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Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.


All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following for Twin Quilt:

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 9" x 95" and (2) 9" x 71" multi-stripe borders


Fabrics C and E - From each fabric:

Cut (2) 8-3/8" strips, subcut (6) 8-3/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally  for 12 triangles] and (4) 1-7/8" x 18" strips
Cut (4) 1-7/8" strips, subcut (8) 1-7/8" x 18" strips

Fabric D - Cut (2) 8-3/8" strips, subcut (7) 8-3/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally  for 14 triangles]

Fabric F - Cut (12) 2-5/8" strips, subcut (24) 2-5/8" x 15-1/2" strips

Fabric G - Cut (6) 2-5/8" strips, subcut (12) 2-5/8" x 15-1/2" strips
Cut (9) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabric H - Cut (1) 8-3/8" strip, subcut (5) 8-3/8" squares [then cut in half diagonally in the same direction of the  strip for 10 triangles]

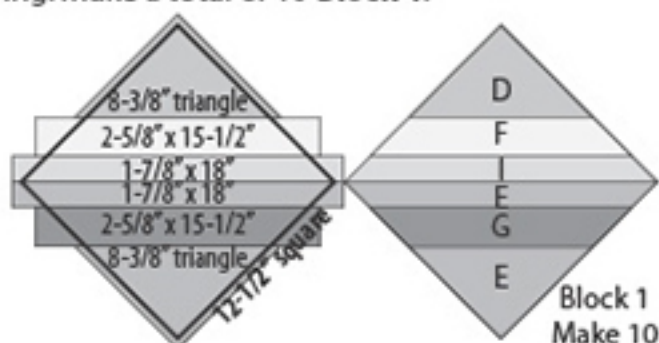
Cut (7) 1-3/4" strips, sewn together end to end with diagonal seams and cut into (2) 1-3/4" x 72-1/2" and (2) 1-3/4" x 51" borders

Fabric I - Cut (12) 1-7/8" strips, subcut (24) 1-7/8" x 18" strips

Fabric J - Cut (6) 2-5/8" strips, subcut (12) 2-5/8" x 15-1/2" strips

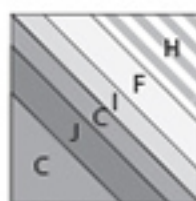
2. Piecing Order for Twin Quilt:

1. Sew **Fabrics E** and **I** 1-7/8" x 18" strips together lengthwise. Center a **Fabric F** 2-5/8" x 15-1/2" strip lengthwise on the **Fabric I** strip then stitch together. Repeat with a **Fabric G** 2-5/8" x 15-1/2" on the **Fabric E** strip. Sew 8-3/8" triangles on each side center on the 2-5/8" strips, **Fabric D** triangle on the **Fabric F** strip and a **Fabric E** triangle on the **Fabric G** strip. Trim block to 12-1/2" square. Stay stitch bias cut edges to prevent stretching. Make a total of 10 **Block 1**.

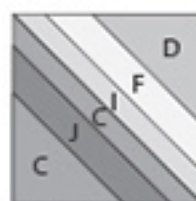

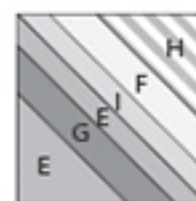
2. In the same manner, make 8 **Block 2**, 4 **Block 3** and 2 **Block 4**.

3. Refer to Twin Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.

4. Arrange blocks in 6 rows. Stitch blocks into rows. Sew rows together to complete twin quilt center (48-1/2" x 72-1/2" unfinished).

5. Sew **Fabric H** 1-3/4" x 72-1/2" borders to right and left sides of twin quilt center. Add **Fabric H** 1-3/4" x 51" borders to top and bottom of twin quilt center.

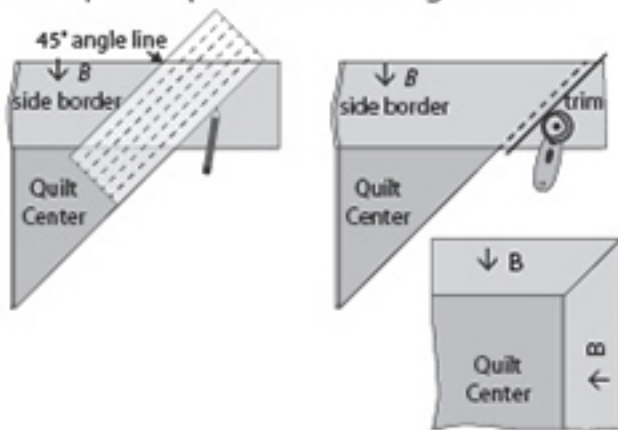
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6. Center **Fabric B** 9" x 95" borders on right and left sides of quilt center and **Fabric B** 9" x 71" borders on top and bottom of quilt center with the dark stripe next to quilt center. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out.



Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

7. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



8. The twin quilt measures approximately 68" x 92" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric K**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

9. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric G**) and enjoy!!

3. Cut the following for Door Banner and Placemats:

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, the panel has a coping border added then trimmed so the panel will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of panel to approximately 23-1/2" x 42-1/2"

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 3-1/2" x 45-1/2" and (2) 3-1/2" x 26-1/2" garland stripe borders, and (4) 5-1/4" x 18-1/2" ornament stripe strips

Fabric E - Cut (4) 3-3/4" strips, subcut (8) 3-3/4" x 18-1/2" strips and (4) 2-1/2" squares

Cut (5) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabric H - Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut

(4) 3-1/2" squares

Cut (4) 2-1/2" strips

Cut (4) 2" strips; subcut (8) 2" x 18-1/2" strips

Fabric K - Cut (2) 17" strips, subcut

(4) 17" x 21" rectangles for placemat backings

4. Piecing Order for Door Banner:

1. Refer to Door Banner Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of panel and borders.

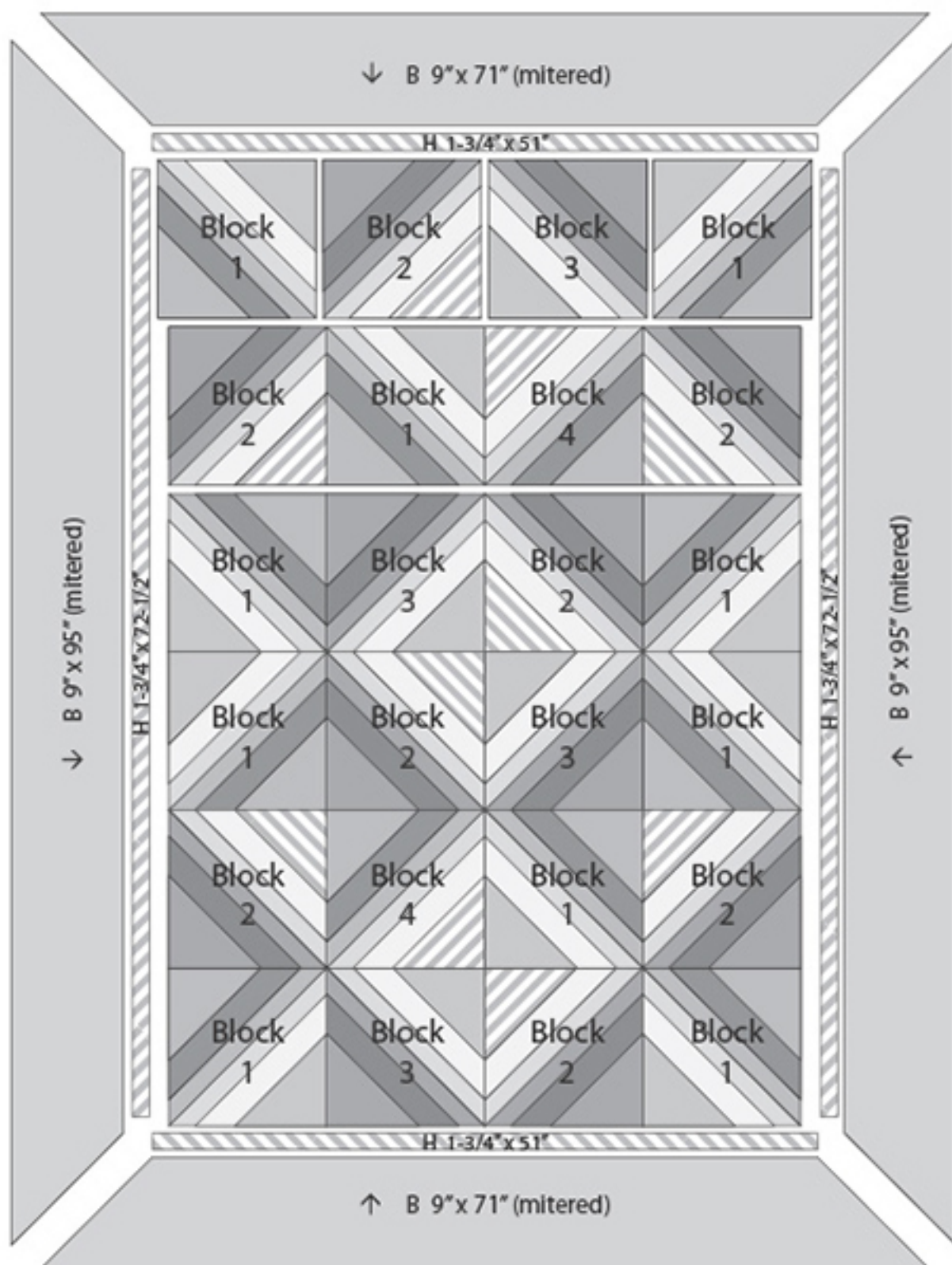
2. Trim 2 **Fabric H** 2-1/2" strips equal to the width of the **Fabric A** panel. Sew **Fabric E** 2-1/2" squares to both ends of each strip. Stitch **Fabric H** 2-1/2" x width of fabric strips to long sides of the **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add prepared **Fabric H** strips with **Fabric E** squares on ends to top and bottom of panel. *Trim bordered panel to 26-1/2" x 45-1/2" (unfinished).*

Border measurements are the cut size.

Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.



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4. Stitch **Fabric B** 3-1/2" x 45-1/2" borders to right and left sides of bordered panel. Stitch **Fabric H** 3-1/2" squares to both ends of each of the **Fabric B** 3-1/2" x 26-1/2" borders then add to the top and bottom of bordered panel.

5. The door banner measures approximately 32-1/2" x 51-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric K**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

6. Layer and baste door banner top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric E**) and enjoy!!

5. Piecing Order for Placemats:

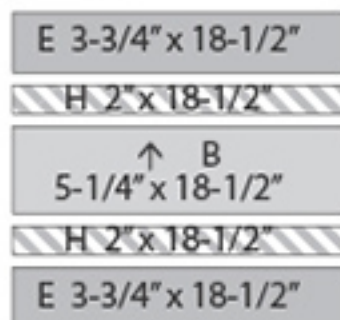
1. Refer to Placemat Layout for arrangement and placement of strips.

2. Stitch a **Fabric B** 5-1/4" x 18-1/2" strip between **Fabric H** 2" x 18-1/2" strips lengthwise. Sew **Fabric E** 3-3/4" x 18-1/2" strips lengthwise to each **Fabric H** strip. Make a total of 4 placemat tops (14-3/4" x 18-1/2" unfinished).

3. Layer each placemat top and backing (**Fabric K**) right sides together. Place a 17" x 21" batting piece on bottom. Stitch around all sides leaving a 4-5" opening on bottom edge. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Turn right sides out. Stitch opening closed. Quilt as desired and enjoy!!

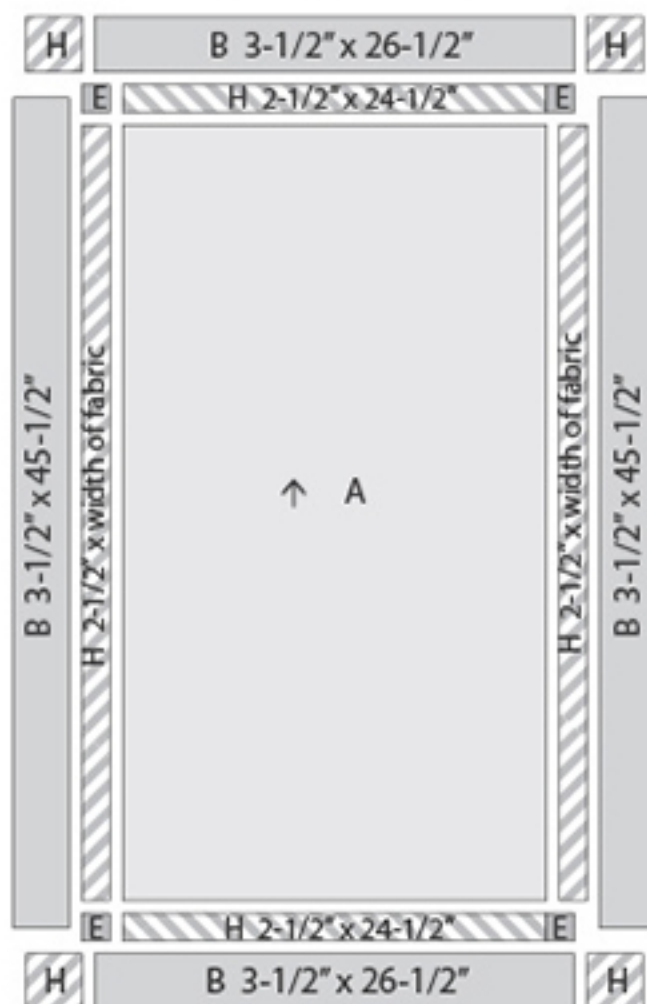
PLACEMAT LAYOUT

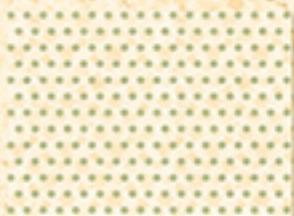

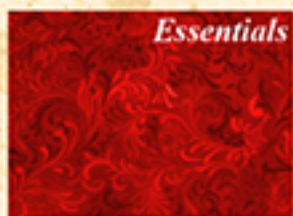
