$\frac{1}{3}$ yard	Cardinals - White/Red (C)	6620-48
$\frac{1}{2}$ yard	Feathers - Brown (D)	6621-33
$\frac{5}{8}$ yard	Pinecones - Brown (E)	6619-33
$\frac{3}{4}$ yard	Branches - Brown/Cream (F)	6618-34
$\frac{1}{4}$ yard	Plaid - Green/Red (G)	6616-66
1 $\frac{3}{4}$ yards	Wood Texture - Cream (H)	6617-44
2 yards	Wildlife Allover - Multi (I)	6622-44
$\frac{1}{4}$ yard	Feathers - Red (J)	6621-88
5 yards	Branches - Green/Cream (Backing)	6618-64

Quilt Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Animal Squares Panel - Multi (A):

- Fussy cut (12) 9" x 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " blocks.

From the Plaid - Red/Brown (B), cut:

- (5) 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (24) 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (8) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (24) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (2) 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (6) 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (6) 2" x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (8) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Cardinals - White/Red (C), cut:

- (2) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (15) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the Feathers - Brown (D), cut:

- (7) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (60) 2" x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Pinecones - Brown (E), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (60) 2" squares.
- (4) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 63 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (3) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 55 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Branches - Brown/Cream (F), cut:

- (12) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (60) 2" x 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Plaid - Green/Red (G), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (60) 2" squares.

From the Wood Texture - Cream (H), cut:

- (2) 2" x 60 $\frac{1}{2}$ " length of fabric (LOF) strips.
- (3) 2" x 53 $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips from the remaining fabric, piece as needed.

From the Wildlife Allover - Multi (I), cut:

- (2) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 65 $\frac{1}{2}$ " LOF strips.
- (2) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 55 $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips from the remaining fabric, piece as needed.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (3) 9" x 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Feathers - Red (J), cut:

- (1) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (4) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the Branches - Green/Cream (Backing), cut:

- (2) 85" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 75" x 85" back.

Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side (1) 9 " x $7\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A block. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $11\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A block. Trim the block to measure $10\frac{1}{2}$ " square to make (1) Block One (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (12) Block Ones total.

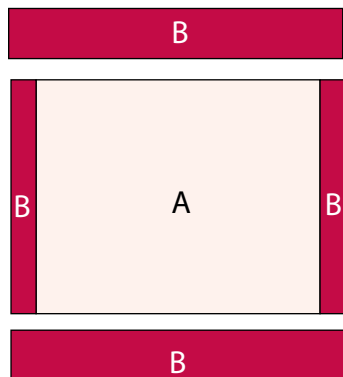

2. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $7\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side (1) 9 " x $7\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip. Sew (1) 2 " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric I square to make (1) Block Two (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (3) Block Twos total.

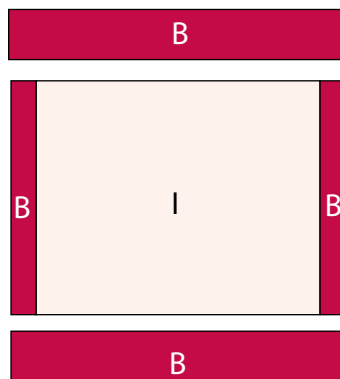

3. Sew (1) 2 " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to each side of (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C square. Sew (1) 2 " Fabric E square to each end of (1) 2 " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric C square to make (1) C block (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (15) C blocks total.

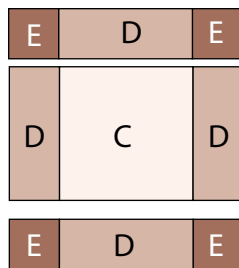

4. Sew (1) 2 " x $7\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to each side of (1) C block. Sew (1) 2 " Fabric G square to each end of (1) 2 " x $7\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the C block to make (1) Block Three (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (15) Block Threes total.

