


Bumbleberries Quilt

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS (Bumbleberries Collection)

1/4" seam allowances are included in all cutting instructions

Press all seams open unless otherwise noted

DESIGN 2a and 2b

Fabric 1a: 2yds - 1.75m - BB20 (Black) **for dark background quilt** Fabric 1b: 2yds - 1.75m - BB40 (Off white) **for light background quilt**

Fabric 2: 3/8yd - 30cm - BB94 (Light grey) Fabric 3: 3/8yd - 30cm - BB95 (Mint) Fabric 4: 3/8yd - 30cm - BB96 (Blush) Fabric 5: 3/8yd - 30cm - BB97 (Grass)

Fabric 5: 38yd - 30cm - BB97 (Grass)
Fabric 6: 38yd - 30cm - BB98 (Pebble)
Fabric 7: 38yd - 30cm - BB99 (Baby blue)
Fabric 8: 38yd - 30cm - BB100 (Linen)

Fabric 9: 3/8yd - 30cm - BB102 (Light coral)
Fabric 10: 3/8yd - 30cm - BB107 (Sunshine)

Wadding and backing 52" x 64"

CUTTING

1. From fabric 1 (Black OR Off White) cut:

2 x 21/2" x 561/2"

2 x 2½" x 48½"

8 x 1½" x 56½"

126 x 21/2" x 21/2"


2. From each of the fabrics 2 to 9 cut:

28 x 1½" x 2½"

28 x 11/2" x 41/2"

PIECING (DESIGN 2a and 2b)

- **1.** Use either 2½" Black or Off White Bumbleberries squares for centres and one other colour for rest of each block
- **2a.** Take two $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Sunshine Bumbleberries strips and join strips to opposite sides of one, $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Black or Off White Bumbleberries square
- **b.** Add 11/2" x 41/2" Sunshine Bumbleberries strips to top and bottom edges to complete block
- c. Block should measure 41/2" square



Block

- 3. Make fourteen blocks with Sunshine Bumbleberries strips in total
- 4. Repeat to make total of 126 blocks, fourteen of each colour

ASSEMBLY

- 1a. Refer to main diagrams and arrange blocks into nine vertical rows of fourteen blocks
- **b.** Join blocks together in their vertical rows
- 2. Join rows together with 11/2" x 561/2" Black or Off White Bumbleberries strips
- **3.** Add $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $56\frac{1}{2}$ " Black or Off White Bumbleberries strips to opposite sides of quilt top and $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $48\frac{1}{2}$ " Black or Off White Bumbleberries strips to top and bottom edges to complete quilt top

COMPLETION

- 1a. Make quilt sandwich with quilt top, wadding and backing
- **b.** Pin or baste layers
- 2. Quilt as desired
- 3. Cut 21/2" strips from Black or Off White Bumbleberries and double bind edges of quilt
