**Blocks:** 6 light Fat Quarters\* 6 dark Fat Quarters

Inner Border & Border (light): 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> yards

Border (dark): 1 yard


Binding: 5/8 yard

Backing: 41/8 yards



Sew 1-6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 26" light and dark border strip together. Make 2. Sew 4 to each side of the quilt. Sew 1-6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 32" light and dark border strip together. Make 2. Sew to the quilt top and bottom.



# Slice & Dice

Quilt is 63" x 63".

#### Cutting

Blocks (light and dark): From EACH of the 12 Fat Quarters cut: 3-5" x 22" strips

#### Inner Border and Border (light):

 $2-6\frac{1}{2}$ " x 32" strips for the border  $2-6\frac{1}{2}$ " x 26" strips for the border 6-2" x width of fabric strips Sew the strips end to end. From this long strip cut 2-2" x 511/2" and 2-2" x 481/2" strips for the inner border.

Border (dark):  $2-6\frac{1}{2}$ " x 32" strips for the border  $2-6\frac{1}{2}$ " x 26" strips for the border

#### **Binding:**

 $7-2\frac{1}{2}$ " x width of fabric strips. Sew the strips end to end to make the binding.

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
**5** Layer, quilt and bind.




### Construction


Use 1/4" seams. Press in the direction of the arrows in the diagrams.

Sew 1 light and 1 dark 5" x 22" strip together as shown. Make 18 strip sets. Cut four 5" wide segments from each strip set, for a total of 72 (36 matching pairs).




## **7** To make 1 block:







(B) Cut 1-1¾" wide unit from the top and bottom of the four-patch. Trim these 2 units as shown.




(C) Cut  $1-1\frac{3}{4}$ " x 6" unit from the left and right of the four-patch.



(D) Join the units from C to the sides of the four-patch; join the units from B to the top and bottom to make the block. Make 36.



3 Sew 6 blocks together to make 1 row, make 6 total. Press the rows in opposite directions. Join the rows. Add 1-2" x 48½" inner border to each side of the quilt center. Add 1-2" x  $51\frac{1}{2}$ " inner border to the top and bottom.



Quilt is 51<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 51<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"unfinished.
