



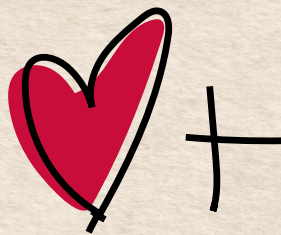

# SMALL WONDERS



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## RENDEZVOUS STARS

*Quilt Instructions*

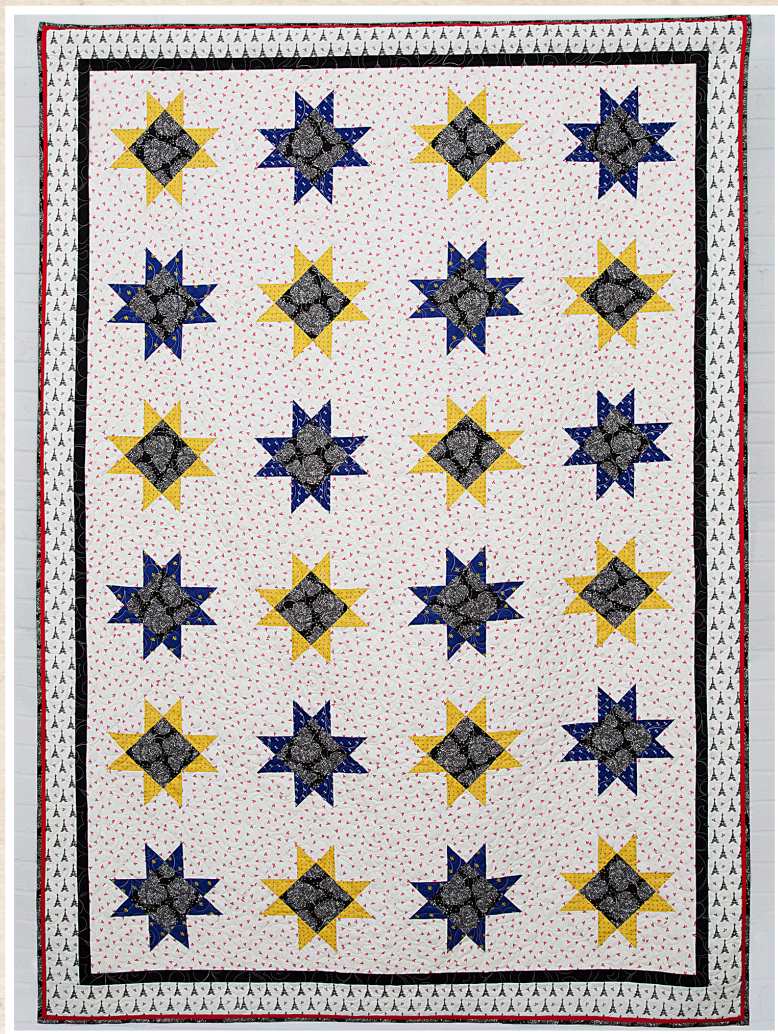
**Finished Size:** 60" x 85"

**Finished Blocks:** 9"

### MATERIALS

**NOTE:** *Fabrics in the quilt shown are from the France line of the Mary Fons World Piece collection.*

- 2 1/4 yards - Eiffel Tower
- 5/8 yard - Blue Ditsy
- 4 yards - Red Ditsy
- 1 yard - Black Leaf
- 5/8 yard - Mustard Ditsy
- 1/3 yard - Solid Black
- 1/2 yard - Solid Red
- 108" - Mary Fons Backing Hearts

## CUTTING

### FROM RED DITSY, CUT:

- (2)  $13\frac{1}{2}$ "  $\times$  WOF strips
  - From strips cut (4)  $13\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
  - Cut the squares in quarters on the diagonal for side set triangles
- (5)  $9\frac{1}{2}$ "  $\times$  WOF strips
  - From strips cut (16)  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
  - Cut 1 of the squares in half on the diagonal for set corner triangles
- (24)  $2\frac{3}{4}$ "  $\times$  WOF strips
  - From strips cut (96)  $2\frac{3}{4}$ " squares and (96)  $2\frac{3}{4}$ "  $\times$  5" rectangles

### FROM BLACK LEAF, CUT:

- (3) 5"  $\times$  WOF strips
  - From strips cut (24) 5" squares
- (8)  $2\frac{3}{4}$ " strips for binding

### FROM MUSTARD DITSY, CUT:

- (7)  $2\frac{3}{4}$ "  $\times$  WOF strips
  - From strips cut (96)  $2\frac{3}{4}$ " squares

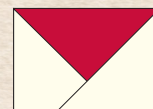
### FROM BLUE DITSY, CUT:

- (7)  $2\frac{3}{4}$ "  $\times$  WOF strips
  - From strips cut (96)  $2\frac{3}{4}$ " squares

