1/4 yard Spider Web - Cream (H)
$2 / 3$ yard Metallic Dot - Black (I)
$2 / 3$ yard Decorative Scroll - Cream (J)
$31 / 2$ yards Cat Silhouettes - Black (Backing)

## Quilt Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Decorative Halloween Boxes - Black (A):

- Add fusible web to the back of the fabric and then fussy cut (11) assorted (your choice) blocks following the frame outline on each block.

From the Spider Web - Black (B), cut:
-(2) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (11) $6 \frac{1}{2} / 2$ squares.

- (3) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (44) 2" squares.

From the Decorative Pumpkins - Grey (C), cut:
-(1) $6 \frac{112 "}{}$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (5) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
From the Cat Silhouettes - Grey (D), cut:
-(1) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " $x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (4) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
From the Bird Silhouettes - Cream (E), cut:

- (1) $6 \frac{1}{2} " \mathrm{x}$ WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (5) $61 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Bird Silhouettes - Grey (F), cut:

- (1) $6^{1 / 2 "} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (3) $6 \frac{1}{2} "$ squares.

From the Decorative Halloween Stripe - Cream/Grey (G), cut:
-(2) $4 " \times 65 "$ strips from the length of fabric (LOF), centered on the thick border.

- (2) $4 " \times 58 "$ LOF strips.
-(2) $6 \frac{112 " x}{}$ x $40 "$ LOF strips.
-(2) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $33 "$ LOF strips.
From the Spider Web - Cream (H), cut:
- (1) $6 \frac{1}{2} 2$ " $\times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (17) 2 " $\times 6 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Metallic Dot - Black (I), cut:
-(1) 2 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (12) 2 " squares.
-(6) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Decorative Scroll - Cream (J), cut:
-(3) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (44) $2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Cat Silhouettes - Black (Backing), cut:

- (2) 62 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $62 " \times 69 "$ back.


## Sewing Instructions

1. Center a Fabric A block onto the center of (1) $6 \frac{1}{2} / 2$ Fabric B square. Press the block in place. Repeat for the remaining Fabric A blocks and $61 / 2 "$ Fabric B squares.

2. Finish the raw edges of each block with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make (11) applique blocks (Fig. 1).

8. Sew (1) $61 / 2 "$ Fabric E square, (4) $2 " \times 1 / 2 "$ Fabric J strips, (1) applique block, (1) $61 / 2 "$ Fabric F square, (1) $61 / 2 "$ Fabric D square and (1) $61 / 2 "$ Fabric C square together to make (1) EC strip. Repeat to make a second EC strip.
9. Sew (1) JB strip to each side of (1) EC strip to make the Left Side Border (Fig. 3).
10. Sew (1) JB strip to each side of (1) EC strip to make the Right Side Border (Fig. 4). Note: The orientation of the EC strip.

11. Sew (7) $2 "$ Fabric B squares, (6) $2 " \times 6 \frac{1}{2 "}$ Fabric J strips together to make (1) BB strip. Repeat to make (4) BB strips total.
12. Sew (7) $2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ Fabric J strips, (3) applique blocks, (1) $6 \frac{1}{2} "$ Fabric C square, (1) $61 / 2 "$ Fabric D square and (1) $61 / 2 "$ Fabric E square together to make (1) AA strip. Repeat to make a second AA strip.
7. Sew (5) $2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ Fabric J strips and (4) $2 "$ Fabric B squares together to make (1) JB strip. Repeat to make (4) JB strips total.

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13. Sew (1) BB strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) AA strip to make the Top Border (Fig. 5).

14. Sew (1) BB strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) AA strip to make the Bottom Border (Fig. 6). Note: The orientation of the AA strip.

## Quilt Top Assembly Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.

15. Center (1) $61 / 2 " \times 40 "$ Fabric G strip on one side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a $1 / 4 "$ from the top edge of the Center Block and stop a $1 / 40$ from the bottom edge. DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS. Repeat with the opposite side.
16. Repeat Step 15 to sew (1) $61 / 2 " \times 33 "$ Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start $1 / 4$ " away from each end of the Center Block. To miter each corner, fold the quilt top on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 7).
17. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 7), draw a 45 -degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners.

18. Sew the Left Side Border and the Right Side Border to the Center Block. Sew the Top Border and the Bottom Border to the Center Block to make the quilt top.
19. Repeat Steps $15-17$ using the 4 " $\times 65$ " Fabric G strip and the 4" x 58" Fabric G strip.
20. Layer and quilt as desired.
21. Sew the (6) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric I strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
22. Bind as desired.

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
