## Charm Thursday

## Size: $65^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x} 78^{\prime \prime}$

- All instructions include a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance.
light 150 dark 120
- 22 " measurement is approximate. WOF-approximately 42".


## Fabric requirements:*

7 Charm packs or 13-light fat quarters
10-dark fat quarters
Binding $5 / 8$ yard
Backing $51 / 2$ yards

## Cutting:

Light squares
from 30 cut $120-2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime x} 2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Dark charm squares
from 120 cut $240-2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime x} 5^{\prime \prime}$
Binding: cut $8-2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF

Just 1 block makes this charm quilt fun to do. Sew $1-2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ dark rectangle to $1-5^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ light charm square. Make 120. Sew $1-2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ dark rectangle to $1-2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\frac{1}{2}} 2^{\prime \prime}$ light charm square. Make 120. Combine the units to make 120 pieced blocks.


2 Sew 12 pieced blocks together to make one column. Press in one direction. Make 10 columns. Join the columns, flipping the alternating columns. Layer, quilt as desired and bind. ENJOY!



[^0]:    *The number of squares and the number of light and dark fabrics in a charm pack varies with each collection. The "charm" of a charm quilt is the mix of fabrics and value. For the fabric requirements we are assuming charm square packs have $40-5 " x 5$ " squares and an equal mix of light and dark fabrics. Fabric requirements are also given for fat quarters. From each fat quarter cut 3-5"x $22^{\prime \prime}$ strips then cut $12-5 " x 5$ " squares. All that said, let's make a quilt!
