
Supplies

Hearts, Nine Patches and Binding: 12 Fat Quarters*

Background: 31/4 yards

Backing: 4½ yards


*Fat Quarter = 18" x 22"





A Sew the $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $46\frac{1}{2}$ " background strips to the quilt sides. Sew the $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $54\frac{1}{2}$ " background strips to the top and bottom.

Arrange and sew 5 nine patch As and 4 nine patch Bs as shown to make 1 side border. Make 2. Sew to the quilt sides. Arrange and sew 5 nine patch As and 6 nine patch Bs as shown to make top and bottom borders. Make 2. Sew to the top and bottom.



 $\label{eq:Sew 14-21/2"} \text{Sew 14-21/2" x 22" strips end to end to make the binding.} \\ \text{Layer, quilt and bind.}$



Hearts

Quilt is 66" x 66".

Cutting

Hearts, Nine Patches and Binding

From EACH of the 12 Fat Quarters cut

1-6½" x 22" strip

From the strip, cut 4-6½" x 4½" rectangles

4-21/2" x 22" strips

(You will have extra rectangles; 14-21/2" x 22" strips will be used for binding.)

Background

8-41/2" x width of fabric strips

From 2 strips, cut 16-4½" squares

Sew 6 strips end to end. From this long strip, cut $2-4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $54\frac{1}{2}$ " and

2-4½" x 46½" borders.

 $28-2\frac{1}{2}$ " x width of fabric strips

From the strips, cut 65-2½" squares, 32-2½" x 22" strips,

8-21/2" x 221/2" strips, and 8-21/2" x 101/2" strips



Construction Use 1/4" seams. Press in the direction of the arrows in the diagrams.

Nine Patches


(A) Join 2-2½" x 22" nine patch strips and 1-2½" x 22" background strip as shown. Make 12 strip sets. Cut into 92-2½" wide segments.



(B) Join 1-2½" x 22" nine patch strip and 2-2½" x 22" background strips as shown. Make 10 strip sets. Cut into 76-2½" wide segments.



(C) Join segments as shown to make one nine patch A. Repeat to make 36 nine patch As.




(D) Join segments as shown to make one nine patch B. Repeat to make 20 nine patch Bs.




) Hearts

(A) Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 64-2½" background squares. Layer a marked square right sides together on one end of a 6½" x 4½" heart rectangle. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim ¼" from the sewn line. Press to the corner to form a triangle. Repeat on the other end of the rectangle. Repeat to make 32 (16 matching pairs) heart tops.




Heart Tops Make 32.


(B) Join 2 matching heart tops, 1-4½" background square and a nine patch A to make 1 heart. Repeat to make 16 hearts.



3 (A) Arrange and sew 4 hearts, 2-2½" x 10½" and 1-2½" x 22½" background rectangle in 3 rows as shown. Join the rows. Repeat to make 4 heart blocks.



(B) Arrange and sew 4 heart blocks, 1-2½" background square and 4-2½" x 22½" background rectangles in 3 rows as shown. Join the rows.
