## REQUIREMENTS

Fabrics from the Bunny Garden collection:

1. A146.2 - Bunny wreath on light grey $-5 / 8 \mathrm{yd}-60 \mathrm{~cm}$
2. A147.2 - Pretty flowers on pink $-3 / 8 \mathrm{yd}-30 \mathrm{~cm}$
3. A148.1-Bunny adventure on white $-5 / 8 \mathrm{yd}-60 \mathrm{~cm}$
4. A149.2 - Butterflies on pink $-3 / 8 \mathrm{yd}-30 \mathrm{~cm}$
5. A150.3 - Leo bunny on yellow $-3 / 8 \mathrm{yd}-30 \mathrm{~cm}$
6. BB66-spring yellow $-5 / 8 y d-60 \mathrm{~cm}$
7. BB68 - spring green $-1 \frac{1}{4} \mathrm{yd}-11 / 4 \mathrm{mtr}$

Wadding and backing 56" x 56"
Use $1 / 4$ " seam allowance throughout. Press all seams open unless otherwise noted.

## Cutting

## From fabric 1 cut

$12 \times 67 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 67 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally once (cut from bottom left to top right)

## From fabric 2 cut

$25 \times 31122^{\prime \prime} \times 3122^{\prime \prime}$

## From fabric 3 cut

$12 \times 67 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 67 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ cut in half diagonally once (cut from bottom left to top right)

## From fabric 4 cut

$25 \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 22^{\prime \prime}$

## From fabric 5 cut

$25 \times 3122^{\prime \prime} \times 3122^{\prime \prime}$

## From fabric 6 cut

$2 \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 451 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (join fabric)
$2 \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 471 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (join fabric)

## From fabric 7 cut

$2 \times 3$ " $\times 471 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ (join fabric)
$2 \times 3$ " x 52½" (join fabric)
$50 \times 37 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 37 / 8^{"}$ cut in half diagonally once

## Making up block

Lay out all the fabric pieces for each of the blocks.
On block 1 you will have fabric 1 in the top left hand corner with fabric 3 in the bottom right corner, and on block 2 fabric 3 will be in the top left and fabric 1 in the bottom right corner.

Start by sewing in rows the top triangle of fabric 7 to the square of fabric 5. Press your seam to the right.

Next sew the triangle of fabric 7 to the square of fabric 2 and then the triangle of fabric 7 together. This time press your seam to the left.

Then sew the last square of fabric 4 to the triangle of fabric 7. Press again to the right this will help when you sew rows together.

Sew the rows together and then add the lager triangles of fabric 1and fabric 3 to each side of the panel to make the block.

Sewing 25 blocks in total.

## Making up quilt

Lay out all the blocks as in the main diagram
Sew the rows together pressing the seams of each row in the opposite way each time. This will help when you sew the rows together.

Sew the rows together
When you have all your blocks sewn together add the inner borders of fabric 6 .
Sew the sides and then the top and bottom.
Now add the outer border again sides and then the top and bottom of fabric 7
Sandwich together the quilt top, wadding and backing.
Quilt by hand or machine as desired.

## Binding

Use your favourite method from fabric 7 to bind the quilt
