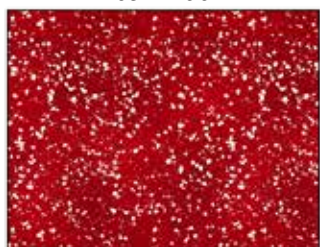

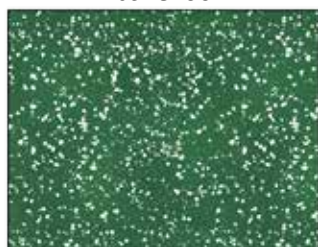

2/3 yard	Scenic - Red/Gray (A)	6541-98
1/2 yard	Swirl - Red (B)	6544-88
1/2 yard	Snowflakes - Gray (C)	6540-90
1 1/8 yards	Swirl - Green (D)	6544-66*
1 1/2 yards	Ornaments - White (E)	6543-8
1 1/8 yards	Snowflakes - Red (F)	6540-88
1/2 yard	Snow - Red (G)	6542-88
7/8 yard	Branches - White (H)	6545-6
1/4 yard	Holiday Tags - Gray (I)	6539-98
4 yards	Branches - Green (Backing)	6545-66

*Includes binding

Quilt Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Scenic - Red/Gray (A), cut:

- (1) 21 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (1) 17 1/2" x 21 1/2" strip.

From the Swirl - Red (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x 21 1/2" WOF strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (2) 2" x 20 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (44) 2 1/2" squares.

From the Snowflakes - Gray (C), cut:

- (3) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (26) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Swirl - Green (D), cut:

- (2) 2" x 32 1/2" WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x 31 1/2" WOF strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 56 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 55 1/2" strips.
- (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Ornaments - White (E), cut:

- (2) 7" x 31 1/2" WOF strips.
- (2) 7" x 35 1/2" length of fabric (LOF) strips.

From the Snowflakes - Red (F), cut:

- (1) 7" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (4) 7" squares.
- (3) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 1/2" x 59 1/2" strips.
- (3) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 1/2" x 55 1/2" strips.

From the Snow - Red (G), cut:

- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (92) 2 1/2" squares.

From the Branches - White (H), cut:

- (6) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (50) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Holiday Tags - Gray (I), cut:

- (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (4) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Branches - Green (Backing), cut:

- (2) 71" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 71" x 75" back.

Sewing Instructions

1. Place (1) 2 ½” Fabric B square on the top left corner of (1) 4 ½” Fabric C square, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle ¼” away from the sewn seam.

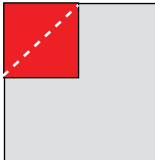

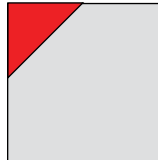

2. Follow Figure 3 for the seam direction to add a 2 ½” Fabric B to the upper right corner of the 4 ½” Fabric C to make (1) C block (Fig. 4).

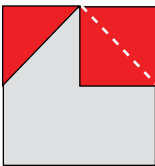

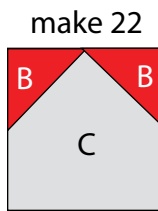

3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make (22) C blocks total.

4. Repeat Steps 1-2 using (46) 4 ½” Fabric H squares and (92) 2 ½” Fabric G squares to make (46) H blocks (Fig. 5).

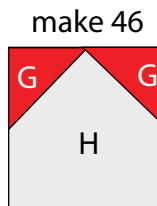

Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

5. Sew (1) 2” x 21 ½” Fabric B strip to each side of the 17 ½” x 21 ½” Fabric A strip. Sew (1) 2” x 20 ½” Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A strip to make the Center Block.

6. Sew (6) C blocks together to make (1) strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) strip to each side of the Center Block.

7. Sew (5) C blocks together to make (1) strip. Sew (1) 4 ½” Fabric C square to each end of the strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

8. Sew (1) 2” x 32 ½” Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2” x 31 ½” Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

9. Sew (1) 7” x 35 ½” Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 7” Fabric F square to each end of (1) 7” x 31 ½” Fabric E strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

10. Sew (12) H blocks together. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) strip to each side of the Center Block.

