## Star Shine

Quilt is $581 / 21 \times 761^{1} 2^{\prime \prime}$ ．

## Supplies

Dark Blocks（Stars）： 8 assorted Fat Quarters＊

Light Blocks： 6 assorted Fat Quarters

Background：21／8 yards
Binding：$\quad 5 / 8$ yard

Backing： $43 / 4$ yards
＊Fat Quarter＝18＂x 22＂

3 Join the rows. Layer, quilt and bind.


## Star Shine

## Cutting

Dark Blocks (Stars)
From EACH of the 8 assorted Dark Fat Quarters cut $2-5^{\prime \prime} \times 22^{\prime \prime}$ strips

From the strips, cut $6-5^{\prime \prime}$ squares and $8-2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares $2-2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 22^{\prime \prime}$ strips

From the strips, cut $16-2 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares

## Light Blocks

From EACH of the 6 assorted Light Fat Quarters cut
$3-5^{\prime \prime} \times 22^{\prime \prime}$ strips
From the strips, cut $12-5^{\prime \prime}$ squares (There will be 9 extra squares.)

## Background

$14-5 " \mathrm{x}$ width of fabric strips
From the strips, cut 110-5" squares

## Binding

$7-2^{1 / 2} \mathrm{x} \mathrm{x}$ width of fabric strips
Sew end to end to make the binding.


## Construction Use $1 / 4$ "seams. Press in the direction of the arrows in the diagrams.

1On your design wall or on the floor, away from curious children and pets, arrange 9 rows of 7 light blocks each (Row A), alternated with 8 rows of 6 dark blocks (Row B). Leave 5 " space between the blocks for placing star point blocks.


2
Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the $21 / 2 "$ dark squares. Fill the spaces on your design wall or floor with the 5 " background squares. These will become Blocks C and D.
(A) Block C: Select the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ dark square that matches the adjacent $5^{\prime \prime}$ dark square. Layer the marked square and a $5^{\prime \prime}$ background square right sides together as shown. Sew on the diagonal line, trim, and press to form the triangle.

(B) Block D: Select the $2-2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ dark squares that match the $5^{\prime \prime}$ adjacent dark squares. Layer the marked squares and a 5 " background square right sides together as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Sew on the diagonal line, trim, and press to form triangles.

(C) Fill the spaces with either C or D blocks as shown. Press toward the unpieced squares in each row. Join the blocks in the rows.
