From the Garden

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, panels have a coping border added then trimmed so they will fit the guilt correctly. Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of 6 panels to approximately 5-1/2" square

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 10-1/2" x 74" and (2) 10-1/2"x 62" multi-stripe borders

Fabric C - Cut (4) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (15) 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" strips

Fabric D - Cut (1) 10-1/2" strip, subcut (16) 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" strips

Fabrics E and F - From each fabric: Cut (4) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (24) 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips

Fabric G - Cut (4) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (54) 2-1/2" squares

Fabrics H and I - From each fabric: Cut (1) 2-1/2" strip, subcut (12) 2-1/2" squares

Fabric J - (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding) Cut (3) 2-1/2" strips, subcut (44) 2-1/2" squares Cut (4) 1-1/4" strips, subcut (12) 1-1/4" x 7" and (12) 1-1/4" x 6" strips


2. Piecing Order:

 Stitch Fabric J 1-1/4"x 6" strips to right and left sides of a Fabric A 5-1/2" square panel. Trim strip ends even. Add Fabric J 1-1/4" x 7" strips to top and bottom of panel. Trim bordered panel to 6-1/2" (unfinished). Make a total of 6 Unit 1.



Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.


Arrange 1 Unit 1, (4) 2-1/2" Fabric G squares, and 2 each Fabrics E and F 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips in 3 rows. Sew into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 6 Block 1 (10-1/2" square unfinished).



Arrange Fabrics G, H, I, and J 2-1/2" squares in 3 rows. Sew into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 6 Unit 2 (6-1/2" square unfinished).



 Arrange 1 Unit 2, (4) 2-1/2" Fabric G squares, and 2 each Fabrics E and F 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips in 3 rows. Sew into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 6 Block 2 (10-1/2" square unfinished).



Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of blocks, strips, squares, and border.

Arrange blocks, Fabric J 2-1/2" squares, and Fabrics C and D 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" strips in 9 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows into quilt center (38-1/2" x 50-1/2" unfinished).


Center Fabric B 10-1/2" x 74" borders on right and left sides of quilt center and Fabric B 10-1/2" x 62" borders on top and bottom of quilt center with the top of stripe next to quilt center, Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" 1/4" from corners of quilt detail center. Do not trim. Press borders out. Qρ Quilt >

Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

8. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.




- The quilt measures approximately
 1/2" x 70-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing
 (Fabric K) approximately 8" larger than the top.
- Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric J) and enjoy!!
