

Indigo Nature

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - Referring to the guilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (1) 6" x 48-1/2", (1) 6" x 22-3/4", (1) 6" x 18-1/2", (1) 6" x 14-3/4", and (1) 6" x 12-1/2" daisy stripe and (1) 4-1/4" x 31-1/4", (1) 4-1/4" x 24-3/4", (2) 4-1/4" x 22", and (1) 4-1/4" x 9-1/2" bug stripe Fabric B - Cut (9) 5-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 5-1/2" x 88-3/4" and (2) 5-1/2" x 87-1/2" borders Fabric C - Cut (1) 4-7/8" strip, subcut (1) 4-7/8", (1) 4-5/8", and (1) 3-7/8" squares [each cut in half diagonally // for 6 triangles] and (1) 4-1/2" x 13-3/4" strip Cut (1) 4-1/4" strip, subcut (1) 4-1/4" x 15-1/4" and (1) 3-1/2" x 20-1/2" strips **Fabric D** - Cut (1) 6-3/8" strip, subcut (3) 6-3/8" and (2) 4-7/8" squares [each cut in half diagonally for 10 triangles] and (1) 6" square Cut (2) 4-1/2" strips, subcut (1) 4-1/2" x 24-1/2", (1) 4-1/2" x 21-3/4", (1) 3-1/2" x 19", and (1) 3-1/2" x 7-3/4" strips and (2) 3-7/8" squares [cut in half diagonally // for 4 triangles] Fabric E - Cut (1) 6-3/8" strip, subcut (2) 6-3/8", (3) 4-5/8", and (2) 3-7/8" squares [each cut in half diagonally // for 14 triangles] and Cut (1) 6" strip, subcut (1) 6" x 17", (1) 3-1/2" x 15-1/4", and (1) 3-1/2" x 7-3/4" strips Fabric F - Cut (1) 6-3/8" strip, subcut (2) 6-3/8" and (1) 4-7/8" squares [each cut in half diagonally for 6 triangles] and (1) 4-1/2" x 22" Cut (1) 6" strip, subcut (1) 6" x 22-1/2" and (1) 6" x 14-1/2" strips **Fabric G** - Cut (1) 6-3/8" strip, subcut (1) 6-3/8", (1) 4-7/8", (1) 4-5/8", and (1) 3-7/8" squares [cut each square in half diagonally // for 8 triangles] Cut (1) 6" strip, subcut (1) 6" x 21-3/4" and (1) 3-1/2" x 15-1/2" strips Cut (2) 4-1/2" strips, subcut (1) 4-1/2" x 16-1/2",

(1) 4-1/2" x 18-1/2" and (1) 4-1/4" x 14-1/2" strips

  (1) 4-7/8", and (1) 4-5/8" squares [each cut in half

 Cut (2) 6" strips, subcut (1) 6" x 21-1/2",
  (1) 6" x 20-1/2", (1) 6" x 11", (1) 6" x 9-1/2",
  (1) 6" x 7", and (1) 4-1/2" x 14" strips
Cut (1) 4-7/8" strip, subcut (2) 4-7/8"
  and (2) 3-7/8" squares [each cut in half
  diagonally for 8 triangles]
Cut (1) 4-1/2" strip, subcut (1) 4-1/2" x 11-1/4" and
  (1) 2-1/4" x 25-3/4" strips and (1) 2-1/4" square
 Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (1) 3-1/2" x 33" and

Fabric J - Cut (1) 6-3/8" strip, subcut (1) 6-3/8" and
  (1) 3-7/8" squares [cut in half diagonally // for
  4 triangles] and (1) 6" x 31-1/4" strip
 Cut (1) 6" strip, subcut (1) 6" x 14" and
  (1) 3-1/2" x 21-1/2" strips and (1) 3 7/8" square
  [cut in half diagonally for 2 triangles]
Fabric K - Cut (1) 4-7/8" strip, subcut (2) 4-7/8",
  (1) 4-5/8", and (3) 3-7/8" squares [each cut
  in half diagonally for 12 triangles]
Cut (2) 4-1/2" strips, subcut (1) 4-1/2" x 23-1/4",
  (1) 4-1/2" x 17-3/4", (1) 4-1/2" x 13-1/2", and
  (1) 4-1/4" x 14-3/4" strips
Cut (2) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 3-1/2" x 22-3/4",
  (1) 3-1/2" x 14-3/4" and (1) 3-1/2" x 8-1/4" strips
Fabric L - Cut (1) 7-1/2" strip, subcut (1) 7 1/2" x 10"
   piece and (1) 6-3/8", (1) 4-7/8", and (1) 3-7/8"
  squares [each cut in half diagonally // for 6
  triangles]
 Cut (1) 6" strip, subcut (1) 6" x 32" strip
Cut (1) 4-1/2" strip, subcut (1) 4-1/2" x 15-1/2"
  and (1) 3-1/2" x 14-3/4" strips

