J	Moose Crossing Scroll 4304-40 Pine	1/4 yd	(2) 2-7/8" x WOF strips, sub-cut (18) 2-7/8" squares.	
K	Bear with Honey Plaid 681-77 Brown	1/4 yd	(1) 6-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (6) 6-1/2" squares	
L	Diamond Weave 686-33 Honey	1/4 yd	(2) 2-7/8" x WOF strips, sub-cut (18) 2-7/8" squares	
M	Bear with Honey Plaid 681-44 Green	1/4 yd	(1) 6-1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (6) 6-1/2" squares	
N	Grass 687-44 Pine	1-1/2 yds	(2) 2-7/8" x WOF strips, sub-cut (18) 2-7/8" squares. (8) 5 1/2" x WOF strips*



R	Grass 687-07 Natural	2 yds	(11) 2-7/8" x WOF strips, sub-cut (144) 2-7/8" squares (3) 1-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (63) 1-1/2" squares (3) 2-1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (48) 2-1/2" squares (7) 2-1/2" x WOF strips*	

* SEW STRIPS VIA SHORT ENDS THEN GO TO BORDER ASSEMBLY
WOF/LOF=WIDTH/LENGTH OF FABRIC

BLOCK ASSEMBLY PROJECT USES PRECISE 1/4" SEAMS. TEST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE BY CUTTING (2) 2-1/2" X 5" RECTANGLES. STITCH THEM TOGETHER ALONG THE 5" LENGTH. AT THE MIDPOINT, MEASURE ACROSS THE UNIT. IT SHOULD BE EXACTLY 4-1/2" WIDE. IF NOT, ADJUST YOUR SEAM ALLOWANCE AND REPEAT.

BLOCKS

1. Place (1) E 2-7/8" square on top of (1) R 2-7/8" square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square. Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line. Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line to make (2) ER units. Trim the ER units to measure 2-1/2" square. Repeat to make (36) ER units total.



2. Repeat Step 1 using (18) F 2-7/8" squares and (18) R 2-7/8" squares to make (36) FR 2-1/2" units.

3. Repeat Step 1 using (18) G 2-7/8" squares and (18) R 2-7/8" squares to make (36) GR 2-1/2" units.

4. Repeat Step 1 using (18) H 2-7/8" squares and (18) R 2-7/8" squares to make (36) HR 2-1/2" units.

5. Repeat Step 1 using (18) J 2-7/8" squares and (18) R 2-7/8" squares to make (36) JR 2-1/2" units.




6. Repeat Step 1 using (18) L 2-7/8" squares and (18) R 2-7/8" squares to make (36) LR 2-1/2" units.

7. Repeat Step 1 using (18) N 2-7/8" squares and (18) R 2-7/8" squares to make (36) NR 2-1/2" units.


8. Repeat Step 1 using (18) P 2-7/8" squares and (18) R 2-7/8" squares to make (36) PR 2-1/2" units.




9. Sew (3) ER units together. Sew this strip to the left side of (1) A 6 1/2" square. Sew (1) R 2-1/2" square and (3) ER units together, in that order. Sew this strip to the top of the A square to make (1) Block One. Repeat to make (6) Block Ones total.




10. Sew (3) FR units together. Sew this strip to the right side of (1) B 6 1/2" square. Sew (3) FR units and (1) R 2-1/2" square together, in that order. Sew this strip to the top of the B square to make (1) Block Two. Repeat to make (6) Block Twos total.




11. Repeat Step 9 using (6) C 6-1/2" squares, (36) GR units and (6) R 2-1/2" squares to make (6) Block Threes.




12. Repeat Step 10 using (6) D 6-1/2" squares, (36) HR units and (6) R 2-1/2" squares to make (6) Block Fours.




13. Repeat Step 9 using (6) I 6-1/2" squares, (36) JR units and (6) R 2-1/2" squares to make (6) Block Fives.




14. Repeat Step 10 using (6) K 6-1/2" squares, (36) LR units and (6) R 2-1/2" squares to make (6) Block Sixes.



15. Repeat Step 9 using (6) M 6-1/2" squares, (36) NR units and (6) R 2-1/2" squares to make (6) Block Sevens.



16. Repeat Step 10 using (6) O 6-1/2" squares, (36) PR units and (6) R 2-1/2" squares to make (6) Block Eights.



17. Sew (7) R 1-1/2" squares and (6) Q 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips together, alternating them, to make (1) sashing strip. Repeat to make (9) sashing strips total.



QUILT ASSEMBLY

18. Sew (7) Q 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips and (6) assorted Blocks together to make (1) block row. Repeat to make (8) block rows total.

19. Sew the (9) sashing strips and (8) block rows together, alternating them, to make the quilt top.

BORDER ASSEMBLY MEASURE WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE QUILT TOP TO ENSURE R AND N BORDER SIZES, BELOW ARE OUR CUTTING SIZES.

20. Sew (1) R 2-1/2" x (73-1/2") strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) R 2-1/2" x (59-1/2") strips to the top and bottom of quilt top.

21. Sew (1) N 5-1/2" x (77-1/2") strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) N 5-1/2" x (69-1/2") strips to the top and bottom of quilt top.

FINISHING Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind as usual.

FINISHED SIZE: 69" x 87"
