Pie

Quilt is 62" x 72".

Supplies

Blocks & Sashing Squares 12 Fat Quarters*

Sashing: 3/4 yard

Background and Border: 41/8 yards

Binding: 5/8 yard


Backing: 4½ yards

Lightweight interfacing 21/8 yards, 22" wide

Clear nylon thread

*Fat Quarter = 18" x 22"






Sew the 5½" x 62½" borders to the quilt sides.

Sew the 5½" x 62½" borders to the top and bottom.

Layer, quilt and bind.



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Pie

Quilt is 62" x 72".

Cutting

Blocks

From EACH of the 12 Fat Quarters cut 3-3½" x 22" strips (36 total, 6 are extra) 2-2½" squares

Sashing

5-4½" x width of fabric strips, from the strips, cut 9-4½" x 22" strips


Background, Sashing and Border

 $8\text{-}8\frac{1}{2}$ x width of fabric strips, from the strips, cut 30-8½" squares 7-5½" x width of fabric strips, sew the strips end to end.

From this long strip, cut 4-5½" x 62½" borders.

5-4½" x width of fabric strips, from the strips, cut 9-4½" x 22" strips


 $2-2\frac{1}{2}$ " x width of fabric strips, from the strips, cut $21-2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares




Construction Use 1/4" seams. Press in the direction of the arrows in the diagrams.

Pie


(A) Join 2 different- $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22" strips using a small stitch length. Press the seam open. Make 15 strip sets. Align the pie template on the seam, cut. Cut 60 pies.






Make 15 strip sets.

(B) Layer a pie interfacing on the right side of a pie. Stitch the top curve. Clip 3/16" into the seam allowance. Press the interfacing to the wrong side.



(C) Using clear nylon thread, appliqué 2 pies to an 8½" background square as shown; use a zigzag or blind hem stitch. Stay stitch the edges of the block. Make 30.



2 Sashing
Join a 4½" x 22" sashing strip and a 4½" x 22" background strip.
Make 9 strip sets. From the strip sets, cut 71 sashings, 2½" wide.



Make 9 strip sets.

Arrange and sew 5 sashing units, 3-2½" Fat Quarter squares, and 3-2½" background squares as shown to make row A. Make 4 row As. Arrange and sew 6 sashing units, and 5 blocks as shown to make row B. Make 3 row Bs.

Arrange and sew 5 sashing units, 3-2½" Fat Quarter squares, and 3-2½" background squares as shown to make row C. Make 3 row Cs. Arrange and sew 6 sashing units, and 5 blocks as shown to make row D. Make 3 row Ds. Join the rows.
