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Green Mountain Farm

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvege to selvege, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following for LARGE THROW:

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, panels have a coping border added then trimmed so they will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside black outline of 6 panels to approximately 10-1/2" x 12-1/2"

Fabric B - Cut (2) 11-1/2" strips, subcut (1) 11-1/2" x 26-1/2", (2) 11-1/2" x 20", and (1) 11-1/2" x 13-1/2" strips

Fabric C - Cut (2) 7-1/2" strips

Fabric D - Cut (4) 2-1/2" strips

Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 66-1/2" and (2) 2-1/2" x 56-1/2" borders

Fabric E - Cut (2) 7-1/2" strips

Fabric F - Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

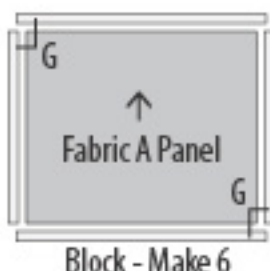
Fabric G - Cut (7) 3" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 3" x 70-1/2" and (2) 3" x 61-1/2" borders

Cut (4) 2-1/2" strips

Cut (8) 1-1/4" strips, subcut (12) 1-1/4" x 14" and (12) 1-1/4" x 11" strips

2. Piecing Order for LARGE THROW:

1. Stitch 1-1/4" x 11" **Fabric G** strips to short sides of a **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 1-1/4" x 14" **Fabric G** strips to top and bottom of panel. **Trim bordered panel to 11-1/2" tall x 13-1/2" wide.** Make a total of 6 blocks.



Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

2. Sew 2-1/2" **Fabric G** strips lengthwise to sides of a 7-1/2" **Fabric E** strip. Make a total of 2 Strip 1, each 11-1/2" tall. From these cut 1 each 11-1/2" x 39-1/2", 11-1/2" x 33", and 11-1/2" x 7" (unfinished) lengths.

3. Sew 2-1/2" **Fabric D** strips lengthwise to sides of a 7-1/2" **Fabric C** strip. Make a total of 2 Strip 2, each 11-1/2" tall. From these cut 1 each 11-1/2" x 33", 11-1/2" x 26-1/2", 11-1/2" x 13-1/2", and 11-1/2" x 7" (unfinished) lengths.

4. Refer to Large Throw Quilt Layout (Page 2) for arrangement and placement of blocks, strips, and borders.

5. Arrange blocks, Strip 1 lengths, Strip 2 lengths, and Fabric B strips in 6 rows. Sew into rows. Sew rows together to complete 52-1/2" x 66-1/2" (unfinished) quilt center.

6. Stitch 2-1/2" x 66-1/2" **Fabric D** borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add 2-1/2" x 56-1/2" **Fabric D** borders to top and bottom.

7. Sew 3" x 70-1/2" **Fabric G** borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add 3" x 61-1/2" **Fabric G** borders to top and bottom.

8. The quilt measures approximately 61-1/2" x 75-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric I**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

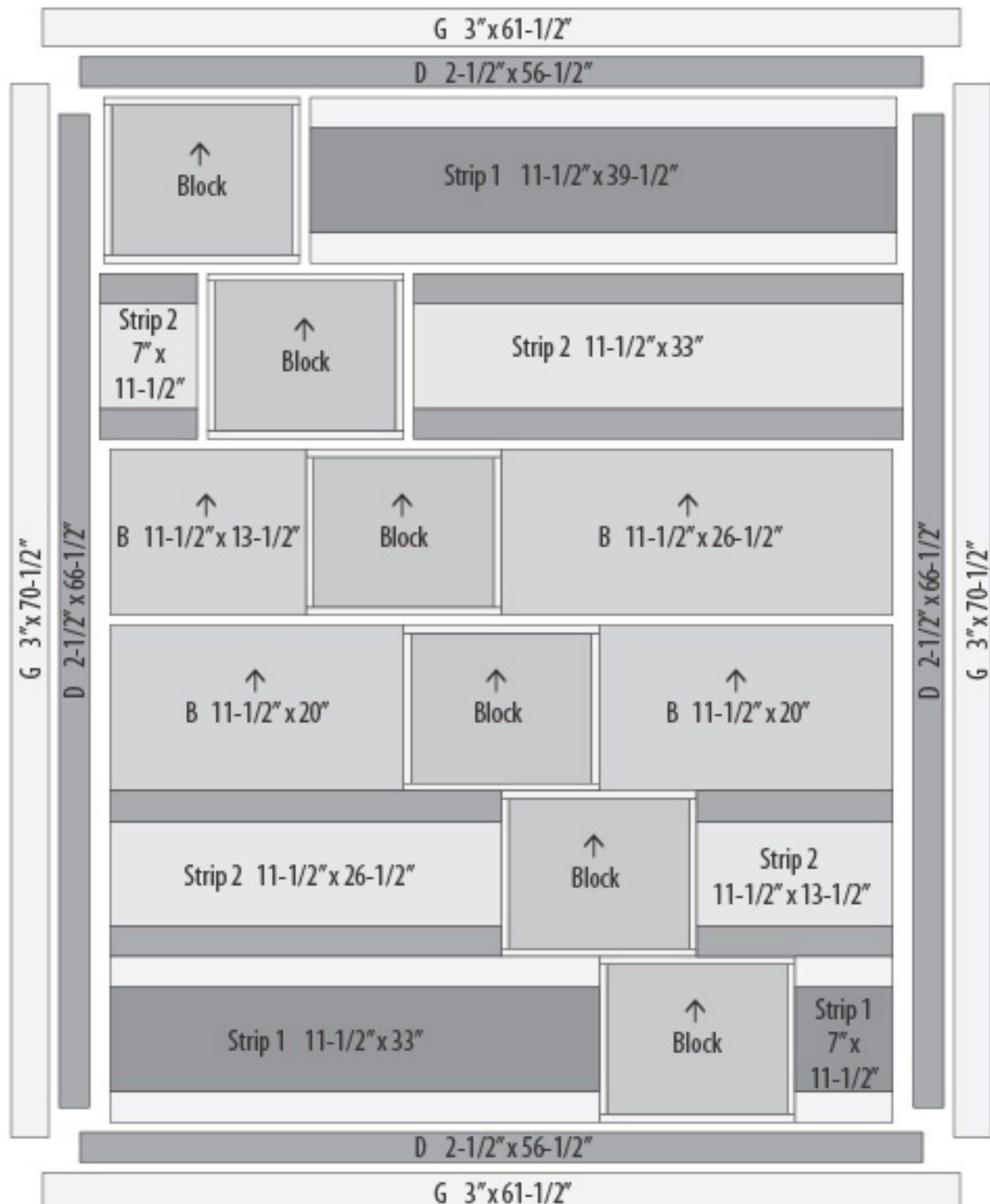
9. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric F**) and enjoy!!

