Twin Quilt 63 1/2" x 87 1/2"

Tidepools

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of 6 panels to approximately 11-1/2" square each

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 12-1/2" x 24-1/2" stripe pieces for use in quilt center, (2) 10-1/4" x 64-1/2", and (2) 10-1/4" x 40-1/2" stripe for borders

Fabric C - Cut (1) 10-1/4" strip, subcut (4) 10-1/4" squares

Fabric D - Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips

Fabric E - Cut (1) 12-1/2" strip, subcut (5) 6-1/2" x 12-1/2" pieces and (4) 3" squares
Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end then cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 84" and (2) 2-1/2" x 64" borders

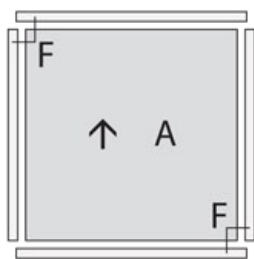
Fabric F - Cut (1) 3" strip, subcut (4) 3" squares and (4) 1-1/4" x 13" strips
Cut (7) 1-1/4" strips, subcut (8) 1-1/4" x 13" and (12) 1-1/4" x 11-3/4" strips

Fabric G - Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips
Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabric H - Cut (5) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end then cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 60-1/2" and (2) 2-1/2" x 40-1/2" borders

2. Piecing Order:

1. Stitch 1-1/4" x 11-3/4" **Fabric F** strips to right and left sides of an 11-1/2" **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 1-1/4" x 13" **Fabric F** strips to top and bottom of panel. **Trim bordered panel to 12-1/2" square (unfinished)**. Make a total of 6 **Block 1**.



Make 6 - Block 1

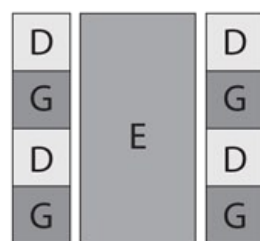
Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

2. Sew 2 each **Fabrics D** and **G** 3-1/2" strips together along long edges, alternating the prints. From this, cut 10 units each 3-1/2" x 12-1/2" (unfinished).



Cut (10) 3-1/2" wide units

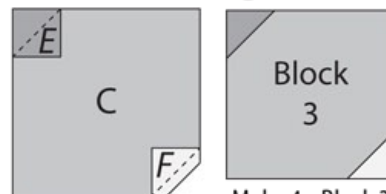
3. Sew units to long sides of a 6-1/2" x 12-1/2" **Fabric E** piece as shown. Make a total of 5 **Block 2** (12-1/2" square unfinished).



Make 5 - Block 2

4. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of each of the **Fabrics E** and **F** 3" squares.

5. Place 1 each marked **Fabrics E** and **F** squares on opposite corners of a **Fabric C** 10-1/4" square as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press triangles out. Make a total of 4 **Block 3** (12-1/2" square unfinished).



Make 4 - Block 3

Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

6. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of blocks, **Fabric B** pieces, and borders.

7. Arrange **Blocks 1** and **2** and **Fabric B** 12-1/2" x 24-1/2" stripe pieces into 5 rows. Sew into rows. Sew rows together to complete quilt center (36-1/2" x 60-1/2" unfinished).

8. Sew **Fabric H** 2-1/2" x 60-1/2" strips to right and left sides. Add **Fabric H** 2-1/2" x 40-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

