# Enduring Grace

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

## 1. Cut the following:

**Fabric A** - Cut (1) 60-1/2" strip, referring to the quilt image fussy cut the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 8" x 60-1/2" and (2) 8" x 53" multi-stripe outer borders

Cut (1) 38" strip, referring to the quilt image fussy cut the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 5-1/4" x 38" floral stripe and (2) 2-1/2" x 36" vine stripe inner borders

**Fabric B** - Cut (1) 11-7/8" strip, subcut (2) 11-7/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally twice  for 8 triangles] and (2) 6-1/4" squares [then cut 1 in half diagonally  and 1 in the opposite direction  for 4 triangles]

Cut (1) 8" strip, subcut (4) 8" squares

**Fabric C** - Cut (1) 3-3/8" strip, subcut (10) 3-3/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally  for 20 triangles] and (4) 1-3/4" x 3" pieces

Cut (1) 3" strip, subcut (3) 3" squares and (16) 1-3/4" x 3" pieces

**Fabric D** - Cut (2) 3-3/8" strips, subcut (20) 3-3/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for 40 triangles

Cut (2) 3" strips, subcut (3) 3" squares and (40) 1-3/4" x 3" pieces

**Fabric E** - Cut (2) 3-3/8" strips, subcut (14) 3-3/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally  for 28 triangles] and (18) 1-3/4" x 3" pieces

Cut (1) 3" strip, subcut (7) 3" squares and (10) 1-3/4" x 3" pieces

**Fabric F** - Cut (1) 3-3/8" strip, subcut (8) 3-3/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for 16 triangles

Cut (1) 3" strip, subcut (3) 3" squares and (16) 1-3/4" x 3" pieces

**Fabric G** - Cut (2) 3-3/8" strips, subcut (16) 3-3/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally  for 32 triangles] and (14) 1-3/4" x 3" pieces

Cut (1) 3" strip, subcut (3) 3" squares and (18) 1-3/4" x 3" pieces

**Fabric H** - Cut (1) 3-3/8" strip, subcut (12) 3-3/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for 24 triangles

Cut (2) 3" strips, subcut (3) 3" squares and (24) 1-3/4" x 3" pieces

**Fabric I** - Cut (1) 3-3/8" strip, subcut (12) 3-3/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for 24 triangles

Cut (2) 3" strips, subcut (1) 3" square and (24) 1-3/4" x 3" pieces

**Fabric J** - Cut (1) 3-3/8" strip, subcut (8) 3-3/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for 16 triangles

Cut (1) 3" strip, subcut (4) 3" squares and (16) 1-3/4" x 3" pieces

**Fabric K** - Cut (2) 3-3/8" strips, subcut (22) 3-3/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for 44 triangles

Cut (3) 3" strips, subcut (5) 3" squares and (44) 1-3/4" x 3" pieces

**Fabric L** - Cut (1) 3-3/8" strip, subcut (8) 3-3/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for 16 triangles

Cut (1) 3" strip, subcut (4) 3" squares and (16) 1-3/4" x 3" pieces

**Fabric M** - Cut (2) 3-3/8" strips, subcut (14) 3-3/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally  for 28 triangles] and (10) 1-3/4" x 3" pieces

Cut (1) 3" strip, subcut (3) 3" squares and (18) 1-3/4" x 3" pieces

Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 2-1/2" x 35" strips

Cut (7) 1-3/4" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 1-3/4" x 75-1/2" and (2) 1-3/4" x 70-1/2" borders


Cut (2) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 1-1/2" x 33" strips

**Fabric N** - Cut (1) 3-3/8" strip, subcut (12) 3-3/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for 24 triangles

Cut (1) 3" strip, subcut (24) 1-3/4" x 3" pieces

## 2. Piecing Order:

1. Arrange (1) **Fabric C** 3" square, (4) 3-3/8 **Fabric C** triangles, (4) 1-3/4" x 3" **Fabric C** pieces, (4) 3-3/8 **Fabric K** triangles, and (4) 1-3/4" x 3" **Fabric K** pieces as shown.



Sew each **Fabric C** triangle to a **Fabric K** triangle (unfinished 3" square).




Sew a **Fabric C** 1-3/4" x 3" piece to each 1-3/4" x 3" **Fabric K** piece (unfinished 3" square).



Arrange all the units in 3


rows of 3. Sew units and square into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 2

Block 1 (unfinished 8" square).





3. Refer to Quilt Center Layout (below) and Quilt Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of blocks, setting triangles, and borders.

4. Arrange 9 blocks on-point in 3 rows of 3. Place 8" **Fabric B** squares between blocks, 11-7/8" **Fabric B** triangles along outside edges, and 6-1/4" **Fabric B** triangles in corners.

Sew triangles, blocks and squares into diagonal rows. Sew the diagonal rows together to complete quilt center (unfinished size approximately 32-1/4" square).

*Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.*

5. Stitch a **Fabric M** 1-1/2" x 33" strip to right and left sides of quilt center. Trim strip ends. Add 2-1/2" x 35" **Fabric M** strips to top and bottom of quilt center. Trim bordered quilt center to 34" x 36".

6. Sew a **Fabric A** 2-1/2" x 36" border to right and left sides of quilt. Add 5-1/4" x 38" **Fabric A** borders to top and bottom.

7. Arrange blocks around quilt center, reserving (4) Block 19 for the borders. Sew the 6 blocks on each side together into rows then sew rows to sides. Stitch the 7 blocks on top of quilt together then sew to top of quilt. Repeat with the bottom row of blocks.

8. Sew an 8" x 60-1/2" **Fabric A** border to right and left sides of quilt. Sew a Block 19 to both ends of each of the 8" x 53" **Fabric A** borders. Sew these to top and bottom of quilt.

9. Stitch 1-3/4" x 75-1/2" **Fabric M** strips to right and left sides, then 1-3/4" x 70-1/2" **Fabric M** strips to top and bottom of quilt.


10. The quilt measures approximately 70-1/2" x 78" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric L**) at least 8" larger than the top.

11. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric M**) and enjoy!!




