¹ / ₄ yard	Owls in Circles - Orange (D)	1007-33
5/8 yard	Folio - Aqua (E)	7755-76
¹ / ₂ yard	Folio - Off White (F)	7755-04
¼ yard	Woodsy Owl - Lt. Aqua (G)	1004-16
¼ yard	Woodsy Owl - Brown (H)	1004-33
¼ yard	Woodsy Animals - Light Green (I)	1001-60
¼ yard	Mini Carrot - Green (J)	1005-66
¼ yard	Flower Dot - Teal (K)	1003-61
3 ¹ / ₂ yards	Owls in Circles - Cream (Backing)	1007-44

Quilt Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 24" Panel - Ecru/Multi (A):

• Fussy cut (1) 23" x 39 ½" panel.

From the Folio - Early Green (B), cut:

- (2) 1 ³/₄" x 39 ¹/₂" WOF strips.
- (2) 2 ¹/₂" x 25 ¹/₂" WOF strips.
- (7) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Woodsy Stripe - Cream/Multi (C), cut:

- (2) 6" x 60 ¹/₂" LOF strips, centered on Cream and Brown Stripes
- (2) 3¹/₂" x 52" LOF strips, centered on the Orange and Blue Stripes
- (2) 6" x 42 ¹/₂" LOF strips, centered on Cream and Brown Stripes
- (2) 3¹/₂" x 34" LOF strips, centered on the Orange and Blue Stripes

From the Owls in Circles - Orange (D), cut:

• (1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (5) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the Folio - Aqua (E), cut:

• (5) 3 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (60) 3 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Folio - Off White (F), cut:

- (4) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (30) 1 ¹/₂" x 4 ¹/₂" strips.
- (5) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (30) 1 ¹/₂" x 6 ¹/₂" strips.

From the Woodsy Owl - Lt. Aqua (G), cut:

• (1) 4 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (8) 4 ¹/₂" squares.



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From the Woodsy Owl - Brown (H), cut:

• (1) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (5) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the Woodsy Animals - Light Green (I), cut: • (1) 4 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (7) 4 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Mini Carrot - Green (J), cut: • (1) 6 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (5) 6 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Flower Dot - Teal (K), cut: • (1) 6" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (4) 6" squares.

From the Owls in Circles - Cream (Backing), cut:

• (2) 61" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 61" x 79" back.

Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) $1 \frac{3}{4}$ " x $39 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the 23" x $39 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A panel. Sew (1) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $25 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ " to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).





2. Place (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E square on the top left corner of (1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D square, right sides together (Fig. 2). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 2). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 3). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the sewn seam.


3. Follow Figure 4 for the seam direction to add a 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E square to each of the remaining corners of the 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D square to make (1) Block One block (Fig. 5).

4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make (5) Block Ones total.




5. Repeat Steps 2-3 using (5) 6 ¹/₂" Fabric H squares and (20) 3 ¹/₂" Fabric E squares to make (5) Block Twos (Fig. 6).

6. Repeat Steps 2-3 using (5) 6 ¹/₂" Fabric J squares and (20) 3 ¹/₂" Fabric E squares to make (5) Block Threes (Fig. 7).



7. Sew (1) 1 ¹/₂" x 4 ¹/₂" Fabric F strip to each side of (1) 4 ¹/₂" Fabric I square. Sew (1) 1 ¹/₂" x 6 ¹/₂" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric I square to make (1) Block Four (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (7) Block Fours total.

8. Sew (1) 1 ¹/₂" x 4 ¹/₂" Fabric F strip to each side of (1) 4 ¹/₂" Fabric G square. Sew (1) 1 ¹/₂ x 6 ¹/₂" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric G square to make (1) Block Five (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (8) Block Fives total.






Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the quilt Layout while assembling.)

9. Center (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 52" Fabric C strip on one side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the top edge of the quilt top and stop a $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.

10. Repeat Step 9 to sew (1) $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 34" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 10).

11. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 10), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a ¼" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners.



12. Sew (8) assorted blocks together to make (1) strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) strip to each side of the Center Block.

13. Sew (7) assorted blocks together to make (1) strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

14. Sew (1) 6" x 60 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) 6" Fabric K square to each end of (1) 6" x 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.


15. Layer and quilt as desired.

16. Sew the (7) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

17. Bind as desired.
