You will also need:
5 yards Backing Fabric
1/2 yard Binding Fabric
69" X 81" Sized Quilt Batting

Notes Before You Begin

- Please read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

Fabric A:

- Cut eleven strips 2-3/4" x WOF, then subcut into one-hundred sixty squares 2-3/4" x 2-3/4".
- Cut five strips 2-1/4" x WOF, then subcut eighty squares 2-1/4" x 2-1/4".
- Cut twelve strips 2-1/4" x WOF, then subcut eighty rectangles 2-1/4" x 5-3/4".
- Cut eight strips 2-1/2" x WOF.
- Cut eight strips 2" x WOF.

Fabric B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J, K, L, M, N, O, V, W, aa, bb, cc, dd:

- From EACH fabric, cut four squares 3-3/4" x 3-3/4".

Fabric B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J, K, P, Q, R, S, T, U, X, Y, Z:

- From EACH fabric, cut eight squares 2-3/4" x 2-3/4".
- From EACH fabric, cut one square 2-1/4" x 2-1/4".

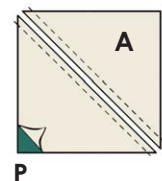
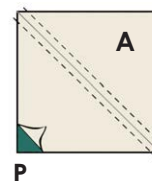
Also from Fabric K:

- Cut eight strips 2-1/2" x WOF.

Assembly Instructions

Step 1: Make the Half Square Triangles (HSTs)

- Place a fabric A 2-3/4" square right sides together with a Fabric P 2-3/4" square. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner and sew a scant 1/4" from either side of the drawn line.
- Cut the fabric apart along drawn line and press fabric open.
- Trim HSTs to 2-1/4" x 2-1/4".
- Repeat to make sixteen matching HSTs.

Step 2: Assemble the Bear Claw Blocks

- Sew two HSTs together, as pictured to make Unit 1.
Repeat to make four Units.

- Sew two HSTs and a Fabric A 2-1/4" square together, as pictured to make Unit 2. Repeat to make four Units.

- Sew a Unit 1 to the left side of a Fabric O 3-3/4" square, as pictured. Sew a Unit 2 to the top of the Fabric O square. Press seams toward Fabric O. Repeat to make four "Paws".



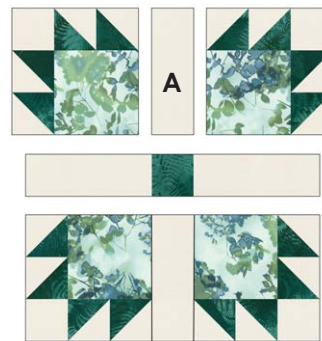

- Sew a Fabric A 2-1/4" x 5-3/4" strip short sides together with a Fabric P 2-1/4" square to make a sashing strip.

- Sew the Bear Paw Block together as shown. Press seams toward Fabric A. Block will measure 12-3/4" x 12-3/4".

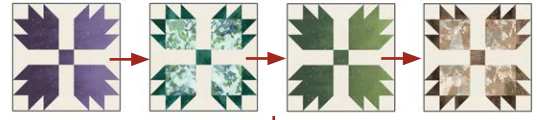


Bear Paw Block

- Repeat Steps 1 and 2 to make twenty Bear Paw Blocks. Follow the chart below to pair the fabrics for each block.

Step 3: Assemble the Quilt Top

- Sew the Bear Paw Blocks into five rows of four blocks each. Refer to the Assembly Diagram for block layout, or arrange them as you please.



Assembly Diagram

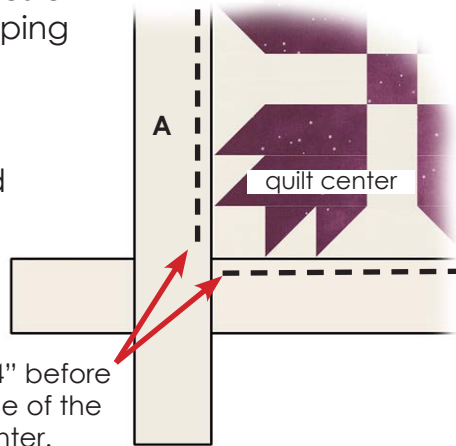
Step 4: Attach the Inner Border

- Sew two Fabric A 2-1/2" strips, short ends together, to make a Border Strip. Repeat with the remaining 2-1/2" strips to make four Inner Border Strips.

