Quilt is 62" x 72".

Supplies

Blocks & Sashing Squares

12 Fat Quarters*

Sashing: $\frac{3}{4}$ yard

Background and Border: $4\frac{1}{8}$ yards

Binding: $\frac{5}{8}$ yard

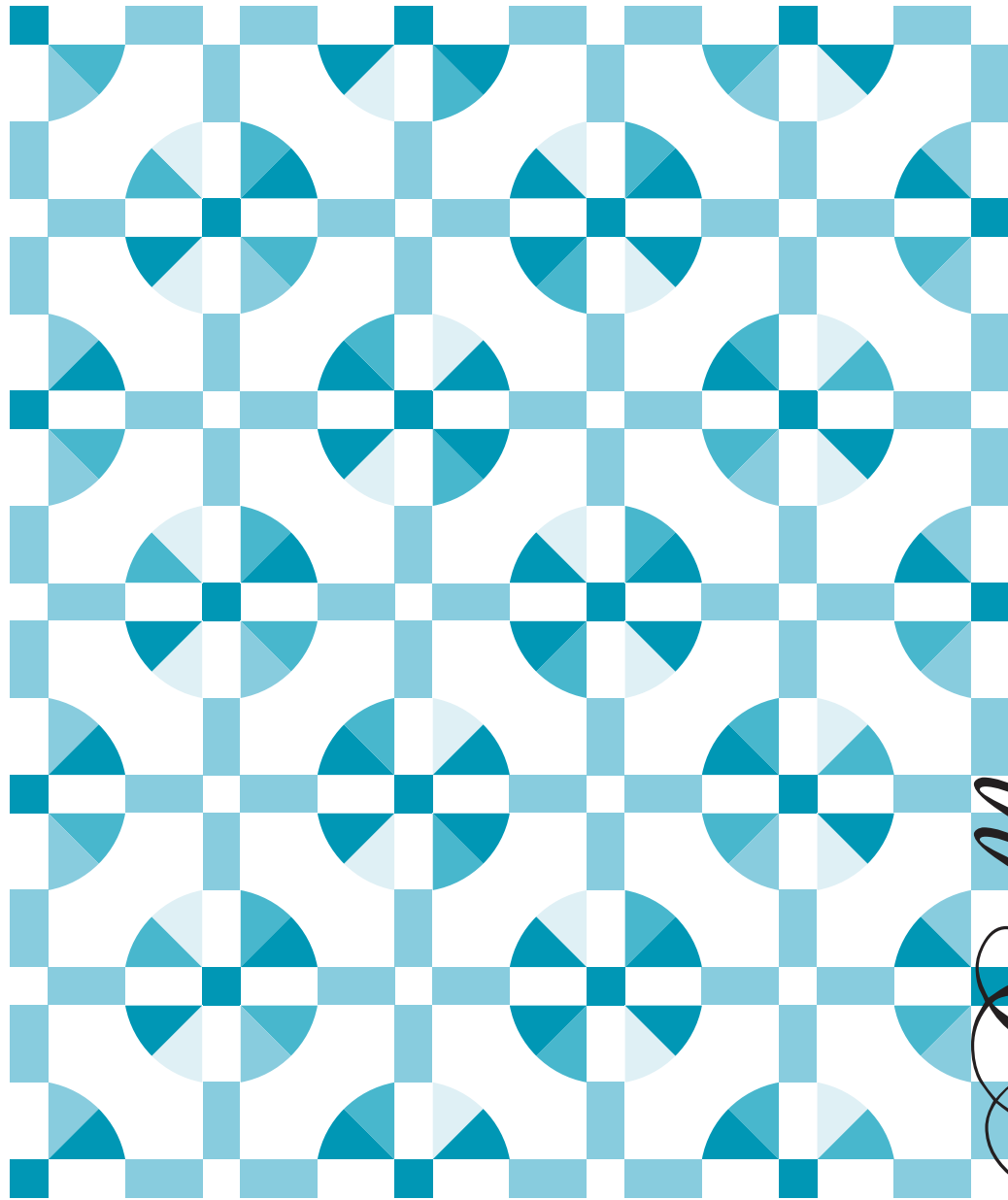
Backing: $4\frac{1}{2}$ yards

Lightweight interfacing

$2\frac{1}{8}$ yards, 22" wide

Clear nylon thread

*Fat Quarter = 18" x 22"

