

Cutting

Blocks, Border, and Binding

From EACH of the 12 Fat Quarters cut:

 $1-3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22" strip; from the strip, cut $10-3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2" rectangles

2-2" x 22" strips; from 1 strip, cut 4-2" x 3½" rectangles and 1-2" square

2-2½" x 22" strips; from 1 strip, cut 4-2½" squares

 $1-1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22" strip (for the border)

Background and Borders

4-5" x width of fabric strips

From the strips, cut 8-5" x 22" strips

 $7-4\frac{1}{2}$ " x width of fabric strips; sew the strips end-to-end.

From this long strip, cut $2-4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 64" and $2-4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 60" borders

11-31/2" x width of fabric strips

From 4 strips, cut 8-3½" x 22" strips

From 7 strips, cut 80-3½" squares


19–2" x width of fabric strips; from 13 strips, cut 260–2" squares

Sew 6 strips end-to-end. From this strip, cut 2-2" x 59" and 2-2" x 50"


Use 1/4" seams. Press in the direction of the arrows in the diagrams.

Blocks A, B, and C Draw a diagonal line, from corner to corner, on the wrong side of the 160-2" background squares.


(A) Layer a marked 2" square, right sides together, on one end of a 3½" x 2" print rectangle as shown. Sew on the drawn line. Trim ¼" from the drawn line, press to make 1 unit A. Make 80 unit As.




(B) Layer a marked 2" square, right sides together, on one end of a 3½" x 2" print rectangle as shown. Sew on the drawn line. Trim ¼" from the drawn line, press to make 1 unit B. Make 80 unit Bs.




(C) Arrange and sew a unit A, a unit B, 1–2" background square, and 1–3½" background square in 2 rows as shown. Join the rows to make one corner C unit. Make 80 corner C units.




(D) Sew 1–2" x 22" and 1–3½" x 22" strip together as shown. Make 8 strip sets. Cut into 80-2" wide segments.




(E) Arrange and sew 4 corner Cs, 4 segments, and 1–2" background square in 3 rows as shown. Join the rows to make one basic block. Make 20.




(F) Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the back of 48–2½" print squares. Layer one marked 2½" square, right sides together, on one corner of a basic block as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim ¼" from the diagonal line and press to the corner to make 1 block A.










Block A 11" x 11" unfinished Make 4.


(G) Layer one marked 2½" square, right sides together, on 2 corners of a basic block as shown. Sew on the diagonal lines. Trim ¼" from the diagonal lines and press to the corners to make 1 block B. Make 10.







Block B 11" x 11" unfinished Make 10.

(H) Layer one marked $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square, right sides together, on 4 corners of a basic block as shown. Sew on the diagonal lines. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the diagonal lines and press to the corners to make 1 block C. Make 6.








Block C 11" x 11" unfinished Make 6.



 $2^{\rm Sew\ 1-2"\ x\ 22"}$ print and 2–5" x 22" background strips together as shown. Make 4 strip sets. Cut into 31–2" wide sashings.

Arrange and sew 4–A blocks


10-B blocks

31-sashings


12-2" print squares in 9 rows as shown.

Press away from the blocks and sashing.



Add the 2" x 59" background borders to the quilt sides.

Add the 2" x 50" background borders to the top and bottom.






5 Sew 12–1½" x 22" strips end-to-end. From this long strip cut 2–1½" x 62" strips and 1½" x 52" strips.

Add the 1½" x 62" strips to the quilt sides.

Add the 1½" x 52" strips to the top and bottom.





Add the 4½" x 64" background borders to the quilt sides.

Add the 4½" x 60" background borders to the top and bottom.

Sew 12–2½" x 22" print strips and the remainder of the 2½" wide print strips end-to-end to make the binding. Layer, quilt, and bind.