3. Cut the following for MEDIUM THROW:

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, panels have a coping border added then trimmed so they will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of 5 panels to approximately 11-1/2" x 13-1/2"

Fabric B - Cut (1) 13" strip, subcut

(2) 13" x 13-1/2" pieces

Cut (1) 11-1/2" strip, subcut

(2) 11-1/2" x 15" pieces

Cut (3) 6-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 6-1/2" x 45-1/2" strips

Fabric C - Cut (3) 6-1/2" strips sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 6-1/2" x 56-1/2" borders

Cut (3) 4-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 4-1/2" x 54-1/2" borders

Fabric D - Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Cut (3) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 45-1/2" and

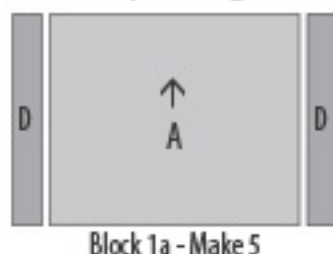
(1) 2-1/2" x 12" strips

Cut (5) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (4) 2-1/2" x 16-1/2" and (9) 2-1/2" x 12" strips

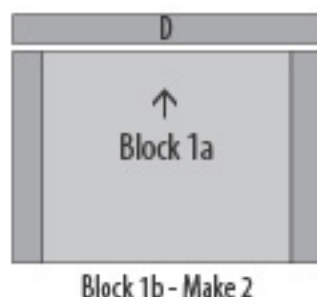
Fabric H - (5) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 51-1/2" and (2) 2" x 48-1/2" borders

4. Piecing Order for MEDIUM THROW:

1. Stitch 2-1/2" x 12" **Fabric D** strips to right and left sides of a **Fabric A** panel. **Trim to 16-1/2" wide.** Make a total of 5 **Block 1a** (11-1/2" x 16-1/2" unfinished).



2. Add **Fabric D** 2-1/2" x 16-1/2" strip to top of a Block 1a. **Trim top Fabric D strip so block is 13" tall.** Make a total of 2 **Block 1b** (13" x 16-1/2" unfinished).

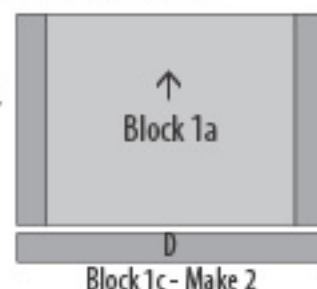


3 Add **Fabric D** 2-1/2" x 16-1/2" strip to bottom of a **Block 1a**.

Trim bottom Fabric D strip so block is 13" tall.

Make a total of 2

Block 1c (13" x 16-1/2" unfinished).



4. Refer to Medium Throw Quilt Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of blocks, **Fabric B** pieces, **Fabric D** strips, and borders.

5. Stitch **Block 1a** between **Fabric B** 11-1/2" x 15" pieces. Sew **Fabric D** 2-1/2" x 45-1/2" strips to top and bottom of center row. **Trim row to 14-1/2" tall.** (Center Row 45-1/2" long unfinished).

