Flower Show

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following for Wall Quilt:

Refer to thumbnails on pattern cover for Fabrics A-E used in this design.

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, the panel has a coping border added then trimmed so the panel will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of panel to approximately 22-1/2" x 41-1/2"

Fabric B - Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Cut (4) 2" strips, subcut (2) 2" x 26" borders

Fabric C - Cut (1) 3" strip, subcut (1) 3" x 21" strip

Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips

Fabric D - Cut (4) 3" strips

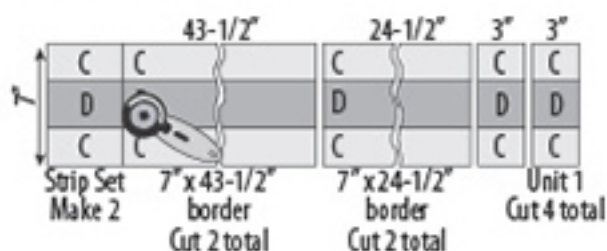
Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 2-1/2" x 21" strips

2. Piecing Order for Wall Quilt:

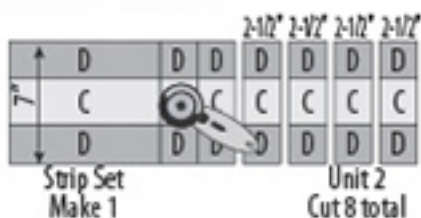
1. Stitch 2 **Fabric C** 2-1/2" x width of fabric strips together end to end. Make a total of 4.

2. Stitch 2 **Fabric D** 3" x width of fabric strips together end to end. Make a total of 2.

3. Sew a double-length **Fabric D** 3" strip between 2 **Fabric C** 2-1/2" double-length strips. Make a second strip set. Subcut each into (1) 7" x 43-1/2" border, (1) 7" x 24-1/2" border, and (2) 3" x 7" Unit 1.



4. Sew a **Fabric C** 3" x 21" strip lengthwise between 2 **Fabric D** 2-1/2" x 21" strips. Subcut into (8) 2-1/2" x 7" Unit 2.



5. Sew a Unit 1 between 2 Unit 2. Make a total of 4 blocks (7" square unfinished).

6. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of panel, borders, and blocks

7. Stitch **Fabric B** 2" x width of fabric strips to sides of the **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 2" x 26" **Fabric B** strips to top and bottom of panel. *Trim bordered panel to 24-1/2" x 43-1/2" (unfinished).*

8. Stitch **Fabrics C** and **D** 7" x 43-1/2" borders to right and left sides of bordered panel. Sew blocks to short ends of **Fabrics C** and **D** 7" x 24-1/2" borders then add to top and bottom of quilt.

9. The quilt measures approximately 37-1/2" x 56-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric E**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

10. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric B**) and enjoy!!

3. Cut the following for Throw Quilt:

Refer to thumbnails on pattern cover for Fabrics A-K used in this design.

Fabric A - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 9-3/4" x 82" and (2) 9-3/4" x 66" multi-stripe borders

Fabric B - Cut (1) 8-1/2" strip, subcut (1) 8-1/2" square and (5) 4-1/2" squares
Cut (1) 4-1/2" strip, subcut (9) 4-1/2" squares

Fabric C - Cut (1) 4-1/2" strip, subcut (16) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips

Fabric D - Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips (binding)
Cut (3) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (48) 2-1/2" squares

Fabric E - Cut (1) 4-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 4-1/2" squares

Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut (16) 2-1/2" squares

Fabric F - Cut (1) 2-7/8" strip, subcut (12) 2-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally for a total of 24 triangles

Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (40) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces and (24) 2-1/2" squares

Fabric G - Cut (1) 4-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 4-1/2" squares and (8) 2-1/2" squares

Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut (16) 2-1/2" squares

Fabric H - Cut (1) 2-7/8" strip, subcut (12) 2-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally for a total of 24 triangles

Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (32) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces and (24) 2-1/2" squares

Fabric I - Cut (2) 2-7/8" strips, subcut (24) 2-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally for a total of 48 triangles

Cut (3) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (40) 2-1/2" squares
Cut (5) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into 2" x 56-1/2" and 2" x 43-1/2" borders

Fabric J - Cut (4) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (56) 2-1/2" squares

4. Piecing Order for Throw Quilt:

1. Arrange 1 **Fabric E** 4-1/2" square, 4 **Fabric E** 2-1/2" squares, and 4 **Fabric H** 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together.

Make a total of 4 **Block 1a** (8-1/2" square unfinished).



