Twin Quilt: 62-1/2" x 74-1/2"

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

#### 1. Cut the following for Play Mat:

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, the panel has a coping border added then trimmed so the panel will fit the quilt correctly. Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of panel

to approximately 24" x 43"

Fabric B - Referring to the play mat image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 6-1/4" x 47" stripe borders (1 with trucks on top, 1 with trucks on bottom) and (2) 6-1/4" x 28" stripe borders (both with trucks on top)

Fabric D - Cut (1) 6-1/4" strip, subcut (4) 6-1/4" squares

Fabric F - Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabric G - Cut (1) 3" strip, subcut (4) 3" squares

Fabric H - Cut (2) 3" strips, subcut (2) 3" x 24-1/2" borders and (4) 3" squares Cut (3) 3" strips.

Fabric I - Cut (6) 3" strips, subcut (4) 3" x 28-1/4" and (4) 3" x 18-3/4" borders



#### 2. Piecing Order for Play Mat:

- Refer to Play Mat Layout for arrangement and placement of panel and borders.
- 2. Stitch Fabric H 3" x 24-1/2" borders to short sides of the Fabric A panel, Trim strip ends even. Add 3"x 48" Fabric H borders to top and bottom of panel. Trim bordered panel to 28" x 47" (unfinished).
- Stitch Fabric B 6-1/4"x 28" borders to sides of play mat, Stitch Fabric D 6-1/4" squares to each end of both Fabric B 6-1/4" x 47" borders. Add to top and bottom of play mat.
- Sew a 3"Fabric H square between 2 Fabric I 3" x 18-3/4" borders. Make a second border. Add to right and left sides of play mat.
- Sew a 3"Fabric H square between 2 Fabric I 3" x 28-1/4" borders, Sew 3" Fabric G squares to both ends. Make a second border. Add to top and bottom of play mat.

#### PLAY MAT LAYOUT



- The guilt measures approximately 44-1/2" x 63-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (Fabric J) approximately 8" larger than the
- Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric F) and enjoy!!

#### 3. Cut the following for Twin Quilt:

- Fabric B Referring to the guilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 6-1/4" x 51-1/2" stripe borders (both with trucks on top) and (2) 6-1/4" x 39-1/2" stripe borders (1 with trucks on top, 1 with trucks on bottom)
- Fabric C Cut (6) 5" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 5" x 66" and (2) 5"x 54" borders
- Fabric D Cut (1) 6-1/2" strip, subcut (6) 6-1/2" squares Cut (1) 6-1/4" strip, subcut (4) 6-1/4" squares
- Fabric E Cut (1) 5" strip, subcut (4) 5" squares and (4) 3-7/8" squares
- Cut (2) 3-7/8" strips, subcut (20) 3-7/8" squares then cut all 3-7/8" squares in half diagonally once for 48 triangles
- Cut (2) 3-3/8" strips, subcut (24) 3-3/8" squares
- Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (24) 3-1/2" squares
- Cut (6) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 63" and (2) 2" x 54" borders
- Fabric G Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips (binding) Cut (1) 3-3/8" strip, subcut (6) 3-3/8" squares and (10) 2" squares Cut (2) 2" strips, subcut (42) 2" squares
- Fabric H Cut (2) 3-3/8" strips, subcut (24) 3-3/8" squares Cut (3) 2" strips, subcut (48) 2" squares

Fabric I - Cut (2) 7-1/4" strips, subcut (6) 7-1/4" squares then cut half diagonally twice of for 24 triangles Cut (2) 6-7/8" strips, subcut (12) 6-7/8" squares, then cut in half diagonally once 📝 for 24 triangles Cut (3) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and

cut into (2) 2" x 48-1/2" borders

Cut (2) 2" strips, subcut (2) 2" x 36-1/2" borders


#### 4. Piecing Order for Twin Quilt:

 Arrange 1 Fabric G and 4 each Fabrics E and H 3-3/8" squares in 3 rows. Sew into rows. Stitch rows together. Trim to 9" square. Make a total of 6 Unit 1.



Unit 1 - Make 6

 Stitch Fabric | 6-7/8" triangles to all sides of a Unit 1. Make a total of 6 Unit 2 (12-1/2" square unfinished).




Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of each of the Fabric E 3-1/2" squares.

Unit 2 - Make 6



Arrange 4 marked Fabric E 3-1/2" squares on corners of a Unit 2 as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press triangles out, Make a total of 6 Block 1 (12-1/2" square unfinished).



Block 1 - Make 6

Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

Arrange 2 each Fabric G and H 2" squares in 2 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 24 Unit 3 (3-1/2" square unfinished).




Unit 3 - Make 24

 Stitch 2 Fabric E 3-7/8" triangles to short sides of a Fabric I 7-1/4" triangle as shown. Make a total of 24 Unit 4 (3-1/2" x 6-1/2" unfinished).



7. Arrange a Fabric D 6-1/2" square and 4 each Units 3 and 4 in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 6 Block 2 (12-1/2" square unfinished).


- Refer to Twin Quilt Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.
- Arrange blocks in 4 rows, alternating Blocks 1 and 2. Sew blocks into rows. Sew rows together to complete quilt center (36-1/2" x 48-1/2" unfinished).
- 10. Sew **Fabric I** 2"x 48-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Stitch 2" **Fabric G** squares to both ends of each **Fabric I** 2"x 36-1/2" border then add to top of quilt center.

- 11. Sew **Fabric B** 6-1/4" x 51-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Stitch 6-1/4" **Fabric D** squares to both ends of each **Fabric B** 6-1/4" x 39-1/2" border then add to top of quilt.
- 12. Stitch **Fabric E** 2" x 63" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric E** 2" x 54" borders to top and bottom of quilt.
- 13. Sew **Fabric C** 5" x 66" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Stitch 5" **Fabric E** squares to both ends of each **Fabric C** 5" x 54" border then add to top of quilt.
- 14. The twin quilt measures approximately 63" x 75" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric J**) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- 15. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric G) and enjoy!!