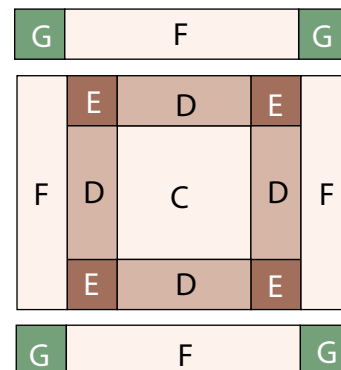

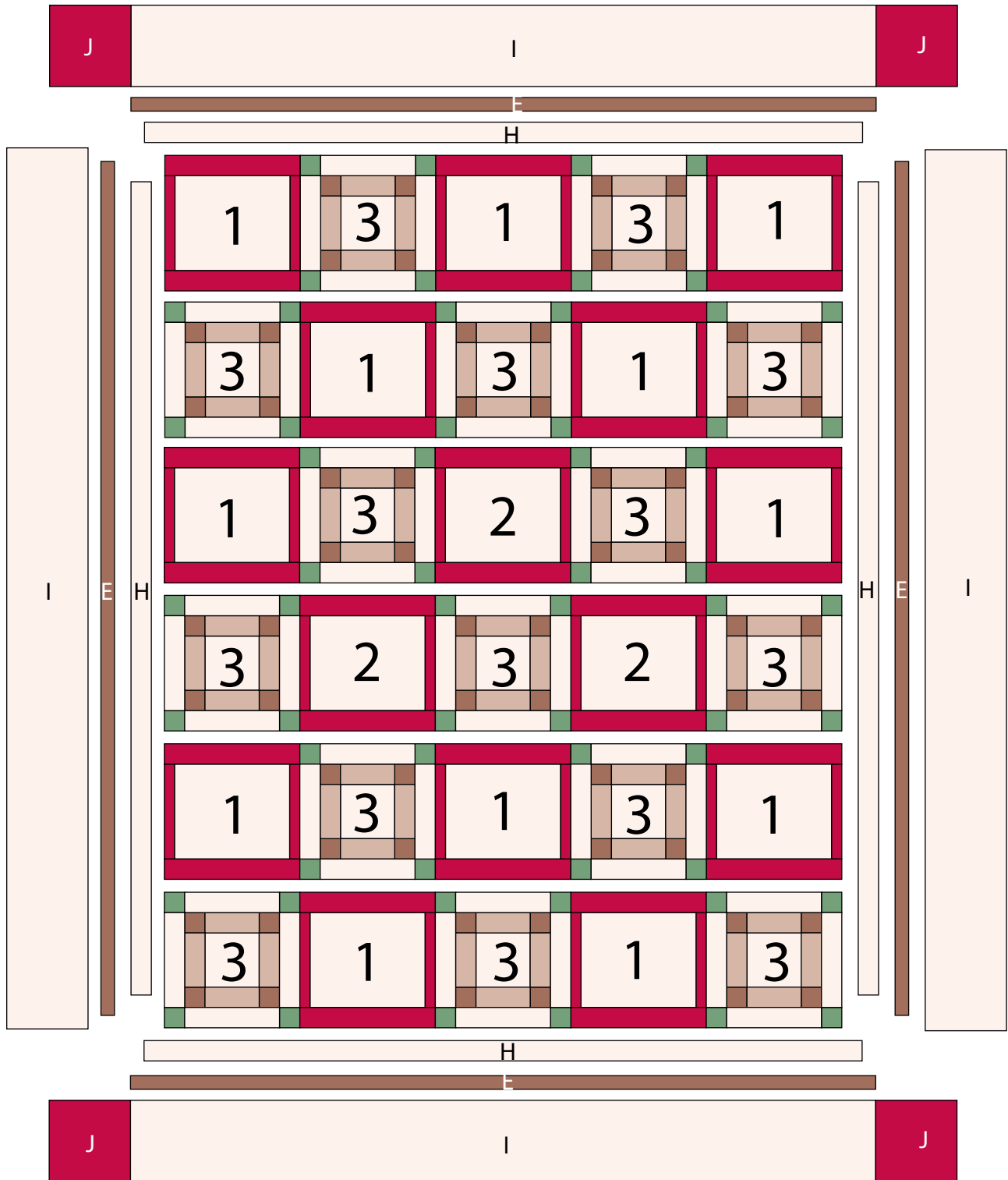
Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the *Quilt Layout while assembling.*)

- (3) Block Ones and (2) Block Threes together, alternating them, to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Five.
- Sew (3) Block Threes and Two Block Ones, alternating them, to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Six.
- Sew (1) Block One, (1) Block Three, (1) Block Two, (1) Block Three and (1) Block One together, in that order, to make Row Three.
- Sew (3) Block Threes and (2) Block Twos together, alternating them, to make Row Four.
- Sew the (6) rows together in numerical order to make the quilt top.
- Sew (1) 2 " x $60\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) 2 " x $53\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
- Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $63\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $55\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
- Sew (1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $65\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J square to each end of (1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $55\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
- Layer and quilt as desired.
- Sew the (8) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- Bind as desired.