6. Sew a **Fabric B** 13" x 13-1/2" piece between 2 **Block 1b** for Top Row (13" x 45-1/2" unfinished). Sew a **Fabric B** 13" x 13-1/2" piece between 2 **Block 1c** for Bottom Row (13" x 45-1/2" unfinished).

7. Sew Center Row between Top and Bottom rows to complete quilt center (39-1/2" x 45-1/2" unfinished).

8. Stitch **Fabric B** 6-1/2" x 45-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

9. Sew 2" x 51-1/2" **Fabric H** borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add 2" x 48-1/2" **Fabric H** borders to top and bottom.

10. Sew 4-1/2" x 54-1/2" **Fabric C** borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add 6-1/2" x 56-1/2" **Fabric C** borders to top and bottom.

11. The quilt measures approximately 56-1/2" x 66-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric I**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

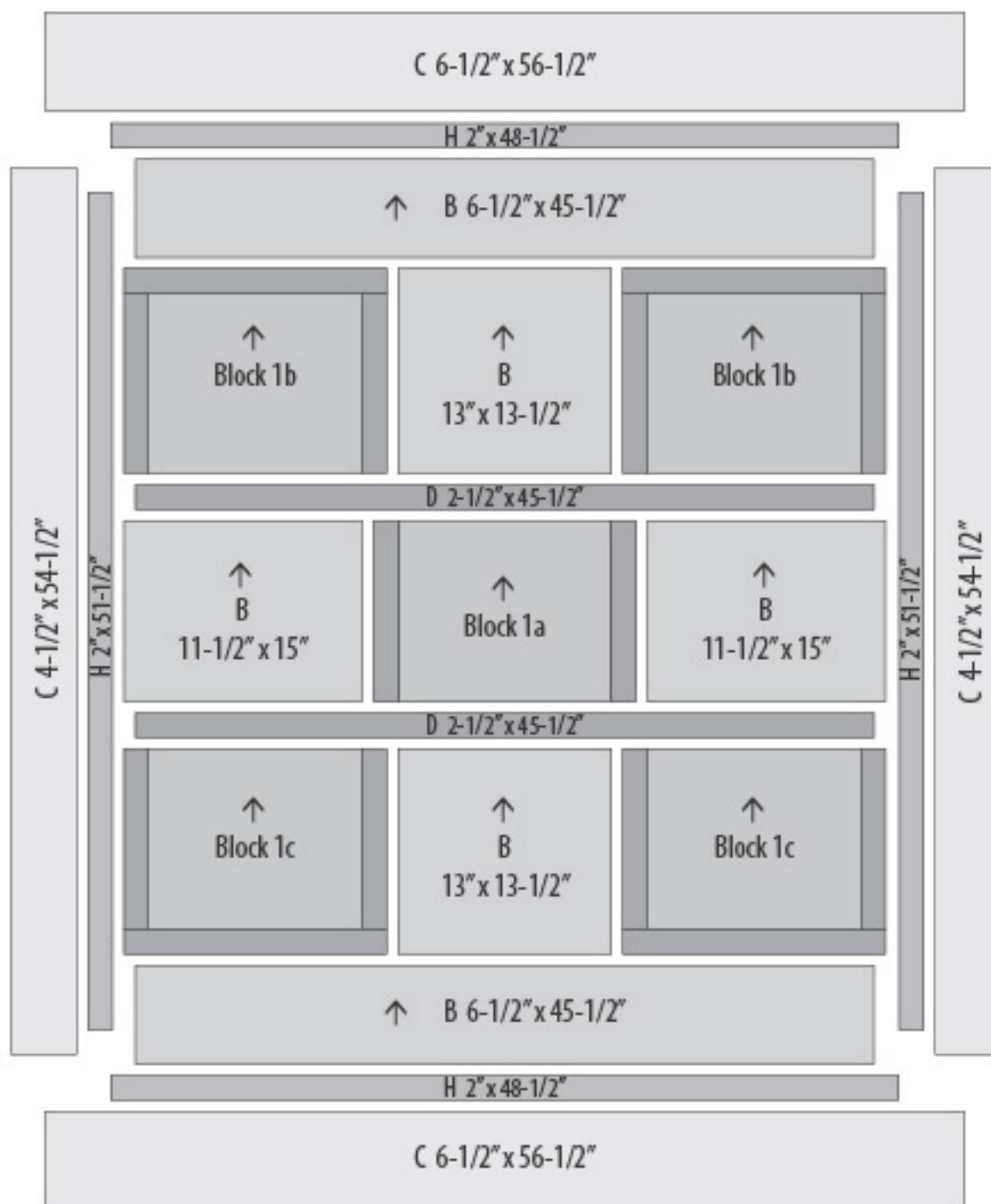
12. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric D**) and enjoy!!
