Quilt is $71^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x} 90^{\prime \prime}$.

Blocks
12 assorted Fat Quarters*
Block Center, Corner and
Cornerstones: $1 \frac{118}{8}$ yards
Background and Sashing: $23 / 4$ yards

Border and Binding: $2^{1} / 2$ yards

## Backing: <br> 51/2 yards

*Fat Quarter=18" x 22 "

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## Due South <br> Quilt is $71^{\prime \prime} \times 90$ ".

## Cutting

## Blocks

From EACH of the 12 Fat Quarters cut:
$1-2^{1 / 2 "} \times 18$ " strip; from the strip, cut $3-2^{1 / 2 "} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
$1-41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 18$ " strip; from the strip, cut $6-2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
$1-13^{1 / 2 "} \times 18$ " strip; from the strip, cut $1-123 / 4$ square and $3-41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$


## Block Center, Corner and Cornerstones

$2-41 / 2^{\prime \prime} x$ width of fabric strips; from the strips, cut $12-41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares $5-33 / /^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ width of fabric strips; from the strips, cut $48-33 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares $2-2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ width of fabric strips; from the strips, cut $20-2^{1 / 2 "}$ squares

## Background and Sashing

$2-17 \frac{1}{2}$ " $x$ width of fabric strips; from the strips, cut $31-171 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$
$4-27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ width of fabric strips
From the strips, cut $48-27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares, cut in half on the diagonal to make $96-27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ half-square triangles (HST)
$18-2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ width of fabric strips; from the strips, cut $288-2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares

## Border and Binding

$9-61 / 2 \mathrm{x}$ width of fabric strips; sew end-to-end to make one long strip From the long strip, cut $2-61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 781 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and $2-61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 71^{1 / 2}$ " borders $9-2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ width of fabric strips; sew end-to-end to make the binding

## Construction

Use $1 / 4 "$ seams. Press in the direction of the arrows in the diagrams.

## Blocks

(A) Draw a diagonal line, from corner to corner, on the wrong side of the $288-2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ background squares. Layer a marked square, right sides together, on one end of a $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ print rectangle. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from the sewn line. Press to the corner to form a triangle. Repeat on the opposite end of the same rectangle to make 1 unit A. Make 144 unit As.

(B) Sew a $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ background half-square triangle to one side of a $33 / 8$ " corner square as shown. Press. Sew a $27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ background half-square triangle to an adjacent side of the same square as shown. Press to make 1 unit B. Make 48 unit Bs.


Unit B $43 / 4^{1 "} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished Make 48.
(C) Join 3 unit As and 1 unit B as shown to make 1 unit C .

Make 48 unit Cs.

(D) Cut the $12-123 / 4$ " print squares twice on the diagonal to make 48 quarter-square triangles (QST). Arrange and sew 4 unit Cs, $1-41 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ center square, and $4-\mathrm{QSTs}$ in 3 rows as shown. Join the rows to make one block. Trim the block to $171 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 171 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished. Make 12 blocks.


Arrange and sew
12-A blocks,
20-cornerstones, 31-sashings, in 9 rows as shown. Press away from the sashing.


Add the $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 781 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
borders to the quilt sides. Press toward the borders.
Add the $6^{1 / 2 " 1} \times 71^{1 / 2 "}$ borders to the top and bottom. Press toward the borders.
Layer, quilt, and bind.
