$1 / 3$ yard Cardinals - White/Red (C)
$1 / 2$ yard Feathers - Brown (D)
$5 / 8$ yard Pinecones - Brown (E)
$3 / 4$ yard Branches - Brown/Cream (F)
$1 / 4$ yard Plaid - Green/Red (G)
$13 / 4$ yards Wood Texture - Cream (H)
2 yards Wildlife Allover - Multi (I)
$1 / 4$ yard Feathers - Red (J)
5 yards Branches - Green/Cream (Backing)

## Quilt Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Animal Squares Panel - Multi (A):
-Fussy cut (12) 9"x 7 1/2" blocks.
From the Plaid - Red/Brown (B), cut:

- (5) $13 / 4$ " $\times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (24) $13 / 4$ " $\times 1 / 2 "$ strips.
- (8) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (24) $21 / 2 " \times 111 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " $\times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (6) $11 / 4 " \times 71 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (6) $2 " \times 101 / 2 "$ strips.
- (8) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.

From the Cardinals - White/Red (C), cut:
-(2) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (15) $41 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Feathers - Brown (D), cut:
-(7) $2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (60) $2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.
From the Pinecones - Brown (E), cut:
-(3) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (60) 2 " squares.

- (4) $11 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 631 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) $11 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 551 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Branches - Brown/Cream (F), cut:
-(12) $2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (60) $2 " \times 71 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Plaid - Green/Red (G), cut:
-(3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (60) 2" squares.
From the Wood Texture - Cream (H), cut:

- (2) 2 " $\times 601 / 2 "$ length of fabric (LOF) strips.
- (3) 2 " $\times 531 / 2 "$ WOF strips from the remaining fabric, piece as needed.

From the Wildlife Allover - Multi (I), cut:

- (2) $61 / 2 " \times 651 / 2 "$ LOF strips.
- (2) $6^{1 / 2 "} \times 55^{1 / 2 "}$ WOF strips from the remaining fabric, piece as needed.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (3) $9^{\prime \prime} \times 7 \frac{1}{2} "$ strips.

From the Feathers - Red (J), cut:
-(1) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (4) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
From the Branches - Green/Cream (Backing), cut:

- (2) 85 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $75 " \times 85 "$ back.


## Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) $13 / 4 " \times 71 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side (1) $9 " \times 71 / 2 "$ Fabric A block. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 111 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A block. Trim the block to measure $101 / 2 "$ square to make (1) Block One (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (12) Block Ones total.

Trim to measure $10^{1 / 2 \prime 2^{\prime \prime}} \times 10^{1 / 2^{\prime \prime}}$ after the borders are added

2. Sew (1) $11 / 4 " \times 71 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side (1) 9 " $\times 71 / 2 "$ Fabric I strip. Sew (1) 2" x $101 / 2$ "
Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric I square to make (1) Block Two (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (3) Block Twos total.

3. Sew (1) $2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to each side of (1) $41 / 2$ " Fabric C square. Sew (1) 2" Fabric E square to each end of (1) 2 " $\times 41 / 2$ " Fabric D strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric C square to make (1) C block (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (15) C blocks total.

4. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 71 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip to each side of (1) C block. Sew (1) 2" Fabric G square to each end of (1) 2 " $\times 71 / 2$ " Fabric G strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the C block to make (1) Block Three (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (15) Block Threes total.

## Quilt Top Assembly

## (Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

5. (3) Block Ones and (2) Block Threes together, alternating them, to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Five.
6. Sew (3) Block Threes and Two Block Ones, alternating them, to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Six.
7. Sew (1) Block One, (1) Block Three, (1) Block Two, (1) Block Three and (1) Block One together, in that order, to make Row Three.
8. Sew (3) Block Threes and (2) Block Twos together, alternating them, to make Row Four.
9. Sew the (6) rows together in numerical order to make the quilt top.
10. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 601 / 2$ " Fabric H strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) $2 " \times 531 / 2 "$ Fabric $H$ strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
11. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 631 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 55^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
12. Sew (1) $61 / 2 " \times 65^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric I strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) $61 / 2$ " Fabric J square to each end of (1) $61 / 2 " \times 551 / 2$ " Fabric I strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
13. Layer and quilt as desired.
14. Sew the (8) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
15. Bind as desired.
