Under the Ocean Blue

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvege to selvege, unless stated otherwise.

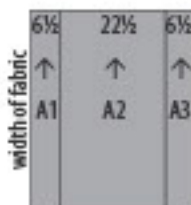
1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - Cut (1) 35-1/2" strip, subcut in the following order:

A1 (1) 6-1/2" strip,


A2 (1) 22-1/2" strip,


and **A3** (1) 6-1/2" strip




NOTE: Print may show differently than in color quilt image depending on where fabric is cut.

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvege: (2) 9-1/2" x 91" and (2) 9-1/2" x 67" multi-stripe borders

Fabric C - Cut (1) 9-1/4" strip, subcut (3) 9-1/4" squares [then cut in half diagonally twice  for 12 triangles] and (2) 4-1/2" wide x 8-1/2" tall pieces

Fabrics D - Cut (1) 5-1/4" strip, subcut (3) 5-1/4" squares [then cut in half diagonally twice  for 12 triangles] and (4) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces

Fabrics E - Cut (1) 5-1/4" strip, subcut (6) 5-1/4" squares then cut in half diagonally twice  for 24 triangles. Cut remaining strip into (2) 2-1/2" x 9" strips subcut (4) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces

Fabric F - Cut (4) 2" strips


Cut (5) 2" strips, subcut (2) 2" x 37-1/2",

(2) 2" x 22-1/2", (4) 2" x 8-1/2", and

(4) 2" x 6-1/2" strips


Fabric G - Cut (8) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Cut (1) 2" strip, subcut (12) 2" squares

Fabric H - Cut (1) 4-7/8" strip, subcut (6) 4-7/8" squares, then cut in half diagonally  for 12 triangles

Cut (1) 3" strip, subcut (8) 3" x 4-1/2" pieces

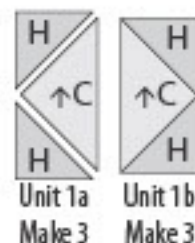
Cut (6) 3" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 3" x 73" and (2) 3" x 49" borders

Cut (2) 2-7/8" strips, subcut (24) 2-7/8" squares, then cut in half diagonally  for 48 triangles

Fabrics C and E are directional, not all triangles cut are used.

2. Piecing Order:

1. Stitch 2 **Fabric H** 4-7/8" triangles to short sides of **Fabric C** 9-1/4" triangles as shown to make 3 each Units 1a and 1b (4-1/2" x 8-1/2" unfinished).



Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

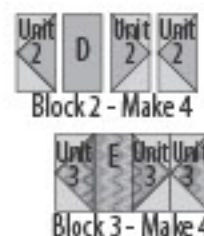
2. Arrange 2 Unit 1a and 1 each Unit 1b and **Fabric C** 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" piece in a row as shown. Stitch together for **Block 1a** (8-1/2" x 16-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make 1 **Block 1b** with 2 Unit 1b and 1 each Unit 1a and **Fabric C** 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" piece.



3. Sew 2 **Fabric H** 2-7/8" triangles to short sides of **Fabrics D** and **E** 5-1/4" triangles as shown to make 12 Unit 2 and 12 Unit 3 (2-1/2" x 4-1/2" unfinished).



4. Arrange Units 2, 3, and **Fabrics D** and **E** 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" pieces as shown. Stitch into 4 **Block 2** and 4 **Block 3** (4-1/2" x 8-1/2" unfinished).



5. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of strips, squares, blocks, and borders.

6. Stitch **Fabric F** 2" strips to long sides of **Fabric A2**. Add **Fabric A1** to left side and **A3** to right side. Sew **Fabric F** 2" strips to right and left sides. Trim strip ends so pieced panel measures 40-1/2" wide x 42-1/2" tall.

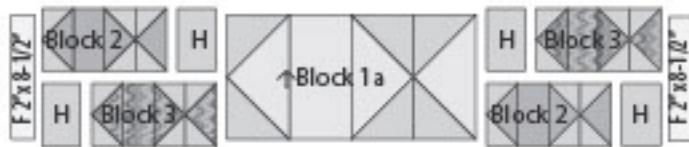
Shading of diagrams may vary depending on fabrics used.

