

## ON THE ROAD

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 78" $\times 94$ "
Finished Block Size 14" x 14"
Measurements include $1 / 4$ " seam allowance.
Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.
Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 Road Trip Quarter Bundle (FQ-5620-18)
$13 / 4$ yards ( 1.65 m ) cream blossoms (C5621 Cream)
$1 / 4$ yard ( 25 cm ) blue flowers (C5624 Blue)
$1 / 4$ yard ( 25 cm ) red flowers (C5624 Red)
3¼ yards ( 3 m ) putty solid (C120 Putty)
$1 / 8$ yard ( 15 cm ) Riley brown solid (C120 Riley Brown)
$1 / 8$ yard ( 15 cm ) scuba solid (C120 Scuba)
$5 / 8$ yard $(60 \mathrm{~cm})$ treetop solid (C120 Treetop)
$1 / 8$ yard ( 15 cm ) lemon shade (C200-61 Lemon)
Binding $3 / 4$ yard $(70 \mathrm{~cm})$

## CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting sashing and border pieces.

## Fat Quarter Bundle

Cut squares $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ in the corresponding number from each of the following assorted prints:

6-blue main, 7 -green main, 6-blue blossoms, 6-red blossoms, 6-blue trailers, 7-green trailers, 6-red trailers, 6-blue tablecloth, 7-green tablecloth, 6-red tablecloth, 7 -green stripe, 6-red stripe
Cut 36 squares $3^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ from blue flowers.
Cut 36 squares $3 " \times 3$ " from red flowers.
Using the template provided, cut 1 trailer from blue blossoms. Reverse or add $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance if necessary for your favorite method of applique.
Using the template provided, cut 1 awning scallop from green stripe. Add $1 / 4$ " seam allowance if necessary for your favorite method of applique.
Cut 1 tire center from cream flowers. Add $1 / 4$ " seam allowance if necessary for your favorite method of applique.

## Cream Blossoms

Cut 8 strips $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF for Border 2.

## Blue Flowers

Cut 1 strip 3" x WOF. Cut the strip into 12 squares 3 " $\times 3$ ".
Cut 2 strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Cut the strip into 18 squares $21 / 2 " \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

## Red Flowers

Cut 1 strip 3" x WOF. Cut the strip into 12 squares 3 " $\times 3^{\prime \prime}$. Cut 1 strips $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Cut the strip into 6 squares $21 / 2$ " $\times 21 / 2$ ".

## Putty Solid

Cut 8 strips $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ WOF for Border 1 .
Cut 5 strips $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ WOF. Cut the strips into 76 squares $21122^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2 "$.
Cut 13 strips $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Cut the strips into 76 rectangles 212" x 6 $1 / 2$ ".
Cut 12 strips $3^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Cut the strips into 152 squares 3" x 3".
Cut 2 strips $141 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Cut the strips into 31 rectangles $21 / 2 " \times 14 \frac{1}{2}$ " for sashing.
Cut 1 square $14 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 141 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

## Riley Brown Solid

Using the templates provided, cut 1 tire and 1 post. Reverse or add $1 / 4$ " seam allowance if necessary for your favorite method of applique.

## Scuba Solid

Using the templates provided, cut 1 door and 1 hitch. Reverse or add $1 / 4$ " seam allowance if necessary for your favorite method of applique.

## Treetop Solid

Cut 4 strips 3" x WOF. Cut the strips into 56 squares 3 " $\times 3$ ". Cut 1 strip $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Cut the strips into 7 squares $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
Using the template provided, cut 1 awning. Reverse or add $1 / 4$ " seam allowance if necessary for your favorite method of applique.

## Lemon Shade

Using the template provided, cut 1 window. Reverse or add $1 / 4$ " seam allowance if necessary for your favorite method 1 of applique.

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to quilt photo for placement of fabrics and blocks.

## Trailer Block

Use your favorite method of applique to attach the trailer pieces to the putty shade $14 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Make 1 Trailer Block.

## Red Bear Paw Block

Refer to the quilt photo for piece placement. Draw a line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the red flowers 3 " squares. Place a red flowers 3 " square on top of a putty solid 3 " square. Sew $1 / 4$ " on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the lines to make 2 Half Square Triangles. Press. Repeat to make 96 Half Square Triangles. Square up the Half Square Triangles to $2 \frac{1}{2}$ ".

Sew 2 half square triangles together to create 24 Unit As.


Sew a putty solid $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " square and 2 half square triangles together to create Unit B. Repeat to make 24 Unit Bs.


Unit B
Referring to the unit diagram for piece placement sew a Unit A, Unit B, and a red stripe $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " square together to create a Red Stripe Unit. Repeat to make 6 Red Stripe Units.


Red Stripe Unit
Referring to the unit diagram for piece placement sew a Unit A, Unit B, and a red tablecloth $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square together to create a Red Tablecloth Unit. Repeat to make 6 Red Tablecloth Units.