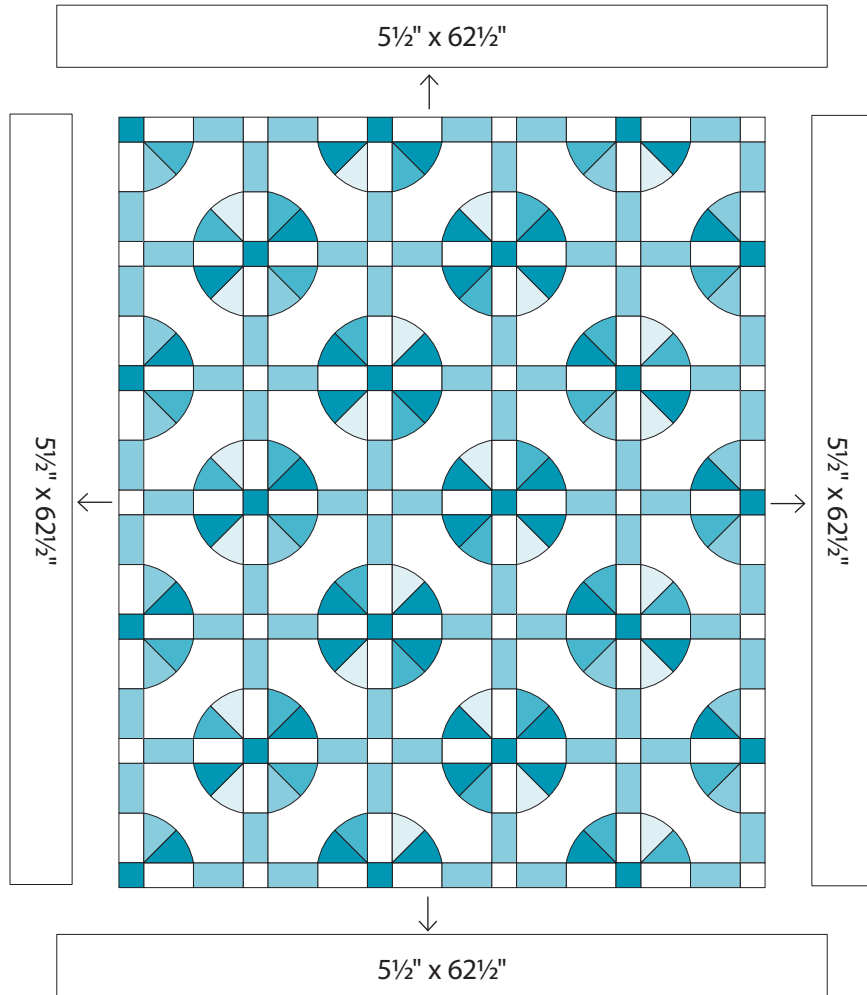


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- 4 Sew the $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $62\frac{1}{2}$ " borders to the quilt sides.
 Sew the $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $62\frac{1}{2}$ " borders to the top and bottom.
 Layer, quilt and bind.



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Cutting

Blocks

From EACH of the 12 Fat Quarters cut
 3- $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22" strips (36 total, 6 are extra)
 2- $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

Sashing

5- $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x width of fabric strips, from the strips, cut 9- $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22" strips

Background, Sashing and Border

8- $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x width of fabric strips, from the strips, cut 30- $8\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

7- $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x width of fabric strips, sew the strips end to end.

From this long strip, cut 4- $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $62\frac{1}{2}$ " borders.

5- $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x width of fabric strips, from the strips, cut 9- $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22" strips

2- $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x width of fabric strips, from the strips, cut 21- $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

Binding

7- $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x width of fabric strips

Sew end to end to make the binding.

Interfacing

60 pie pieces

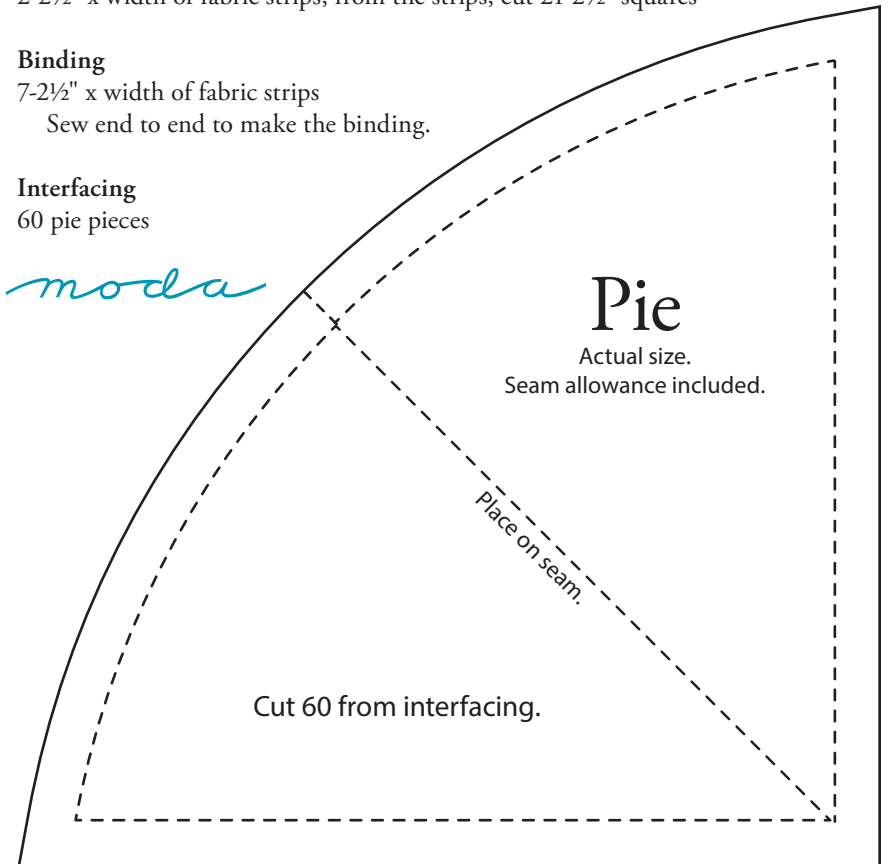
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Pie

