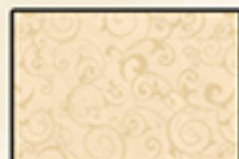

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# Midnight Poppies featuring Poppy Celebration

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.


All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.


## 1. Cut the following:

**Fabric A**- Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (1) 12-1/2" x 69", (1) 12-1/2" x 51", (1) 6" x 57", and (1) 6" x 39" stripe borders

**Fabric B** - Cut (1) 4-3/4" strip, subcut (8) 4-3/4" squares

**Fabric C** - Cut (2) 4-3/4" strips, subcut (12) 4-3/4" squares

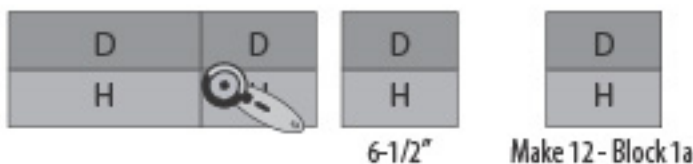
**Fabrics D and H** - From each fabric: Cut (2) 3-7/8" strips, subcut (12) 3-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally for 24 triangles   
Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips

**Fabrics E and F** - From each fabric: Cut (1) 3-7/8" strip, subcut (8) 3-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally for 16 triangles   
Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips

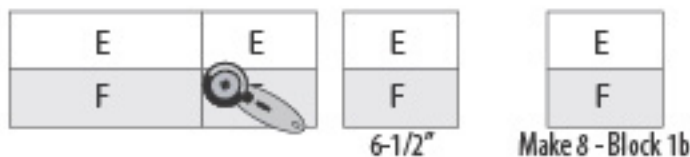
**Fabric G** - Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

## 2. Piecing Order:

1. Sew **Fabrics H** and **D** 3-1/2" strips together lengthwise. Make 2. From these, cut 12 **Block 1a** (6-1/2" square unfinished).



2. Sew **Fabrics E** and **F** 3-1/2" strips together lengthwise. Make 2. From these, cut 8 **Block 1b** (6-1/2" square unfinished).



3. Sew 2 **Fabric H** 3-7/8" triangles to adjoining sides of a **Fabric C** 4-3/4" square. Add **Fabric D** triangles to remaining sides to make 12 **Block 2a** (6-1/2" square unfinished).



Make 12 - Block 2a

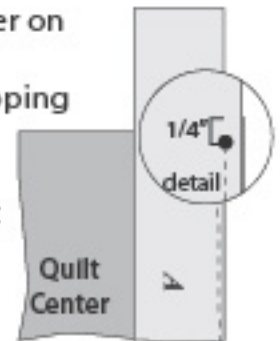
4. Sew 2 **Fabric F** 3-7/8" triangles to adjoining sides of a **Fabric B** 4-3/4" square. Add **Fabric E** triangles to remaining sides to make 8 **Block 2b** (6-1/2" square unfinished).



5. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 2) for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.

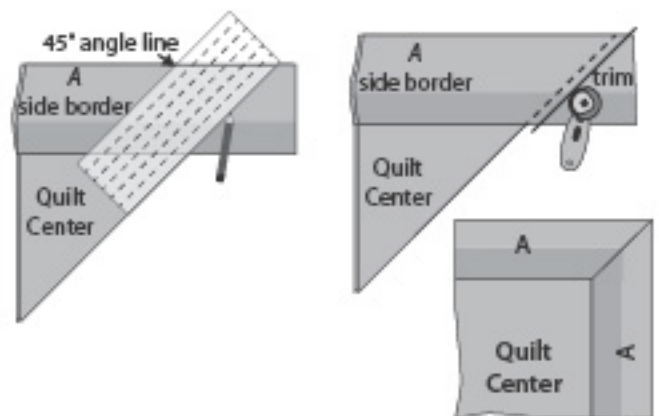
6. Arrange blocks in 8 rows with 5 blocks in each row. Sew blocks into rows. Sew rows together into quilt center (30-1/2" x 48-1/2" unfinished).

7. Sew **Fabric A** 6" x 57" border on right side of quilt center with bottom edges even, and stopping 1/4" from top edge of quilt center. Stitch **Fabric A** 6" x 39" border on top of quilt center with left edges even, and stopping 1/4" from right edge of quilt center. Do not trim. Press *Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.*



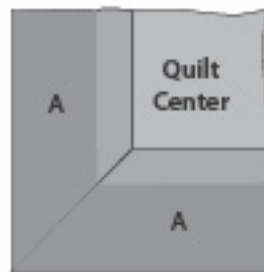

8. Fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open.



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9. In the same manner, add the 12-1/2" x 69" **Fabric A** border to the left side and 12-1/2" x 51" **Fabric A** border to the bottom of quilt center, mitering the bottom left corner.



10. The quilt measures approximately 48" x 66" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric I**) at least 8" larger than the top.

11. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric G**) and enjoy!!
