Rainbow Seeds

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following - Wall Hanging:

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, the panel has a coping border added then trimmed so the square will fit the quilt correctly. Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of bordered floral panel to approximately 23"x 42"

Fabric C - Cut (2) 8-1/2" strips the width of fabric


Referring to the quilt diagram, fussy cut (2) 8-1/4" x 46" strips along the length of fabric, centering design

Fabric F - Cut (4)1-1/4" strips sewn together end to end, subcut (2) 1-1/4" x 46" and (2) 1-1/4" x 27" for flat piping Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Fabric K - Cut (4) 3" strips , subcut (2) 3" x 28" strips

2. Piecing Order - Wall Hanging:

1. Stitch Fabric K 3"x width of fabric (WOF) strips to sides of the Fabric A panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 3"x 28" Fabric K strips to top and bottom of panel. Trim bordered panel to 27" x 46" (unfinished).




- 2. Press Fabric F 1-1/4" x 46" strips in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and place on top of Fabric K strips on both sides of quilt center, matching raw edges as shown in Wall Hanging Layout. Baste in place. In the same manner, baste Fabric F 1-1/4" x 27" strips along the top and bottom.
- 3. Referring to Wall Hanging Layout, stitch Fabric C 8-1/4"x 46" strips to the sides of quilt center, sandwiching the Fabric F strips in between for flat piping. In the same manner, stitch Fabric C 8-1/2" x WOF strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Trim even with sides.

- The quilt measures approximately
 42-1/2" x 62" (unfinished). Make backing
 (Fabric M) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric F) and enjoy!!

3. Cut the following - Throw:

Fabric B - Cut (1) 9-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 9-1/2" squares and (4) 5" squares

Fabric B (throw #2) or C (throw #1) - Cut (6) 3-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and subcut (2) 3-1/2" x 65" borders and (2) 3-1/2" x 60-1/2" borders Fabric D - Cut (1) 9-7/8" strip, subcut (4) 9-7/8" squares, then cut in half diagonally for 8 triangles Cut (1) 9-1/2" strip, subcut (2) 9-1/2" squares Cut (1) 5" strip, subcut (8) 5" squares Fabric E - Cut (1) 9-7/8" strip, subcut (4) 9-7/8" squares, then cut in half diagonally for 8 triangles / Cut (1) 5" strip, subcut (4) 5" squares and (4) 3-1/2" squares Fabric F - Cut (1) 9-7/8" strip, subcut (4) 9-7/8" squares, then cut in half diagonally for 8 triangles / Cut (1) 5" strip, subcut (4) 5" squares and (4) 3-1/2" squares Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding) Fabric G - Cut (1) 9-7/8" strip, subcut (4) 9-7/8" squares, then cut in half diagonally for 8 triangles / Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 3-1/2" squares Fabric H - Cut (1) 9-7/8" strip, subcut (2) 9-7/8"

Fabric H - Cut (1) 9-7/8" strip, subcut (2) 9-7/8" squares, then cut 1 from top right to lower left and 1 from top left to lower right for 4 triangles

Cut (1) 5" strip, subcut (8) 5" squares

Fabric I - Cut (1) 9-7/8" strip, subcut (2) 9-7/8" squares, [then cut in half diagonally for 4 triangles] and (2) 9-1/2" squares

Cut (1) 5" strip, subcut (4) 5" squares

Fabric J - Cut (2) 2" strips, subcut (42) 2" squares

Fabric K - Cut (1) 9-7/8" strip, subcut (4) 9-7/8" squares, then cut in half diagonally for 8 triangles

Fabric L - Cut (4) 9-1/2" strips, subcut (71) 2" x 9-1/2" strips

4. Piecing Order - Throw:

1. Stitch together 1 each Fabrics G and H 9-7/8" triangles along long edges for Block 1 with direction of Fabric H as indicated. Make a total of 4

2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 5" **Fabrics B, D, E, F, H** and **I** squares and 3-1/2" **Fabrics E, F** and **G** squares, marking directional **B** and **H** squares as shown below.





H - mark 4 of each B - mark 2 of each

Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric. Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

3. Stitch together long edges of 1 each Fabrics F and K 9-7/8" triangles. Place a marked 5" Fabric D square on Fabric F corner and a marked 5" Fabric H square on Fabric K corner, right sides together. Sew along drawn lines and trim 1/4" away from stitching. Press triangles open to make 1 Block 2a (9-1/2" square unfinished). Make a second Block 2a. In the same manner make 2 each Blocks 2b - 2d as shown.

4. In the same manner, sew together Fabrics D and E 9-7/8" triangles, then add marked 5" Fabrics F and I squares on the corners for Block 3. Make 4 Block 3 (9-1/2" square unfinished).

In the same manner, sew together Fabrics I and G 9-7/8" triangles, then add marked 5" Fabrics E and B squares on the corners for Block 4. Make 1 each Blocks 4a - 4d as shown.

Stitch together long edges of 4 each Fabrics D and E 9-7/8" triangles for 4 Block 5 (9-1/2" square unfinished).



7. Place marked 3-1/2" Fabric F squares on top corners of a Fabric D 9-1/2" square as shown, right sides together. Sew along drawn lines and trim 1/4" away from stitching. Press triangles open for Block 6. Make 2 Block 6 (9-1/2" square unfinished).





In the same manner. use a Fabric | 9-1/2" square with marked Fabric E 3-1/2" squares to make 2 Block 7, and Fabric B 9-1/2" squares (note direction) with marked Fabric G 3-1/2"

squares to make 1 each Blocks 8a and 8b.

9. Sew 6 Fabric J 2" squares and 5 Fabric L 2" x 9-1/2" strips end to end for a Sashing Row. Make 7 Sashing Rows (2" x 54-1/2" unfinished).


- 10. Arrange Blocks and Fabric L 2" x 9-1/2" sashing strips into 6 Block Rows as shown in Throw Layout on page 4. Sew into rows. Arrange Block Rows and Sashing Rows as shown and sew together to form quilt center (54-1/2" x 65" unfinished).
- 11. Sew Fabric B or C 3-1/2" x 65" borders to left and right sides of quilt center. Add Fabric B or C 3-1/2" x 60-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.
- The quilt measures approximately 60-1/2" x 71" (unfinished), Make backing (Fabric M) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- 13. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together, Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric F) and enjoy!!
