

# ALPAGA PIGNIG

Quilt Instructions



Finished Size: 52" x 72" Finished Blocks: 12 1/2"

#### MATERIALS

**NOTE:** Fabrics in the quilt shown are from the China line of the Mary Fons World Piece collection.

- 1/4 yard Ditsy Red Print
- 1/4 yard Ditsy Black Teal
- 1/2 yard Tribal Multi Print
- 1/2 yard Ditsy Mustard Print
- · 4.5 yards Solid Black
- 108" Mary Fons Backing Hearts
- Fons & Porter 1/4" Seam Marker Ruler

## CUTTING

## FROM TRIBAL MULTI, CUT:

- (2) 6 3/4" x WOF strips
  - · Sub cut (9) 6 3/4" squares

## FROM DITSY BLACK TEAL, CUT:

- (1) 6 3/4" x WOF strips
  - Sub cut (3) 6 3/4" squares

#### FROM DITSY MUSTARD, CUT:

- (2) 6 3/4" x WOF strips
  - · Sub cut (9) 6 3/4" squares

#### FROM DITSY RED, CUT:


• (2) 3" x WOF strips for strip sets

## FROM BLACK SOLID, CUT:


- (4) 6 3/4" x WOF strips
  - · Sub cut (20) 6 3/4" squares
- (4) 3" x WOF strips for strip sets
- (29) 3" x WOF strips
  - · Sub cut:
    - (16) 3" x 13" rectangles
    - (104) 3" x 8" rectangles
    - (44) 3" squares
- (2) 19" squares for side set triangles
  - Sub cut each square in quarters on the diagonal
- (2) 10" squares for corner set triangles
  - Sub cut each square in half on the diagonal

## UNIT ASSEMBLY


8-at-a-Time Triangle Squares - pair one print square with one solid square



Mark stitch lines using seam marker ruler and stitch on the marked lines



Cut along solid black lines



Press open with seams towards dark fabric



8 Triangle-Squares

#### REPEAT THE PROCESS TO CREATE:

- (72)
  Mustard
  Ditsy/
  Black
  triangle
  squares
- (72) Multi Tribal/ Black triangle squares
- (72) Teal
  Ditsy/
  Black
  triangle
  squares







## CENTER BLOCK ASSEMBLY

(Press all seams open)

and of

- Make 2 strip sets Black/Red Ditsy/Black
- · Sub cut (22) 3" segments




• Sew an 8" black strip to the sides of the 3" segment to create the center block units. Create 22 center block units






## ALPACA BLOCK ASSEMBLY

- · Layout the triangle squares around 14 center blocks as shown in the diagram
- · Join the triangle squares and black squares in rows to the bullseye units








## USE THE BLOCK DIAGRAM TO MAKE:

· (6) Multi Tribal and Black Blocks



· (2) Teal and Black Blocks









## BULLSEYE BLOCK ASSEMBLY

• Add 8" black strips to the sides and 13" black strips to the top and bottom of the remaining center units as shown in the diagram.






- · Use the block diagram to make 8 bullseye blocks
- Cut 2 of the Bullseye blocks in half on the diagonal for the 4-side set triangles shown below in the quilt assembly.

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

• Layout quilt blocks on point. Add side and corner set triangles as shown in the quilt layouts.







· Join blocks in diagonal rows. Trim the quilt face once it is sewn together.

## FINISHING

LAYER THE QUILT TOP, BATTING AND BACKING, QUILT AS DESIRED AND BIND