Actual size.
 Seam allowance included.

Place on seam.

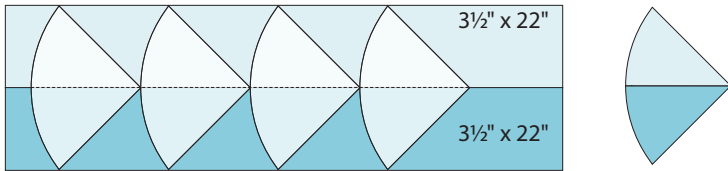
Cut 60 from interfacing.



Construction Use $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams. Press in the direction of the arrows in the diagrams.

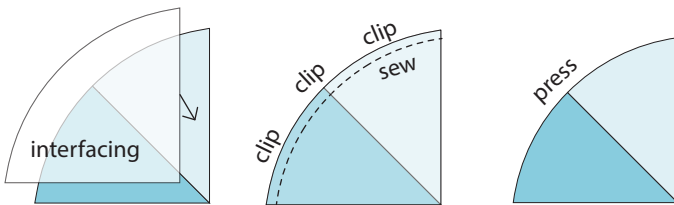
1 Pie

- (A) Join 2 different- $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22" strips using a small stitch length. Press the seam open. Make 15 strip sets. Align the pie template on the seam, cut. Cut 60 pies.



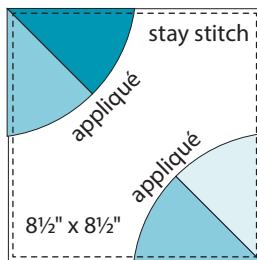
Make 15 strip sets.

- (B) Layer a pie interfacing on the right side of a pie. Stitch the top curve. Clip $\frac{3}{16}$ " into the seam allowance. Press the interfacing to the wrong side.



Make 60.

- (C) Using clear nylon thread, appliqué 2 pies to an $8\frac{1}{2}$ " background square as shown; use a zigzag or blind hem stitch. Stay stitch the edges of the block. Make 30.

 $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished
Make 30.

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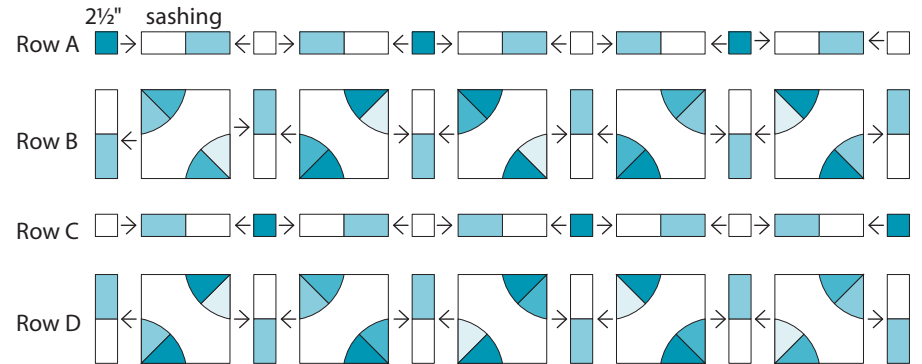
2 Sashing

- Join a $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22" sashing strip and a $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22" background strip. Make 9 strip sets. From the strip sets, cut 71 sashings, $2\frac{1}{2}$ " wide.



Make 9 strip sets.

- 3 Arrange and sew 5 sashing units, $3-2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fat Quarter squares, and $3-2\frac{1}{2}$ " background squares as shown to make row A. Make 4 row As. Arrange and sew 6 sashing units, and 5 blocks as shown to make row B. Make 3 row Bs. Arrange and sew 5 sashing units, $3-2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fat Quarter squares, and $3-2\frac{1}{2}$ " background squares as shown to make row C. Make 3 row Cs. Arrange and sew 6 sashing units, and 5 blocks as shown to make row D. Make 3 row Ds. Join the rows.