2. In the same manner, make the number of **Blocks 1b-1d** listed with fabrics indicated.



Block 1b - Make 10



Block 1c - Make 4



Block 1d - Make 4

3. Stitch **Fabrics H** and **I** 2-7/8" triangles together along their long edges. Make a total of 24 **Unit 1** (2-1/2" square finished). In the same manner, make 24 **Unit 2** with fabrics indicated.



4. Arrange **Fabrics D, F, G,** and **H** 2-1/2" squares and 2 each **Units** and 2 (**U1** and **U2**) in 4 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 12 **Block 2** (8-1/2" square unfinished).



5. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of blocks, **Fabric B** square, and borders.

6. Arrange blocks and **Fabric B** 8-1/2" square into 7 rows. Sew into rows. Stitch rows together to complete quilt center (40-1/2" x 56-1/2" unfinished).

7. Stitch **Fabric I** 2" x 56-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric I** 2" x 43-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

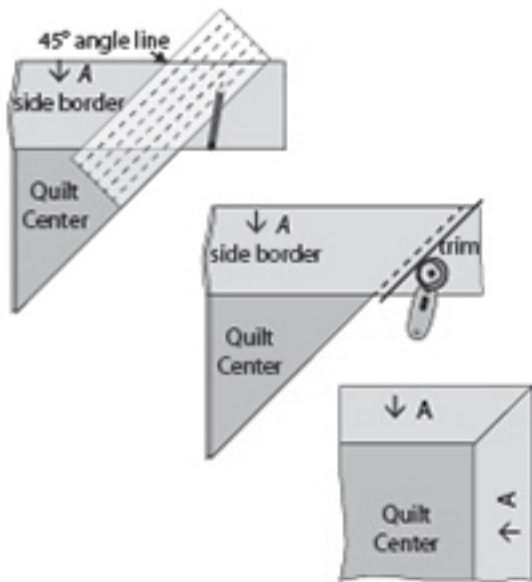
8. Center **Fabric A** 9-3/4" x 82" borders on right and left sides of quilt center and **Fabric A** 9-3/4" x 66" borders on top and bottom of quilt center with the flower stripe next to quilt center. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out.



Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric. Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

9. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



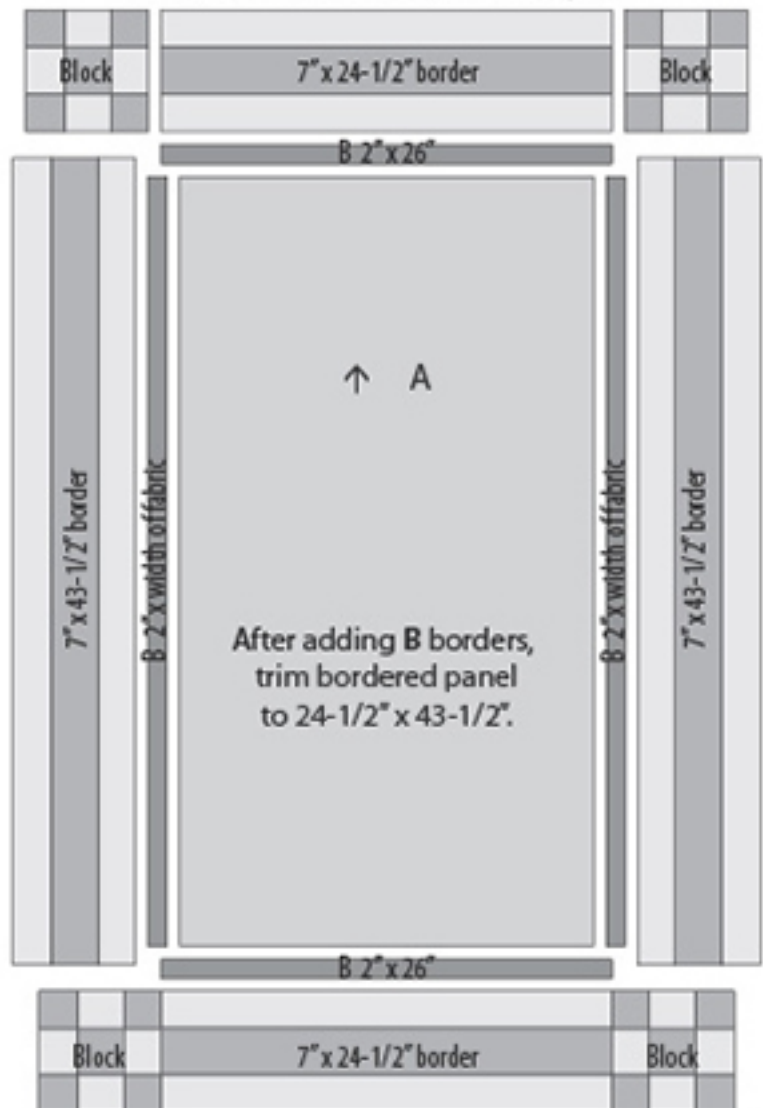
10. The quilt measures approximately 62" x 78" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric K**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

11. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric D**) and enjoy!!