11. Sew (11) H blocks together. Sew (1) 4 ½” Fabric H square to each end of the strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

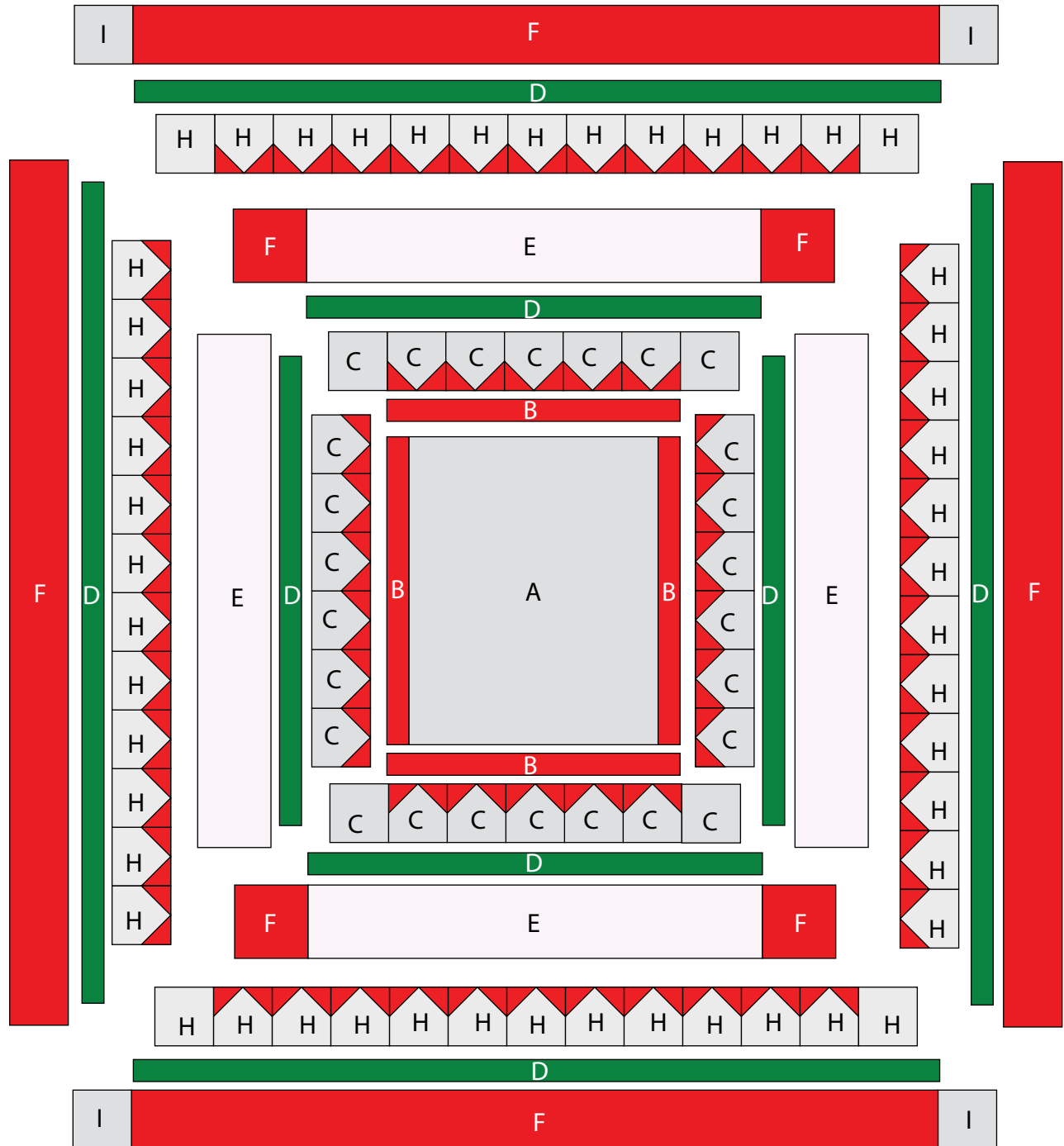
12. Sew (1) 2” x 56 ½” Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2” x 55 ½” Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

13. Sew (1) 4 ½” x 59 ½” Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 4 ½” Fabric I square to each end of (1) 4 ½” x 55 ½” Fabric F strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

14. Layer and quilt as desired.

15. Sew the (7) 2 ½” x WOF Fabric D strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

16. Bind as desired.