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7. Sew 2" **Fabric G** squares to both ends of a **Fabric F** 2" x 6-1/2" strip. Make a total of 4 Unit 4 (2" x 9-1/2" unfinished). Sew a **Fabric F** 2" x 22-1/2" strip between 2 Unit 4. Make a total of 2 pieced strips (2" x 40-1/2" unfinished). Sew these to the top and bottom of the pieced panel to complete center section (40-1/2" x 45-1/2" unfinished).



8. Arrange **Block 1a**, 2 **Block 2**, 2 **Block 3**, and 4 **Fabric H** 3" x 4-1/2" pieces as shown. Sew the **Fabric H** pieces to right or left end of **Blocks 2** or **3** as shown. Sew the rows together on each side of **Block 1a**. Sew into a row. Add **Fabric F** 2" x 8-1/2" strips to right and left sides of row (8-1/2" x 40-1/2" unfinished). Sew to top of center section.

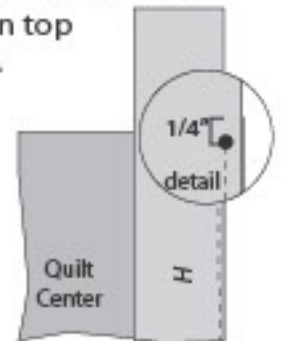


9. Repeat Step 8 to make a second row as shown and sew to bottom of center section.



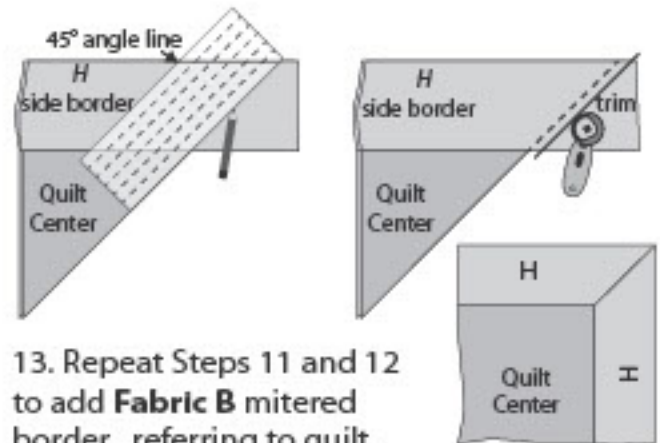
10. Sew a **Fabric F** 2" x 37-1/2" strip between 2 **Fabric G** 2" squares. Make a total of 2. Stitch to top and bottom of quilt to complete quilt center (40-1/2" x 64-1/2" unfinished).

11. Center **Fabric H** 3" x 73" borders on right and left sides of quilt center and **Fabric H** 3" x 49" borders on top and bottom of quilt center. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out.



Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

12. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



13. Repeat Steps 11 and 12 to add **Fabric B** mitered border, referring to quilt image for orientation of stripe.

14. The quilt measures approximately 63-1/2" x 87-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric I**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

15. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric G**) and enjoy!!

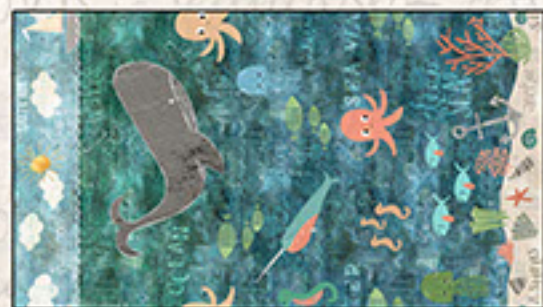
QUILT LAYOUT

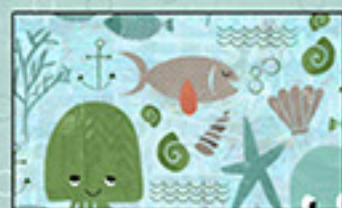