- Sew an Inner Border Strip to the top and bottom of the quilt center, starting and stopping a 1/4" before each corner and backstitching.

- Sew a Inner Border Strip to the sides of the quilt center, starting and stopping a 1/4" before each corner and backstitching.

- Press all seam allowances toward the borders.



Stop 1/4" before the edge of the quilt center.



Inner Border

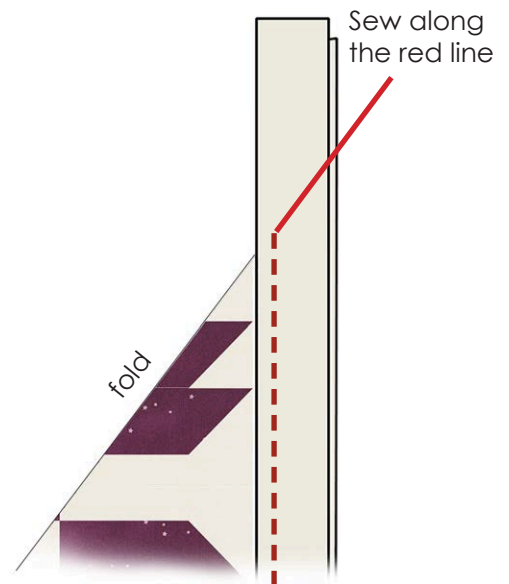
Step 5: Mitre the Border Corners

- Fold the quilt in half diagonally, with right sides together. Two perpendicular borders will now be laying with one on top of the other. Align the raw edges.

- With a ruler, mark a line (shown in red) that extends from the diagonal fold to the raw edges of the borders.

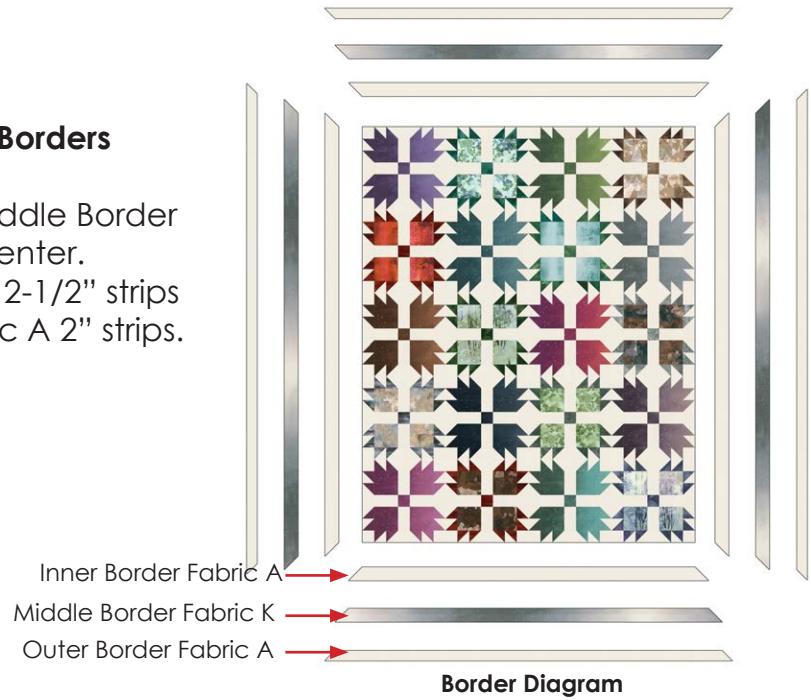
- Sew along the marked line, beginning at the original stitching. Trim seam allowance to 1/4".

- Repeat for the other three corners.



Step 6: Attach the Middle and Outer Borders

- Repeat Steps 4 and 5 to sew the Middle Border and the Outer Border to the Quilt Center.
The Middle Border uses the Fabric K 2-1/2" strips and the Outer Border uses the Fabric A 2" strips.



Your quilt top is complete!
Baste, quilt, bind, and enjoy.