Red Tablecloth Unit

Referring to the unit diagram for piece placement sew a Unit A, Unit B, and a red blossoms $41 / 2$ " square together to create a Red Blossoms Unit. Repeat to make 6 Red Blossoms Units.


## Red Blossoms Unit

Referring to the unit diagram for piece placement sew a Unit A, Unit B, and a red trailers $41 / 2$ " square together to create a Red Trailers Unit. Repeat to make 6 Red Trailers Units.


Referring to the block diagram for piece placement, sew 4 putty solid $2 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 6 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles, 1 red flowers $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square, and the 4 Red Units together to create the Red Bear Paw Block. Repeat to make 6 Red Bear Paw Blocks.

## Blue Bear Paw Block

Refer to the quilt photo for piece placement. Draw a line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the blue flowers 3 " squares. Place a blue flowers 3 " square on top of a putty solid $3^{\prime \prime}$ square. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the lines to make 2 Half Square Triangles. Press. Repeat to make 96 Half Square Triangles. Square up the Half Square Triangles to $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

Sew 2 half square triangles together to create 24 Unit As.


Sew a putty solid $2 \frac{1}{2} /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ square and 2 half square triangles together to create Unit B. Repeat to make 24 Unit Bs.


Unit B
Referring to the unit diagram for piece placement sew a Unit A, Unit B, and a blue trailers $41 / 2$ " square together to create a Blue Trailers Unit. Repeat to make 6 Blue Trailers Units.


Blue Trailers Unit
Referring to the unit diagram for piece placement sew a Unit A, Unit B, and a blue main $4 \frac{1}{2} /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ square together to create a Blue Main Unit. Repeat to make 6 Blue Main Units.


Blue Main Unit
Referring to the unit diagram for piece placement sew a Unit A, Unit D, and a blue blossoms $4 \not 1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square together to create a Blue Tablecloth Unit. Repeat to make 6 Blue Tablecloth Units.

Blue Tablecloth Unit

Referring to the unit diagram for piece placement sew a Unit A, Unit D, and a blue tablecloth $41 / 2$ " square together to create a Blue Blossoms Unit. Repeat to make 6 Blue Blossom Units.


Blue Blossoms Unit
Referring to the block diagram for piece placement, sew 4 putty solid $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2$ rectangles, 1 blue flowers $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square, and the 4 Blue Units together to create the Blue Bear Paw Block. Repeat to make 6 Blue Bear Paw Blocks.

## Green Bear Paw Block

Refer to the quilt photo for piece placement. Draw a line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the treetop solid 3" squares. Place a treetop solid 3" square on top of a putty solid 3 " square. Sew $1 / 4$ " on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the lines to make 2 Half Square Triangles. Press. Repeat to make 112 Half Square Triangles. Square up the Half Square Triangles to $2 \frac{1}{2} \mathbf{2}^{\prime \prime}$.

Sew 2 half square triangles together to create 28 Unit As.


Sew a putty solid $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ square and 2 half square triangles together to create Unit B. Repeat to make 28 Unit Bs.


Unit B
Referring to the unit diagram for piece placement sew a Unit A, Unit B, and a green main $4122^{\prime \prime}$ square together to create a Green Main Unit. Repeat to make 7 Green Trailers Units.


Referring to the unit diagram for piece placement sew a Unit A, Unit B, and a green trailers $41 / 2$ " square together to create a Green Trailers Unit. Repeat to make 7 Green Trailers Units.


Green Trailers Unit

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Referring to the unit diagram for piece placement sew a Unit A, Unit B, and a green tablecloth $41 / 2$ " square together to create a Green Tablecloth Unit. Repeat to make 7 Green Tablecloth Units.


Green Tablecloth Unit
Referring to the unit diagram for piece placement sew a Unit A, Unit B, and a green stripe $41 / 2$ " square together to create a Green Stripe Unit. Repeat to make 7 Green Stripe Units.


Referring to the block diagram for piece placement, sew 4 putty solid $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles, 1 treetop solid $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square, and the 4 Green Units together to create the Green Bear Paw Block. Repeat to make 7 Green Bear Paw Blocks.

## Block and Sashing

Refer to quilt photo for Bear Paw Block, Trailer Block and sashing placement. Sew a block to a putty solid $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 141 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Repeat to make a row with 4 blocks and 3 sashing rectangles. Make 5 block and sashing rows.

## Sashing and Posts

Refer to quilt photo for sashing and post placement. Sew a putty solid $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 14 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to a blue flowers $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Repeat to make a row with 4 sashing rectangles and 3 posts. Make 4 sashing and post rows.

## Quilt Center Assembly

Refer to quilt photo for row placement. Sew rows together to complete the center of the quilt.

## Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

## Border 1

Side borders should be $781 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Top and bottom borders should be 6612".

## Border 2

Side borders should be $821^{1} 2^{\prime \prime}$. Top and bottom borders should be 7812".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Riley Blake fabric from the Road Trip Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.

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## Quilt Center Diagram

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
