Stars & 4 Patches

Quilt is 72½" x 90".

Supplies

Stars, Four Patches and Sashing Squares: 12 assorted Fat Quarters*


Background and Border: 43/4 yards

Binding: 3/4 yard


Backing: 5½ yards

*Fat Quarter=18" x 22"






4 Assemble the quilt top: Arrange the blocks, sashing rows, and 3" x 15½" sashing strips as shown. Note the position of the A, B and C units. Sew the blocks and sashing strips into rows. Sew the block rows and sashing rows together.



Add the borders and binding: Add the 3" x 85½" borders to the sides of the quilt top. Add the 3" x 73" borders to the top and bottom. Layer, quilt and bind.



Stars & 4 Patches Quilt is 721/2" x 90".

Cutting

Stars, Four Patches and Sashing Squares

From EACH of 8 Fat Quarters cut:

2-61/4" x 22" strips

From the strips, cut $4-6\frac{1}{4}$ " squares and $2-5\frac{1}{2}$ " squares to make 2 stars 1-3" x 22" strip to make four patches

From EACH of 4 Fat Quarters cut:

1-61/4" x 22" strip

From the strip, cut 2-61/4" squares and 1-51/2" square to make 1 star

3-3" x 22" strips

From one strip, cut 3-3" sashing squares

Set aside 2 strips to make four patches.

Background and Border:

2-15½" x width of fabric strips

From the strips, cut 28-15½" x 3" sashing strips

7-61/4" x width of fabric strips

From the strips, cut 40-61/4" squares

5-51/2" x width of fabric strips

From the strips, cut 32-51/2" squares

19-3" x width of fabric strips

From 8 strips, cut 16-3" x 22" strips to make four patches

From 2 strips, cut 3-3" x 15½" sashing strips

Sew 9 strips end to end.

From this long strip cut, 2-3" x 73" and 2-3" x 85½" border strips

Binding:

9–2½" x width of fabric strips. Sew the strips end to end to make the binding.

Construction Use 1/4" seams. Press in the direction of the arrows in the diagrams.

Four Patches: Sew 1 solid and 1 background 3" x 22" strip together. Press toward the solid. Make 16 strip sets. From each of the strip sets, cut 6-3" wide units. Cut 96 total. Combine 2 units to make one Four Patch. Make 48.








Four Patch Make 48. 5½" square unfinished


Make 16 strip sets.

7 Stars:

(A) Draw a diagonal line, from corner to corner, on the wrong side of the 40-61/4" background squares. Layer the solid and background square right sides together. Sew a 1/4" from each side of the diagonal line. Cut on the drawn line. Press open toward the solid triangle to make 2 half square triangle units. Repeat to make 80 half square triangle units.




(B) Draw a diagonal line, from corner to corner, on the wrong side of 40 half square triangle units as shown. Layer 1 marked and 1 unmarked half square triangle unit, with opposite fabrics right sides together. Sew ½" from each side of the diagonal line. Cut on the drawn line. Press open to make 2 quarter square triangle units. Repeat to make 80 quarter square triangle units.




2 Block and Sashing assembly: Make stars scrappy or use one print in a star.


(A) **Block A:** Sew 3-5½" background squares, 4 quarter square triangle units, 1-four patch and 1-5½" solid square together as shown. Make 4.



(B) **Block B:** Sew 2-5½" background squares, 4 quarter square triangle units, 2-four patches and 1-5½" solid square together as shown. Make 10.



(C) **Block C:** Sew 4 quarter square triangle units, 4-four patches and 1-5½" solid square together as shown. Make 6.



(D) **Sashing rows:** Sew 3-3" solid squares and 4-3" x 15½" background strips together as shown. Make 4.
