Scrappy Heart Fabric Requirements Quilted In Honor Version Using Island Batiks

Quilt - 52" x 68"

Heart Squares:

Approximately 3/4 yards of assorted non-neutral Quilted in Honor SKUs (includes fabric for the HSTs)

Background fabric: 1 1/4 yards (includes fabric for the HSTs) Choose from NO09-NA, NC28-02, KP02-1US, US02-3, US03-4

Sashing and Borders:

2 yards of assorted non-neutral Quilted in Honor SKUs Light colored background fabric – 2 3/4 yards choose from NO09-NA, NC28-02, KP02-1US, US02-3, US03-4


Binding: 1/2 yard

Optional Color Ways for making a scrappy (2) color quilt using the Island Batik collection.

Camo greens, browns & neutrals Reds and Neutrals Blues and Neutrals


Make (12) heart blocks:






Fabric Requirements:

Squares to be cut from the Island Batiks fabric collection.



(120) assorted colored 2.5" squares



(216) background 2.5" squares

(96) 2.5" HSTs in various color per block

Cutting Directions:

Cut a good supply of 2.5" squares from the Island Batiks. It is always nice to have a little stash of these squares.

You can make your background scrappy too with squares of light, neutral colored fabrics.

Making HSTs:

There is a little more waste with this method but it is easier to make the quilt more scrappy.

You will be using one background 2.5" square and one colored 2.5" square per HST.

This method only yields (1) half square triangle per square background/scrap colored square combination..

Draw a diagonal line through the center back of the background HST.


Notice that you are sewing ON the diagonal line.

Place squares right side together.

Sew on the diagonal line.

Trim 1/4" from diagonal line on one side.

Press to the dark.






Assemble your block:

Lay out the pieces for your block in rows according to the diagram. You will have six rows.

Press each row in alternating directions so you can nest the seams.

Sew your rows together. Press down or up.

Sashing and Borders:

2 yards of assorted non-neutral Quilted in Honor SKUs Light colored background fabric – 2 3/4 yards choose from NO09-NA, NC28-02, KP02-1US, US02-3, US03-4

Cutting Directions:


First Cut	Then Cut
(9) 2.5" by Width of Fabric strips	(See directions below for piecing borders.)
(8) 2.5" by Width of Fabric strips	(120) 2.5" squares
(1) 12.5" by Width of Fabric strip	(18) 1.5" by 12.5" strips.
	Cut one of these strips into (6) 1.5" squares.
(2) 2" by Width of Fabric strips	
(21) 2.5" by Width of Fabric strips	(328) 2.5" squares

Step 1:

Sew 1.5" by 12.5" sashing strips between blocks.

Make (4) rows.

Press to the sashing strips.




Step 2:

Sew 1.5" by 12.5" sashing strips together with 1.5" squares.

Make (3) rows.

Press to the squares.

Step 3: Sew your rows of hearts alternating with sashing rows. Press to the sashing rows.



Add Border #1.

Step 4:

Piece side borders.

You need (2) that are 2.5" by 51.5"

Sew to the sides of the quilt.


Press to the borders.

Sew top and bottom borders.

Sew a 2" by 42.5" strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt.

Press to the strips.

Top and Bottom Borders 2" by 42.5"



Side Borders 2.5" by 51.5"

Add border #2.

Step 5:


Side Borders:

Sew (4) rows of (27) 2.5" squares together according to the diagram. Press, alternating the direction of the seams in each row. Sew to quilt and press to the inner borders.

Top and Bottom Borders:

Sew (4) rows of (29) 2.5" squares together according to the diagram. Press, alternating the direction of the seams in each row. Sew to quilt and press to the inner borders.


Make sure red squares are in each of the 4 corners.



Add Border 3.

Piece side borders. You need (2) that are 2.5" by 70.5". Sew to the sides of the quilt. Press to the outside borders.

Piece top and bottom borders. You need (2) that are 2.5" by 62.5".



Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press to the outside borders.