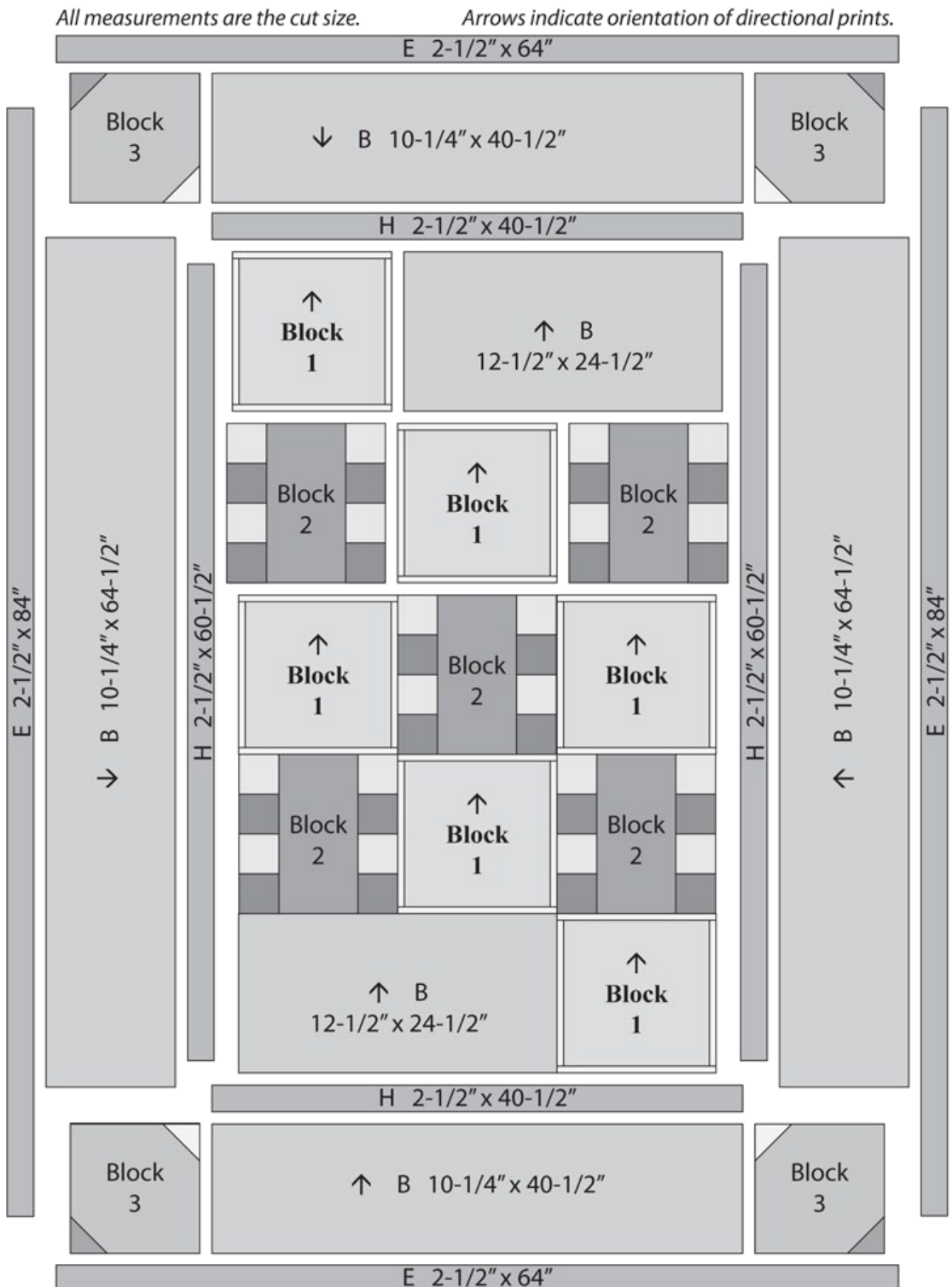
9. Stitch **Fabric B** 10-1/4" x 64-1/2" borders to right and left sides. Sew a **Block 3** to both short ends of each **Fabric B** 10-1/4" x 40-1/2" borders then add to top and bottom of quilt.

10. Sew **Fabric E** 2-1/2" x 84" strips to right and left sides. Add **Fabric E** 2-1/2" x 64" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

11. The quilt measures approximately 64" x 88" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric I**) at least 8" larger than the top.

12. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric G**) and enjoy!!
