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Poppy Celebration



Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:


Fabric A - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (1) 14" x 77" and (1) 14" x 68" poppy stripe borders. Cut borders in half length wise for (2) 7" x 77" and (2) 7" x 68" borders.



Fabric B - Cut (1) 9-7/8" strip, subcut (2) 9-7/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally  for 4 triangles] and (4) 5" squares

Cut (1) 5-3/4" strip, subcut (2) 5-3/4" squares [then cut in half diagonally twice  for 8 triangles] and (4) 5-3/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally  for 8 triangles]


Cut (1) 3-5/8" strip, subcut (6) 3-5/8" squares and (1) 2-3/4" square


Cut (1) 2-3/4" strip, subcut (15) 2-3/4" squares

Fabric C - Cut (1) 9-7/8" strip, subcut (2) 9-7/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally  for 4 triangles] and (2) 9-1/2" squares

Cut (1) 5-3/4" strip, subcut (1) 5-3/4" square [then cut in half diagonally twice  for 4 triangles] and (4) 5-3/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally  for 8 triangles]


Cut (1) 5" strip, subcut (4) 5" squares and (4) 3-5/8" squares


Fabric D - Cut (1) 9-7/8" strip, subcut (2) 9-7/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally  for 4 triangles] and (4) 3-5/8" squares


Cut (2) 5-3/8" strips, subcut (12) 5-3/8" squares, then cut in half diagonally  for 24 triangles

Fabric E - Cut (1) 5-3/8" strip, subcut (4) 5-3/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally for 8 triangles] and (4) 5" squares



Cut (4) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (48) 2-3/4" squares

Fabric F - Cut (1) 9-7/8" strip, subcut (2) 9-7/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally  for 4 triangles] and (4) 5" squares

Cut (1) 5-3/4" strip, subcut (1) 5-3/4" square [then cut in half diagonally twice  for 4 triangles], (1) 5-3/8" square, and (2) 3-5/8" squares


Cut (1) 5-3/8" strip, subcut (7) 5-3/8" squares, then cut all 5-3/8" squares in half diagonally  for 16 triangles

Fabric G - Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabric H - Cut (1) 5-3/4" strip, subcut (1) 5-3/4" square [then cut in half diagonally twice for 4  triangles], (2) 5-3/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally  for 4 triangles], and (2) 2-3/4" squares

Cut (2) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (30) 2-3/4" squares

Cut (5) 1-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 1-1/2" x 54-1/2" and (2) 1-1/2" x 47-1/2" borders

Fabric I - Cut (1) 5-3/4" strip, subcut (1) 5-3/4" square [then cut in half diagonally twice for 4  triangles] and (2) 2-3/4" squares

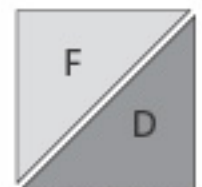
Cut (2) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (30) 2-3/4" squares

Fabric J - Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2-1/2" x 56-1/2" and (2) 2-1/2" x 51-1/2" borders

2. Piecing Order:

1. Stitch **Fabrics D** and **F** 9-7/8" triangles together along their long edges. Make a total of 4

Block 1 (9-1/2" square unfinished).



Block 1 - Make 4

2. Arrange 2 each **Fabrics E** and **I** 2-3/4" squares in 2 rows. Sew into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 16 Unit 1a (5" square unfinished).

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3. In the same manner make 16 Unit 1b each with 1 each **Fabrics B** and **E** and 2 **Fabric H** 2-3/4" squares.

4. Stitch **Fabrics D** and **F** 5-3/8" triangles together along their long edges. Make a total of 16 Unit 2a (5" square unfinished).

5. In the same manner, make 8 each Units 2b and 2c as shown.

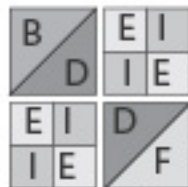

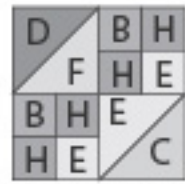

6. Arrange 2 Unit 1a and 1 each Units 2a and 2b in 2 rows. Sew into rows. Stitch rows together. Make a total of 8 **Block 2a** (9-1/2" square unfinished).

7. In the same manner, make 8 **Block 2b** each with 2 Unit 1b and 1 each Units 2a and 2c.

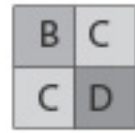


Block 2b - Make 8

8. Arrange 1 each **Fabrics D** and **F** and 2 **Fabric B** 3-5/8" squares in 2 rows. Sew into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 2 Unit 3a (6-3/4" square unfinished).



