Wall Quilt: 34-1/2" x 66-1/2"

Wilmington Prints: A World of Possibilities

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

#### 1. Cut the following for Wall Quilt:

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, the panel has borders that are cut a little longer than needed then trimmed to fit.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of panel to approximately 23" x 42"

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 2-1/2"x 59-1/2" narrow stripe borders and (2) 9"x 23-1/2" multi-stripe borders (1 with blue stripe on top, 1 with blue stripe on bottom)

Fabric G - Cut (3) 4-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 4-1/2" x 59-1/2" borders

Cut (2) 4-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 4-1/2" x 35-1/2" borders


Fabric J - Cut (6) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

#### 2. Piecing Order for Wall Quilt:

- Refer to Wall Quilt Layout for arrangement and placement of panel and borders.
- Stitch 9"x 23-1/2" Fabric B borders to top and bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim strip ends even. Add the Fabric B 2-1/2" x 59-1/2" borders to the right and left sides of panel. Trim strip ends even.
- 3. Sew Fabric G 4-1/2" x 59-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Trim strip ends even. Add 4-1/2" x 35-1/2" Fabric G borders to top and bottom of quilt. Trim strip ends even.
- The quilt measures approximately 35" x 67" (unfinished). Make backing (Fabric L) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric J) and enjoy!!

Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints. Border measurements are the cut size.



#### 3. Cut the following for Throw Quilt:

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 8-3/4" x 68" and (2) 8-3/4" x 64" multi-stripe borders

Fabric C - Cut (1) 12-1/2" strip, subcut (1) 12-1/2" and (4) 6-1/2" squares

Fabric D - Cut (1) 6-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 6-1/2" squares

Fabric E - Cut (3) 2" strips, subcut (16) 2" x 6-1/2" strips

Fabric F - Cut (3) 2" strips, subcut (32) 2" x 3-1/2" strips

Fabric H - Cut (3) 4-1/2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 4-1/2" x 43-1/2" borders and (10) 2" x 6-1/2" strips Cut (2) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (2) 2-1/2" x 39-1/2" borders Cut (1) 2" strip, subcut (6) 2" x 6-1/2" strips

Fabric I - Cut (2) 2" strips

Fabric J - Cut (1) 3-7/8" strip, subcut
(8) 3-7/8" squares, then cut 4 in half
diagonally in 1 direction and 4 in half diagonally in the opposite direction for a total
of 16 triangles
Cut (2) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (16) 3-1/2"
pieces

Fabric K - Cut (1) 3-7/8" strip, subcut
(8) 3-7/8", then cut in half diagonally for a total of 16 triangles
Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding)
Cut (2) 2" strips
Cut (4) 2" strips, subcut (2) 2" x 39-1/2"
(2) 2" x 36-1/2" borders

#### 4. Piecing Order for Throw Quilt:


1. Stitch **Fabrics E** and **H** 2" x 6-1/2"

strips together lengthwise. Make a

total of 16 Unit 1 (3-1/2" x 6-1/2"

Unit 1 - Make 16 unfinished).

 Stitch Fabrics
 I and K 2" strips together
 lengthwise.



Make 2. From these cut (32)  $2^{\prime\prime}$  wide Unit 2a  $(2^{\prime\prime} \times 3-1/2^{\prime\prime} \text{ unfinished})$ .

 Sew 2 Unit 2a together as shown.
 Make a total of 16 Unit 2b (3-1/2" square unfinished).




4. Arrange 1 Fabric C 6-1/2" square and 4 each Units 1 and 2b in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 Block 1 (12-1/2" square unfinished).



Block 1 - Make 4

5. Stitch a **Fabric** J. 3-1/2" square between **Fabric F** 2" x 3-1/2" pieces as shown.

Make a total of 8 Unit 3a (3-1/2" x 6-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make 8 Unit 3b with fabric arranged as shown.




6. Stitch Fabric J. and K 3-7/8" triangles together in 4 each Units





4a-4d (3-1/2" square unfinished) as shown.

7. Arrange 1 Fabric D 6-1/2" square, 2 each Units 3a and 3b, and 1 each Units 4a-4d in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 4 Block 2 (12-1/2" square unfinished).



Block 2 - Make 4


Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

- Refer to Throw Quilt Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of 12-1/2"
   Fabric C square, blocks, and borders.
- Arrange 12-1/2" Fabric C square and blocks in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together into quilt center (36-1/2" square unfinished).
- 10. Sew **Fabric K** 2" x 36-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric K** 2" x 39-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.
- 11. Sew **Fabric H** 2-1/2" x 39-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric H** 4-1/2" x 43-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

12. Center Fabric B 8-3/4" x 68" borders on right and left sides of quilt center and Fabric B 8-3/4"x 64" borders on top and bottom of quilt center with the top of stripe next to quilt center. Stitch borders to 1/4" sides starting and stopping detail 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out. 8 Quilt  $\rightarrow$ Center

Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.


13. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



- 14. The quilt measures approximately 60" x 64" (unfinished). Make backing (Fabric L) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric K) and enjoy!!