Fabric M - Cut (1) 6-3/8" strip, subcut (1) 6-3/8", (1) 4-7/8", (1) 4-5/8", and (1) 3-7/8" squares [each cut in half diagonally for 8 triangles] and (1) 6" x 13-1/2" strip

Cut (1) 4-1/2" strip, subcut (1) 4-1/2" x 24-1/4" strip Cut (1) 4-1/4" strip, subcut (1) 4-1/4" x 23-1/2" strip

Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (1) 3-1/2" x 32-3/4" strip

Fabric N - Cut (1) 6-3/8" strip, subcut (1) 6-3/8",

(1) 4-7/8", and (1) 3-7/8" squares [each cut in half diagonally // for 6 triangles] and (1) 6" square

Cut (1) 6" strip, subcut (1) 6" x 16-1/2" and (1) 6" x 12-3/4" strips

Cut (1) 4-1/2" strip, subcut (1) 4-1/2" x 26" strip

Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (1) 3-1/2" x 24-1/4" strip

Cut (10) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Cut (8) 1-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 1-1/2" x 85-1/2" and

(2) 1-1/2" x 78-3/4" borders

Fabric O - Cut (1) 6-3/8" strip, subcut (1) 6-3/8", (2) 4-7/8", and (4) 4-5/8" squares [each cut in half diagonally / for 14 triangles]

Cut (1) 6" strip, subcut (1) 6" x 11-1/4" and

(1) 4-1/2" x 19-1/2" strips and (1) 3-7/8" square [cut in half diagonally // for 2 triangles]

Cut (2) 4-1/2" strips, subcut (1) 4-1/2" x 41-1/2",

(1) 4-1/2" x 14-1/2", (1) 4-1/2" x 12-1/2", and

(1) 4-1/4" x 14-1/2" strips


Cut (2) 4-1/4" strips, subcut (1) 4-1/4" x 16-1/4",

(1) 4-1/4" x 11-1/4", (1) 4-1/4" x 8",

(1) 4-1/4" x 7-3/4", and (1) 3-1/2" x 20" strips


2. Piecing Order:

1. Stitch 6-3/8" triangles together to make the following triangle sets (unfinished 6" square).



NOTE: Not all cut triangles will be used.

2. Stitch 4-7/8" triangles together to make the following triangle sets (unfinished 4-1/2" square).



3. Stitch 4-5/8" triangles together to make the following 4-1/4" 0 triangle sets Make 2 Make 2 Make 1 Make 4

4. Stitch 3-7/8" triangles together to make the

following triangle sets (unfinished 3-1/2" square).

5. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of the 2-1/4" Fabric I, 6" Fabric D, and 6" Fabric N squares.



Place the marked Fabric I square right sides together on Fabric E corner of a 6" E/I triangle set. Sew on marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4".

Press triangle out to finish Unit 1 (6" square unfinished).

Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

7. In the same manner add triangles to opposite

corners of the 7-1/2" x 10" Fabric L piece using 6" Fabrics D and N triangles.





- 8. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of strips, triangle sets, units and borders.
- 9. Arrange strips, triangle sets, and units in vertical rows. Sew pieces above and below Units 1 and 2 together then sew to Unit 1 or Unit 2. Sew pieces within all other rows together. Sew rows together.
- 10. Stitch Fabric N 1-1/2" x 85-1/2" borders to right and left sides, and Fabric N 1-1/2" 78-3/4" strips to top and bottom of quilt center.

- 11. Stitch **Fabric B** 5-1/2" x 87-1/2" borders to right and left sides, and **Fabric B** 5-1/2" 88-3/4" strips to top bottom of quilt.
- 12. The quilt measures approximately 88-3/4" x 97-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric P**) at least 8" larger than the top.
- 13. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric N**) and enjoy!!