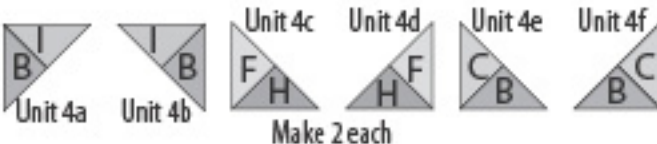

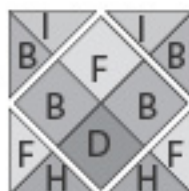
In the same manner, make 2 Unit 3b.

9. Sew 5-3/4" triangles together along their short sides to make 2 each Units 4a - 4f.



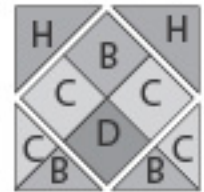
Make 2 each

10. Arrange 1 each Units 4a-4d around a Unit 3a. Stitch Units 4a-4d to Unit 3a. Make a total of 2 **Block 3** (9-1/2" square unfinished).



Block 3 - Make 2

11. Arrange 1 each Units 4e-4f and 2 **Fabric H** 5-3/8" triangles around a Unit 3b. Stitch Units 4e-4f and **Fabric H** triangles to Unit 3b. Make a total of 2 **Block 4** (9-1/2" square unfinished).

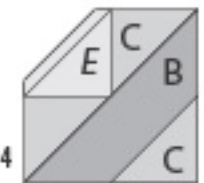
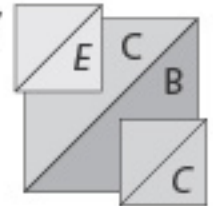


Block 4 - Make 2

12. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of each of the **Fabrics B, C, E, and F** 5" squares.



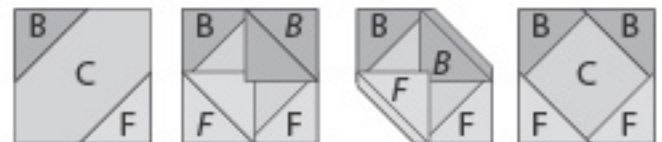
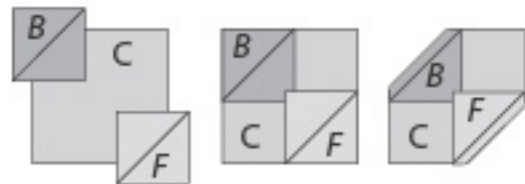
13. Stitch **Fabrics B** and **C** 9-7/8" triangles together along their long edges. Arrange **Fabrics C** and **E** marked 5" squares on corners as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press triangles out. Make a total of 4 **Block 5** (9-1/2" square unfinished).



Block 5 - Make 4

Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

14. Place marked **Fabrics B** and **F** 5" squares on opposite corners of a **Fabric C** 9-1/2" square as shown. Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press triangles out. Repeat on remaining corners of the **Fabric C** square. Make a total of 2 **Block 6** (9-1/2" square unfinished).



Block 6 - Make 2

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15. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.

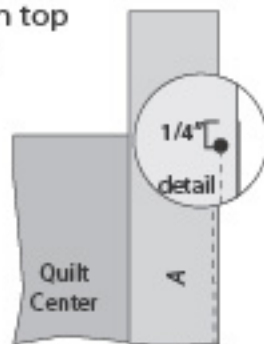
16. Arrange blocks in 6 rows. Stitch blocks into rows. Sew rows together to complete quilt center (45-1/2" x 54-1/2" unfinished).

17. Stitch **Fabric H** 1-1/2" x 54-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric H** 1-1/2" x 47-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

18. Stitch **Fabric J** 2-1/2" x 56-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric J** 2-1/2" x 51-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

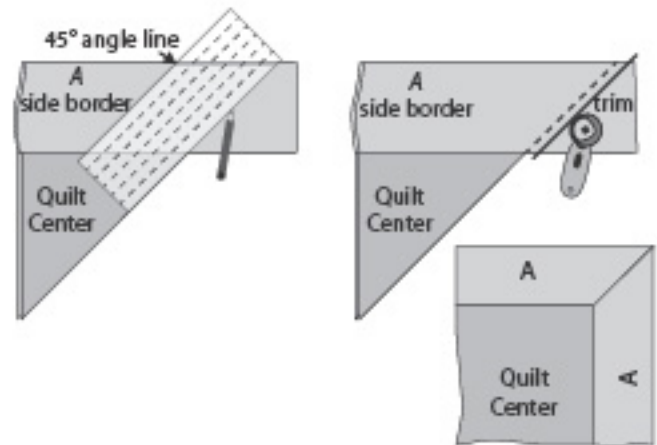
19. Center **Fabric A** 7" x 77" borders on right and left sides of quilt center and **Fabric A** 7" x 68" borders on top and bottom of quilt center.

Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out.



Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

20. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



21. The quilt measures approximately 64-1/2" x 73-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric K**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

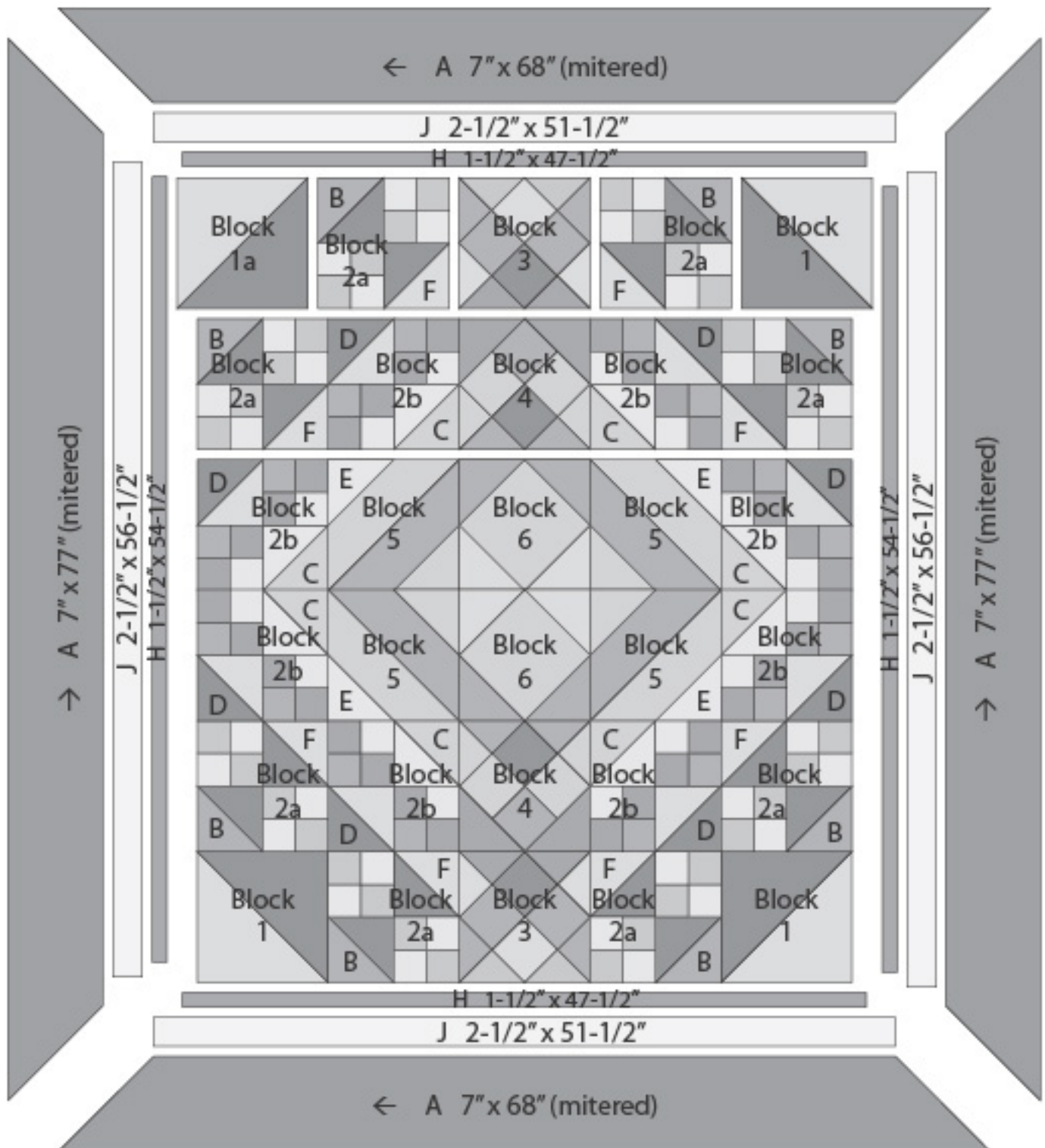
22. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric G**) and enjoy!!

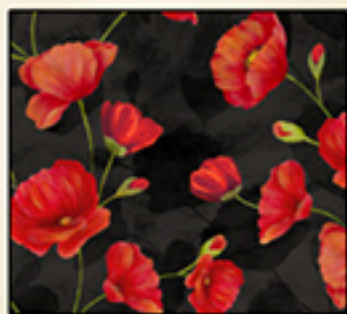
