Quilt is $62^{\prime \prime} \times 72^{\prime \prime}$.

## Supplies

Blocks \& Sashing Squares
12 Fat Quarters*

Sashing: 3/4 yard

Background and Border: 41/8 yards

Binding: 5/8 yard

Backing: 4½ yards

Lightweight interfacing
$21 / 8$ yards, $22^{\prime \prime}$ wide

Clear nylon thread
*Fat Quarter = 18" x 22"

Sew the $5 \frac{1}{1} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 62 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders to the quilt sides.
Sew the $5 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 62^{1} 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders to the top and bottom.
Layer, quilt and bind.

## Cutting

Blocks
From EACH of the 12 Fat Quarters cut
$3-3^{1 / 2}$ " x $22^{\prime \prime}$ strips ( 36 total, 6 are extra)
$2-2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares

## Sashing

$5-4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ width of fabric strips, from the strips, cut $9-41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 22^{\prime \prime}$ strips

## Background, Sashing and Border

$8-8 \frac{1}{2}$ " x width of fabric strips, from the strips, cut $30-81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
$7-5 \frac{1}{2} \mathrm{x} x$ width of fabric strips, sew the strips end to end.
From this long strip, cut $4-5 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 62 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders.
$5-4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x width of fabric strips, from the strips, cut $9-41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 22^{\prime \prime}$ strips
$2-2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} x$ width of fabric strips, from the strips, cut $21-2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares


## Construction Use $1 / 4$ "seams. Press in the direction of the arrows in the diagrams.

Pie
(A) Join 2 different $-3^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 22^{\prime \prime}$ strips using a small stitch length. Press the seam open. Make 15 strip sets. Align the pie template on the seam, cut. Cut 60 pies.

Cut 60 .
(B) Layer a pie interfacing on the right side of a pie. Stitch the top curve. Clip $3 / 16^{\prime \prime}$ into the seam allowance. Press the interfacing to the wrong side.


Make 60.
(C) Using clear nylon thread, appliqué 2 pies to an $81 / 2$ " background square as shown; use a zigzag or blind hem stitch. Stay stitch the edges of the block. Make 30.


## Blocks

$8^{1 / 2 "} \times 8^{1 / 2 "}$ unfinished Make 30.
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Sashing
Join a $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 22^{\prime \prime}$ sashing strip and a $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 22^{\prime \prime}$ background strip.
Make 9 strip sets. From the strip sets, cut 71 sashings, $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide.


Make 9 strip sets.

Arrange and sew 5 sashing units, 3-2 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fat Quarter squares, and $3-2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ background squares as shown to make row A. Make 4 row As. Arrange and sew 6 sashing units, and 5 blocks as shown to make row B. Make 3 row Bs.
Arrange and sew 5 sashing units, $3-2^{1 / 2} /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ Fat Quarter squares, and 3-212" background squares as shown to make row C. Make 3 row Cs.
Arrange and sew 6 sashing units, and 5 blocks as shown to make row D.
Make 3 row Ds. Join the rows.
