## What can I do with a 5 " square?

1


Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side.

2


Place 2-5"x 5 " right side together

3


Place 2 "pieced" charms right side together (nest seams)


Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ on each side of the line.


Stitch a scant $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam on outside edges Cut in half


Stitch a scant $1 / 4$ " seam on outside edges Cut in half


Cut apart on the diagonal line.


Press open to make 2 "pieced" charms $41 / 2$ "x 5 " with seams


Press open to make 2 half square triangles. 4112 "x $41 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ with seams

Cutting your own 5 " squares:
$1 / 4$ yard $=8$ squares
1 fat quarter $=12$ squares
$1 / 2$ yard $=24$ squares
$3 / 4$ yard $=40$ squares
1 yard $=56$ squares

Press open to make 2-4 patch blocks $41 / 2$ "x $41 / 2$ " with seams

Easy corner triangles


Use a scrap saver ruler.
