## Birds of a Feather Block

Unfinished Block Size: 12 ½" x 12 ½"

### FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

- When doing appliqué it is better to start with a larger block and trim to 12 %" x 12 %" when finished.
- 1 square 13" x 13" from white solid (C100-01 Clean White) for background
- 1 square 10" x 12" from aqua small dot
- (C350-20 Aqua) for bird
- 1 square 7 1/2" x 4" from gray tone on tone small chevron (C400-41 Gray) for wing
- 1 square 4" x 4" from orange tone on tone small dot (C420-60 Orange) for legs and eye
- Optional: button for eye


### ASSEMBLY REQUIREMENTS


- Trace all templates onto freezer paper or use regular paper templates. Trace bird, wing, 2 legs and eye onto right side of fabric. This tracing line becomes your sewing line. Trim ¼" to ½" from the traced line. Clip curves and cleavage.
- 2. Find the center of the background fabric by folding in fourths. Press.
- 3. Center the bird, wing, 2 legs and eye.
- 4. Glue in place.
- 5. Use your favorite method of appliqué.
- 6. Trim block to 12 ½" x 12 ½" unfinished. Press.



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### CINDY'S TEMPLATE

#### Instructions:

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Center bird on the 13" square fabric. With favorite method of applique begin sewing on template 1 and finish with template 11. Trim down to 12.5" x 12.5" square block.
