

Winter Whispers

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following for Eagle Wall/Throw Quilt:

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, the panel has a coping border added then trimmed so the panel will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges wood print frame of panel to approximately 28-1/2" x 42"

Fabric D - Cut (5) 5" strips, sewn end to end and cut into (2) 5" x 47" borders and (2) 5" x 42-1/2" borders

Fabric E - Cut (6) 4" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 4" x 56" and (2) 4" x 49-1/2" borders

Fabric F - Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabric H - Cut (4) 3-1/2" strips, cut 2 strips into (2) 3-1/2" x 34-1/2" borders.

2. Piecing Order for Eagle Wall/Throw Ouilt:


- Refer to Eagle Throw/Wall Quilt Layout for arrangement and placement of panel and borders.
- Stitch Fabric H 3-1/2" strips to long sides of the Fabric A panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 3-1/2" x 34-1/2" Fabric H strips to top and bottom of panel. Trim bordered panel to 33-1/2" x 47" (unfinished).
- Sew Fabric D 5"x 47" borders to sides of quilt. Add Fabric D 5"x 42-1/2" borders to top and bottom.

- Sew Fabric E 4" x 56" borders to sides of quilt.
 Add Fabric E 4" x 49-1/2" borders to top and bottom.
- The wall/throw quilt measures approximately 49-1/2" x 63" (unfinished). Make backing (Fabric I) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric F) and enjoy!!

3. Cut the following for Deer Throw Quilt:

Fabric B - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, the panel has a coping border added then trimmed so the panel will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges wood print frame of panel to approximately 28-1/2" x 42"

Fabric C - Cut (2) 10-1/2" strips, subcut (8) 6"x 10-1/2" and (4) 3-1/4" x 10-1/2" rectangles

Fabric D - Cut (1) 34-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 3"x 34-1/2" borders the length of the fabric, parallel to the selvage.

From remainder of strip, cut (3) 3" x 32" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 3" x 53" borders

Fabric E - Cut (2) 6-1/4" strips, subcut (8) 6-1/4" squares [then cut in half diagonally twice for 32 triangles] and (20) 2-1/2" squares

Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut (16) 2-1/2" squares

Fabric F - Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (6) 2-1/2" x 3" pieces and (20) 2-1/2" squares Cut (3) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 45" borders Cut (2) 2" strips, subcut (2) 2" x 29" borders

Fabric G - Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips (binding) Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 2-1/2" x 6-1/2", (2) 2-1/2" x 4", (4) 2-1/2" x 3" pieces, and (12) 2-1/2" squares

Fabric H - Cut (3) 3-3/8" strips, subcut (30) 3-3/8" squares then cut in half diagonally once for 60 triangles Cut (1) 3" strip, subcut (20) 2" x 3" pieces

3. Piecing Order for Deer Throw Quilt:

1. Sew 2 Fabric H 3-3/8" triangles to short sides of a Fabric E 6-1/4" triangle. Make a total of 30 Unit 1 (3"x 5-1/2" unfinished).



Not all Fabric E triangles cut are used.

2. Align 3 Unit 1 in a vertical row. Stitch together. Make a total of 10 Unit 2 (5-1/2" x 8" unfinished).

Stitch a Fabric F 2-1/2" x 3"

(3" x 5-1/2" unfinished). In the

same manner, make 4 Unit 3b

with Fabric G pieces.



4. Stitch each Units 3a and 3b to bottom of a Unit 2 to make 6 **Block 1** and 4 **Block 2** (5-1/2" x 10-1/2" unfinished).

5. Refer to Deer Throw Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and

placement of panel, blocks, pieces, squares, and borders.

 Stitch Fabric F 2" x 29" borders to short sides of the Fabric B panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 2" x 45" Fabric F strips to top and bottom of panel. Trim bordered panel to 30-1/2" x 44" (unfinished).

7. Arrange 1 Fabric G 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" piece, 2 Fabric G 2-1/2" squares, 6 Fabric E 2-1/2" squares, and 4 Fabric F 2-1/2" squares in a vertical row on right side of bordered panel. Sew into vertical row (2-1/2" x 30-1/2" unfinished). Make an identical border for the left side. Add borders to right and left sides of bordered panel.


8. Arrange 1 Fabric G 2-1/2" x 4" piece, 4 Fabric G 2-1/2" squares, 12 Fabric E 2-1/2" squares, and 6 Fabric F 2-1/2" squares in a horizontal row on top of bordered panel. Sew into row (2-1/2" x 48" unfinished). Make an identical border for the bottom. Add borders to top and bottom of bordered panel.

 Sew Fabric D 3"x 34-1/2" borders to sides of quilt. Add Fabric D 3"x 53" borders to top and bottom.

- 10. Arrange 3 Block 1, 2 Block 2, 4 Fabric C 6" x 10-1/2" rectangles, and 2 Fabric C 3-1/4" x 10-1/2" rectangles in a horizontal row on top of quilt. Sew into a row (10-1/2" x 53" unfinished). Stitch to top of quilt. Repeat to make and add identical bottom border.
- 11. The quilt measures approximately 53"x 59-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (Fabric I) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- 12. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric G) and enjoy!!


