

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS (Dove House Collection)

DESIGN 1

Fabric 1: 5/8yd - 60cm - A165.3 (Dove house on warm grey)

Fabric 2: 5/8yd - 60cm - A166.3 (Chalk hearts on slate)

Fabric 3: 5/8 yd - 60cm - A167.1 (Love tree on light cream)

Fabric 4: 3/8 yd - 40cm - A168.3 (Pink hearts on dove)

Fabric 5: 3/8yd - 40cm - A169.3 (White doves)

Fabric 6: ½yd - ½mtr - BB82 (Coral)

Fabric 7: 7/8 yd - 80cm - BB80 (Duck egg)

60" x 60" wadding and backing

Wadding used is Warm and White from The Warm Company

DESIGN 2

Fabric 1: 5/8yd - 60cm - A165.2 (Dove house on duck egg)

Fabric 2: 5/8 yd - 60cm - A166.1 (Chalk hearts on dove)

Fabric 3: 5/8 yd - 60cm - A167.3 (Love tree on night)

Fabric 4: 3/8yd - 40cm - A168.1 (Pink hearts on light cream)

Fabric 5: 3/8yd - 40cm - A169.1 (Duck egg doves)

Fabric 6: ½yd - ½mtr - BB79 (Light grey)

Fabric 7: 7/8 yd - 80cm - BB82 (Coral)

60" x 60" wadding and backing

Wadding used is Warm and White from The Warm Company

DESIGN 3

Fabric 1: 5/8 yd - 60cm - A165.1 (Dove house on light cream)

Fabric 2: 5/8yd - 60cm - A166.2 (Chalk hearts on blush)

Fabric 3: 5/8 yd - 60cm - A167.2 (Love tree on duck egg)

Fabric 4: 3/8yd - 40cm - A168.2 (Grey hearts on light cream)

Fabric 5: 3/8yd - 40cm - A169.2 (Blush doves)

Fabric 6: ½yd - ½mtr - BB80 (Duck egg)

Fabric 7: 7/8 yd - 80cm - BB83 (Gold)

60" x 60" wadding and backing


Wadding used is Warm and White from The Warm Company

CUTTING

Use 1/4" seam allowance throughout. Press all seams open unless otherwise noted

- 1. From fabric 1 cut:
- 16 x 6½" x 6½"
- 2. From fabric 2 cut:
 - 32 x 2" x 6½"
 - 32 x 2" x 5"
- 3. From fabric 3 cut:
- 16 x 6½" x 6½"
- 4. From fabric 4 cut:
 - 16 x 2½" x 3"
 - 16 x 2½" x 5"
- **5.** From fabric 5 cut:
 - 16 x 2½" x 3"
 - 16 x 2½" x 5"
- 6. From fabric 6 cut:
 - 32 x 3" x 3"
 - 25 x 2" x 2"
- 7. From fabric 7 cut:
 - 40 x 2" x 12½"

MAKING UP BLOCK



Lay out your fabric pieces for block A

Block B

Work on the top left hand corner of the block. Sew the two squares together

Now sew the next strip to the top of this piece. Next take the left hand piece and sew it to your work, and sew the last one to the top

Block B

Block B

Now do the bottom right hand corner as you have sewn the last piece

Join in rows and then sew the rows together to make the block. You will sew 8 in total

Lay out your pieces for block B

This will be made up as block A, but this time on your piece blocks the middle fabrics will be in the opposite corners. You will need 8 in total

ASSEMBLY

Lay out your blocks, sashing and small squares as in the main diagram

Sew in rows, starting at the top. On each row press the seam in the opposite way. Join the rows together to complete the quilt top

COMPLETION

Sandwich quilt top, wadding and backing. Pin or baste layers

Quilt as desired

Double bind edges with 21/2" fabric 6 strips
