) F-blocks together to make (1) strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) strip to each side of the center block.

- 13. Sew (11) F-blocks together to make (1) strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the center block.
- 14. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 56 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to each side of the center block. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 48 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the center block.
- 15. Sew (14) assorted 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips together, lengthwise, to make (1) strip. Repeat to make (4) strips total. Sew (1) strip to each side of (1) 4 ½" Fabric K square to make (1) side border. Repeat to make a second side border. Sew (1) border to each side of the center block.
- 16. Sew (11) assorted 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips together, lengthwise, to make (1) border strip. Repeat to make (4) border strips total.

- 17. Sew (3) 4 ½" Fabric C squares (2) border strips together, alternating them, to make the top border. Repeat to make the bottom border. Sew the borders to the center block to make the quilt top.
- 18. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 19. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric H strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 20. Bind as desired.
