Cutting Directions:

(Backing)

Note: All strips are cut across the width of the fabric (perpendicular to selvages) unless noted otherwise.

WOF = Width of fabric from selvage to selvage.

A. 24168-R: Paisley – Red

• Cut two 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into six 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

B. 24167-N: Floral – Navy

- Cut two 5 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twelve 5 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make forty-eight triangles.
- Cut three 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty-four 4 ½" squares.

C. 24170-R: Chevron – Red

• Cut two 5 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twelve 5 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make forty-eight triangles.

D. 24171-H: Dots – Lime

• Cut two 5 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twelve 5 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make forty-eight triangles.

E. 24171-B: Dots – Blue

• Cut three 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into forty-eight 2 ½" squares.

F. 24170-N: Chevron – Navy

- Cut three 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into forty-eight 2 ½" squares.
- Cut seven 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.





Cutting Directions - Continued:

Note: All strips are cut across the width of the fabric (perpendicular to selvages) unless noted otherwise.

WOF = Width of fabric from selvage to selvage.

G. 24166-Z: Main Floral

- Cut two 8 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into six $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
- Cut four 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut two 3 ½" x 67 ½" strips.
- Cut three 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut two 3 ½" x 57 ½" strips.

H. 24170-H: Chevron – Lime

• Cut three 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty-four 4 ½" squares.

I. 24167-R: Floral – Red

• Cut two 5 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twelve 5 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make forty-eight triangles.

J. 24169-ZN: Daisies – Navy

• Cut two 5 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twelve 3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make six A-blocks 5 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make forty-eight triangles.

K. 24171-R: Dots – Red

- Cut four 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut two 2" x 64 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- Cut three 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to 5. Place one 2 ½" Fabric F square on the top left corner end with diagonal seams, and cut two 2" x 51 ½" strips.
- Cut four 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut two 2" x 73 ½" strips.
- Cut four 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut two 2" x 60 ½" strips.

L. 21519-Z

- Cut six 5 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into thirty-six 5 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (144) triangles.
- Cut six 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into forty-eight 4 ½" squares.

Backing 24168-N: Paisley – Navy

• Cut two 68" x WOF strips. Sew together and trim to make one 68" x 84" back.

Block Assembly:

1. Place one 4 ½" Fabric B square on the top left corner of one 8 ½" Fabric A square, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam.

2. Follow Figure 3 for the seam direction to add a 4 ½" Fabric B square to each of the remaining corners of the 8 ½" Fabric A square to make one A-block (Fig. 4).

- 4. Repeat Steps 1-2 using six 8 ½" Fabric G squares and twenty-four 4 ½" Fabric H squares to make six G-blocks (Fig. 5).



- of one 4 ½" Fabric L square, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam. Repeat to sew a 2 ½" Fabric E square to the lower right corner of the Fabric L square to make one L-block (Fig. 6). Repeat to make forty-eight L-blocks total.
- 6. Sew one Fabric C triangle, one Fabric D triangle and two Fabric L triangles together to make one CLD block (Fig. 7). Repeat to make forty-eight CLD blocks total.











7. Sew two CLD blocks together to make one CLD strip (Fig. 8). Repeat to make twenty-four CLD strips total.



8. Sew one Fabric J triangle, one Fabric L triangle, one Fabric B triangle and one Fabric I triangle together to make one JLBI block (Fig. 9). Repeat to make twenty-four JLBI blocks total. Construct twenty-four mirror image JBLI blocks for a total of forty-eight blocks.

9. Sew one JLBI block and one mirror image JLBI block together to make one JLBI strip (Fig. 10). Repeat to make twenty-four JLBI strips total.



10. Sew four L-blocks, four CLD strips and one A-block together to make one Block One. Repeat to make six Block Ones total (Fig. 11).



11. Sew four L-blocks, four JLBI strips and one G-block together to make one Block Two. Repeat to make six Block Twos total (Fig. 12)



Quilt Assembly:


(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

- 12. Sew one Block One to each side of one Block Two to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three.
- 13. Sew one Block Two to each side of one Block One to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Four.
- 14. Sew the four rows together, in numerical order, to make the quilt top.
- 15. Sew one 2" x 64 ½" Fabric K strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 2" x 51 ½" Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
- 16. Sew one 3 ½" x 67 ½" Fabric G strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 3 ½" x 57 ½" Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
- 17. Sew one 2" x 73 ½" Fabric K strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 2" x 60 ½" Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.

Finishing:

- 18. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 19. Sew the seven 2 ½ x WOF Fabric F strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half, lengthwise with wrong sides together, and press.
- 20. Bind as desired.