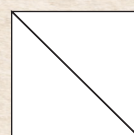
## UNIT ASSEMBLY

### FLYING GEESE UNITS

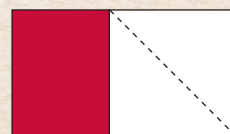
- Use the flip corner method shown to create the flying geese units



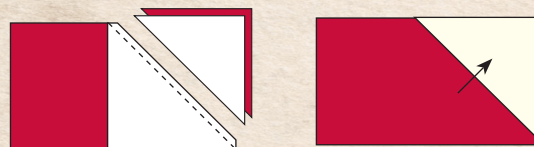
1. Draw a diagonal line on each  $2\frac{3}{4}$ " square



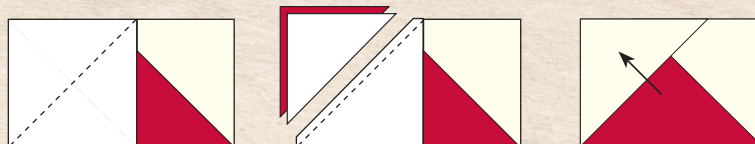
2. With right sides together, align on marked square with one edge of the rectangle as shown. Stitch one thread width to the outside of the diagonal line.



3. Cut  $\frac{1}{4}$ " beyond the stitching line as shown. Press the resulting triangle open and the seam allowance toward the triangle.



4. Repeat steps 2 and 3 on the other edge of the rectangle to complete the unit.



5. Make 40 flying geese units with Mustard Ditsy and Red Ditsy



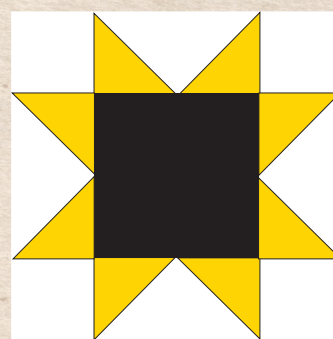
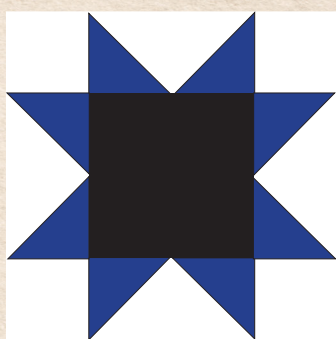
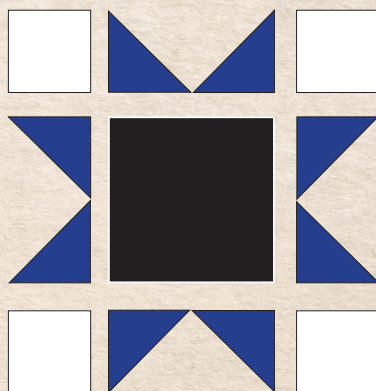
6. Make 40 flying geese units with Blue Ditsy and Red Ditsy



## BLOCK ASSEMBLY

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- Lay block units out following the diagram
- Join units in rows and then rows to create 24 blocks:

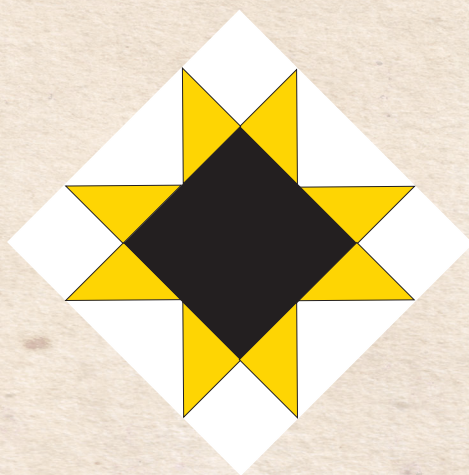


- (12) *Rendezvous Stars with Blue Ditsy*
- (12) *Rendezvous Stars with Mustard Ditsy*

