1/2 yard	Folio - Celery (F)	7755-06
1/4 yard	Flower Dot - Brown (G)	1003-33
1/4 yard	Flower Dot - Teal (H)	1003-61
1/4 yard	Mini Carrot - Green (I)	1005-66
1/4 yard	Folio - Off White (J)	7755-04
3 1/3 yards	Woodsy Animals - Cream (Backing)	1001-44

Quilt Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Owls in Circles - Orange (A), cut:

• (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (5) 6 ½" squares.

From the Folio - Brown (B), cut:

- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (18) 1 ½" x 6 ½" strips.
- (5) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (18) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (2) 2" x 40 ½" WOF strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 43 ½" strips.
- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Woodsy Owl - Brown (C), cut:

• (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (4) 6 ½" squares.

From the Folio - Aqua (D), cut:

- (2) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (20) 3 ½" squares.
- (2) 5 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (12) 5 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (48) triangles.

From the Mini Carrot - Cream (E), cut:

- (3) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (18) 5 ½" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (72) triangles.
- (5) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (4) 4 ½" x 43 ½" strips.

From the Folio - Celery (F), cut:

• (2) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (12) 5 ½" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (48) triangles.

From the Flower Dot - Brown (G), cut:

• (1) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (4) 4 ½" squares.

From the Flower Dot - Teal (H), cut:

• (1) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (8) 4 ½" squares.

From the Mini Carrot - Green (I), cut:

• (1) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (8) 4 ½" squares.

From the Folio - Off White (J), cut:

• (1) 5 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (6) 5 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (24) triangles.

From the Woodsy Animals - Cream (Backing), cut:

• (2) 59" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 59" x 59" back.

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Sewing Instructions

1. Follow Figure 1 and sew (1) Fabric F triangle, (1) Fabric J triangle, (1) Fabric D triangle and (1) Fabric E triangle together to make (1) FD block. Repeat to make (12) FD blocks total.



2. Follow Figure 2 and sew (1) Fabric D triangle, (1) Fabric J triangle, (1) Fabric F triangle and (1) Fabric E triangle together to make (1) DF block. Repeat to make (12) DF blocks total.





3. Sew (1) FD block and (1) DF block together to make (1) Unit 1 (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (12) Unit 1's total.




4. Follow Figure 4 and sew (1) Fabric F triangle, (2) Fabric E triangles and (1) Fabric D together to make (1) EE block. Repeat to make (24) EE blocks total.




Unit 2 make 12

5. Sew (2) EE blocks together to make (1) Unit 2 (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (12) Unit 2's total.




6. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 6 ½" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Block One (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (4) Block Ones total.

7. Place (1) 3 ½" Fabric D square on the top left corner of (1) 6 ½" Fabric C square, right sides together (Fig. 7). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 7). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 8). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn







- 8. Follow Figure 9 for the seam direction to add a 3 ½" Fabric D square to each of the remaining corners of the 6 ½" Fabric C square to make (1) Unit 3. (Fig. 10).
- 9. Repeat Steps 7-8 to make (4) Unit 3's total.



10. Repeat Steps 7-8 using (1) 6 ½" Fabric A square and (4) 3 ½" Fabric D squares to make (1) Unit 4 (Fig. 11).

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11. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) Unit 3. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 3 to make (1) Block Two (Fig. 12). Repeat to make (4) Block Twos total.



12. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) Unit 4. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 4 to make (1) Block Three (Fig. 13).




Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

- 13. Sew (2) 4 ½" x Fabric I squares, (3) Unit 1's and (2) 4 ½" Fabric H squares together to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Five.
- 14. Sew (2) Unit 1's, (2) Block Twos, (2) Unit 2's and (1) Block One together to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row
- 15. Sew (2) 4 ½" x Fabric H squares, (3) Unit 2's and (2) 4 ½" Fabric I squares together to make Row Three. Repeat to make Row Seven.
- 16. Sew (2) Unit 1's, (2) Block Ones, (2) Unit 2's and (1) Block Three together to make Row Four.
- 17. Sew the (7) rows together, in numerical order, to make the quilt top.
- 18. Sew (1) 2" x 40 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) 2" x 43 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
- 19. Sew (1) 4 ½" x 43 ½" Fabric E strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) 4 ½" Fabric G square to each end of (1) 4 ½" x 43 ½" Fabric E strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
- 20. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 21. Sew the (6) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 22. Bind as desired.



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