Arrow indicates orientation of directional print.

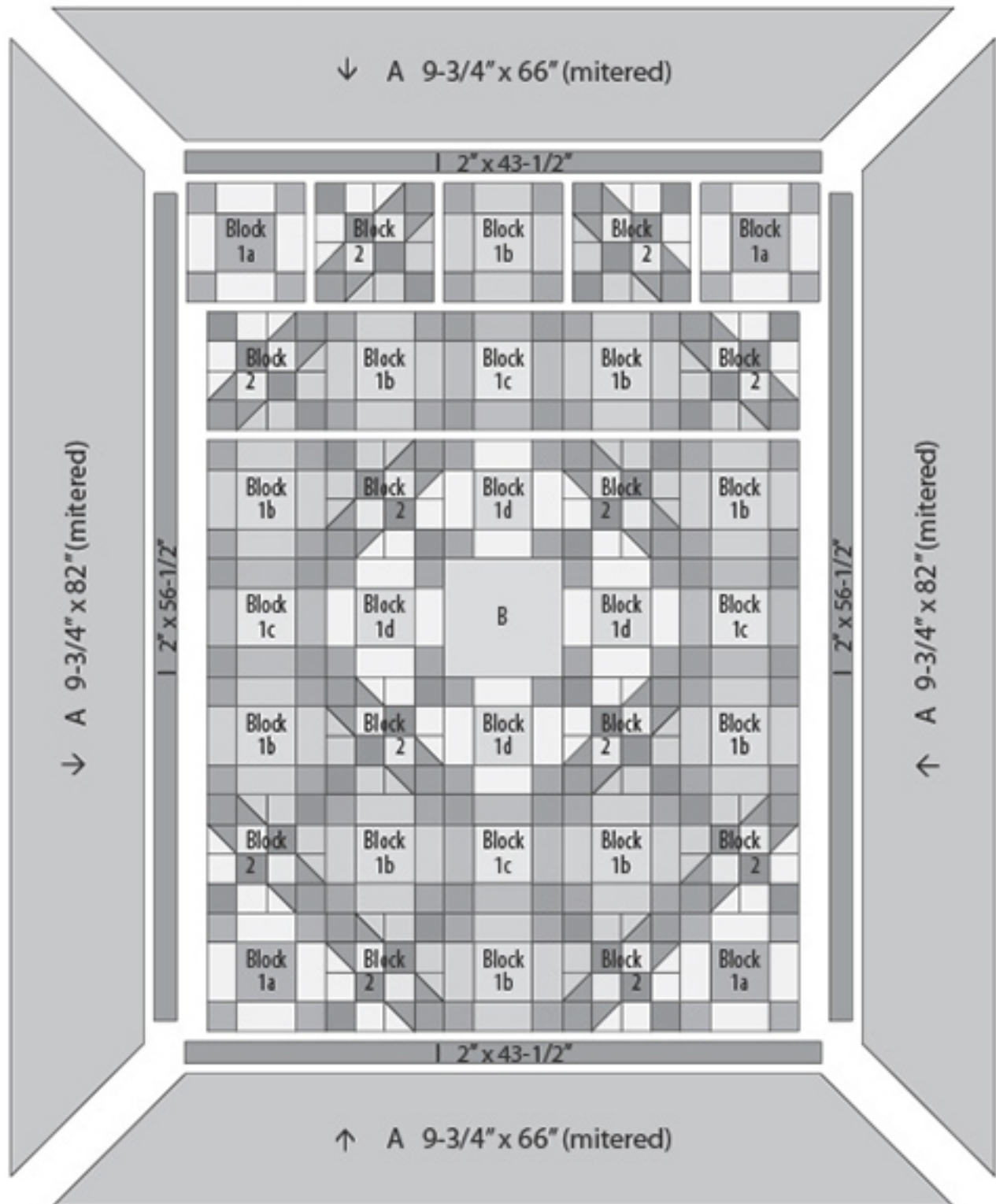

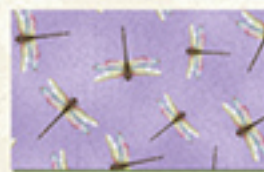

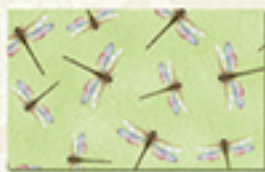
