



### Materials

¼ yard	Stacked Penguins - Multi (A)	F6533-98
⅞ yard	Dot - Red (B)	F6536-88*
⅔ yard	Dot - White/Red (C)	F6536-8
⅜ yard	Novelty Stripe - Multi (D)	F6537-98
¾ yard	Swirl - Gray/White (E)	F6534-90
⅝ yard	Squares - Multi (F)	F6535-98
⅜ yard	Swirl - Red (G)	F6534-88
1 ⅛ yards	Tossed Polar Bears - Gray (H)	F6532-90
3 ¼ yards	Swirl - White/Red (Backing)	F6534-8

\*Includes binding

### Quilt Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

#### From the Stacked Penguins - Multi (A), cut:

- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (4) 6 ½" squares.

#### From the Dot - Red (B), cut:

- (3) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (32) 3 ½" squares.
- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Dot - White/Red (C), cut:

- (2) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (16) 3 ½" squares.
- (2) 6 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (16) 3 ½" x 6 ½" strips.

#### From the Novelty Stripe - Multi (D), cut:

- (2) 5 ½" x 36 ½" WOF strips.

#### From the Swirl - Grey/White (E), cut:

- (1) 8 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (10) 3" x 8 ½" strips.
- (1) 13 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (10) 3" x 13 ½" strips.

#### From the Squares - Multi (F):

- Fussy cut (5) 8 ½" squares, each centered on a 4-patch block.

#### From the Swirl - Red (G), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 46 ½" strips.
- (2) 2" x 39 ½" WOF strips.

#### From the Tossed Polar Bears - Grey (H), cut:


- (6) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (4) 5 ½" x 49 ½" strips.

#### From the Swirl - White/Red (Backing), cut:

- (2) 57" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 57" x 67" back.

### Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) 3" x 8 ½" Fabric E strip to each side of (1) 8 ½" Fabric F square. Sew (1) 3" x 13 ½" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric F square. Trim the block to measure 12 ½" square to make (1) Block One (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (5) Block Ones.



2. Place (1) 3 ½" Fabric B square on the left side of (1) 3 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 2). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 2). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 3). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance.



3. Place another 3 ½" Fabric B square on the right side of the 3 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 4). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 4). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 5). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance to make (1) BCB unit.





4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make (16) BCB units total.

5. Sew (1) BCB unit to each side of (1) 6 ½" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 3 ½" Fabric C square to each end of (1) BCB unit. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Block Two (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (4) Block Twos total. Pay attention to the orientation of the BCB units.





## Quilt 2

### Quilt Top Assembly

*(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)*

6. Sew (1) Block One to each side of (1) Block Two to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three.
7. Sew (1) Block Two to each side of (1) Block One to make Row Two.
8. Sew the (3) rows together in numerical order to make the quilt top.
9. Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 36 1/2" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
10. Sew (1) 2" x 46 1/2" Fabric G strip each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) 2" x 39 1/2" Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
11. Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 49 1/2" Fabric H strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 49 1/2" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
12. Layer and quilt as desired.
13. Sew the (6) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
14. Bind as desired.