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

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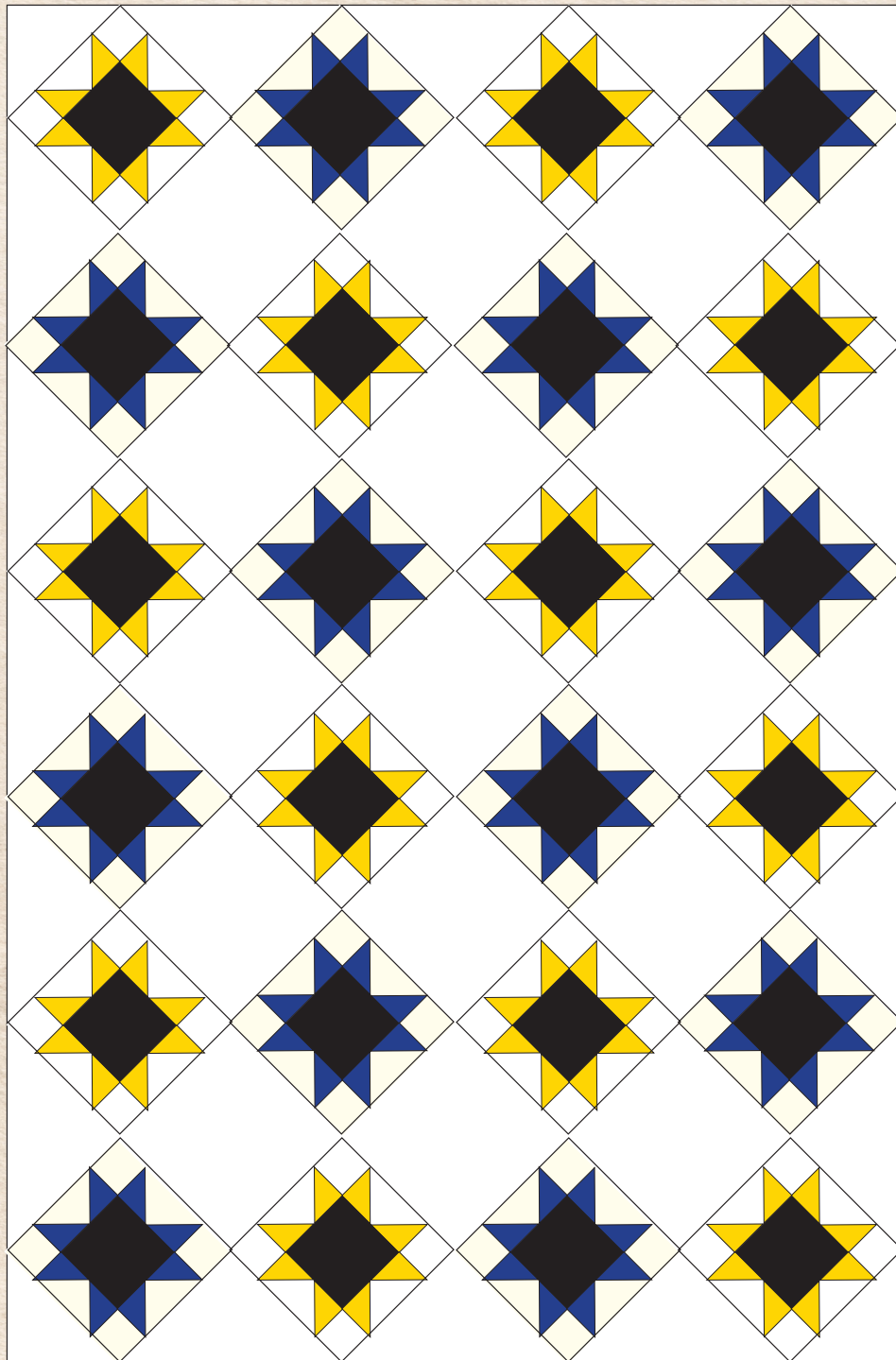
- Set blocks on point using the quilt diagram and add set triangles and set corners



## QUILT ASSEMBLY *(cont.)*

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- *Join the blocks in rows diagonally*
- *Join rows together to create the quilt top unit*



## BORDERS

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### INNER BORDER FROM SOLID BLACK:

- *Cut (8) 1 1/2" x WOF strips and piece together*
- *Cut (2) strips the width of the quilt face for the top and bottom border. Attach the quilt face.*
- *Cut (2) length of the quilt face once you have sewn the top and bottom inner border on. Attach to the quilt face.*

### OUTER BORDER FROM EIFFEL TOWER:

- **NOTE:** *FIRST cut strips length of fabric for side borders, SECOND cut strips width of fabric and piece for top and bottom borders.*
- *Measure the quilt face sides and cut (2) 3 1/2" x length of quilt top strips for the side borders. Attach to the sides of the quilt face.*
- *Measure the quilt face width and cut (5) 3 1/2" x remaining WOF strips for top and bottom border, piece together and cut to fit top and bottom of the quilt face. Attach the quilt face.*
- **NOTE:** *keep eiffel towers facing the same direction as you piece and attach to the quilt face*

### FLANGE BORDER FROM RED

**SOLID:** *NOTE: if your quilt will be sent to longarm, you will want to wait for it to return to add this step just before you bind the quilt.*

- *Cut (9) 2" x WOF strips and piece together, fold and press in half lengthwise to create the flange.*
- *Cut (2) flange strips the width of the quilt face for the top and bottom. Place the raw edges together and baste in place using a scant 1/4" seam.*
- *Cut (2) flange strips the length of the quilt face for side flange. Place the raw edges together and baste in place using a scant 1/4" seam.*
- *Layer, quilt top batting and backing and quilt as desired.*
