

# The Way Home

Wall/Throw Quilt: 47" x 66-1/2"

Wilmington Prints: A World of Possibilities

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Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvage to selvage, unless stated otherwise.


## 1. Cut the following:

**Fabric A** - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, the panel has a coping border added then trimmed so the panel will fit the quilt correctly.


Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of panel to approximately 23" x 42"

**Fabric B** - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvage: (2) 8-1/4" x 41-1/2" multi-stripe borders (1 with red word stripe on top and 1 with red word stripe on bottom)

**Fabric C** - Cut (1) 3" strip, subcut (12) 3" squares (fussy cut if desired)

**Fabric D** - Cut (2) 3-3/8" strips, subcut (24) 3-3/8" squares then cut in half diagonally for 48 triangles 

**Fabrics E and K** - From each fabric:  
Cut (2) 1-3/4" strips, subcut (48) 1-3/4" squares

**Fabric F** - Cut (2) 3-3/8" strips, subcut (24) 3-3/8" squares then cut 12 in half diagonally in 1 direction and 12 in half in the other direction for 48 triangles   
Cut (2) 1-3/4" strips, subcut (48) 1-3/4" squares

**Fabric G** - Cut (6) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 64" and (2) 2" x 47-1/2" borders

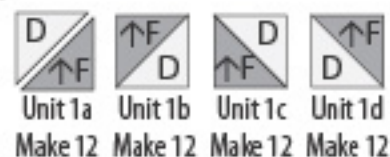
**Fabric H** - Cut (6) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 61" and (2) 2" x 44-1/2" borders

**Fabric I** - Cut (4) 2-3/4" strips, subcut (2) 2-3/4" x 28" borders  
Cut (6) 1-1/4" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 1-1/4" x 64" and (2) 1-1/4" x 44-1/2" strips for flat piping

**Fabric J** - Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding)  
Cut (2) 1-3/4" strips, subcut (48) 1-3/4" squares

## 2. Piecing Order:

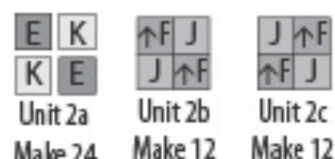
1. Sew **Fabrics D** and **F** 3-3/8" triangles together along their long edges. Make a total



of 12 Unit 1a (3" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 12 each Units 1b-1d.

Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

2. Arrange 2 each **Fabrics E and K** 1-3/4" squares in 2 rows. Sew into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total



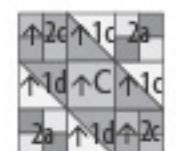
of 24 Unit 2a (3" square unfinished). In the same manner, make 12 each Units 2b and 2c with **Fabrics F** and **J** 1-3/4" squares.

3. Arrange a 3" **Fabric C** square and 2 each Units 1a, 1b, 2a, and 2b in 3 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 6 **Block 1** (8" square unfinished).

4. In the same manner, make 6 **Block 2** each with a 3" **Fabric C** square and units shown.

5. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 3) for arrangement and placement of panel, strips, blocks, borders, and flat piping.

6. Stitch **Fabric I** 2-3/4" strips to sides of the **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 2-3/4" x 28" **Fabric I** strips to top and bottom of panel. **Trim bordered panel to 26-1/2" x 45-1/2" (unfinished).**

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7. Arrange **Blocks 1** and **2** in a vertical row on left side of bordered panel. Stitch blocks into a vertical row then sew to left side of bordered panel.

8. Arrange **Blocks 1** and **2** in a vertical row on right side of bordered panel. Stitch blocks into a vertical row then sew to right side of bordered panel.

9. Sew **Fabric B** 8-1/4" x 41-1/2" borders to top and bottom of bordered panel to complete quilt center (41-1/2" x 61" unfinished).

10. Sew **Fabric H** 2" x 61" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric H** 2" x 44-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

11. Fold **Fabric I** 1-1/4" x 64" and 1-1/4" x 44-1/2" strips in half lengthwise, right side out forming 5/8" wide flat piping strips.

12. Baste 5/8" x 64" **Fabric I** flat piping strips to sides of quilt, with raw edges even with **Fabric H** border. Baste 5/8" x 44-1/2" **Fabric I** flat piping to top and bottom of quilt, with raw edges even with raw edges of **Fabric H** border.

13. Stitch **Fabric G** 2" x 64" borders to sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric G** 2" x 47-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

14. The quilt measures approximately 47-1/2" x 67" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric L**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

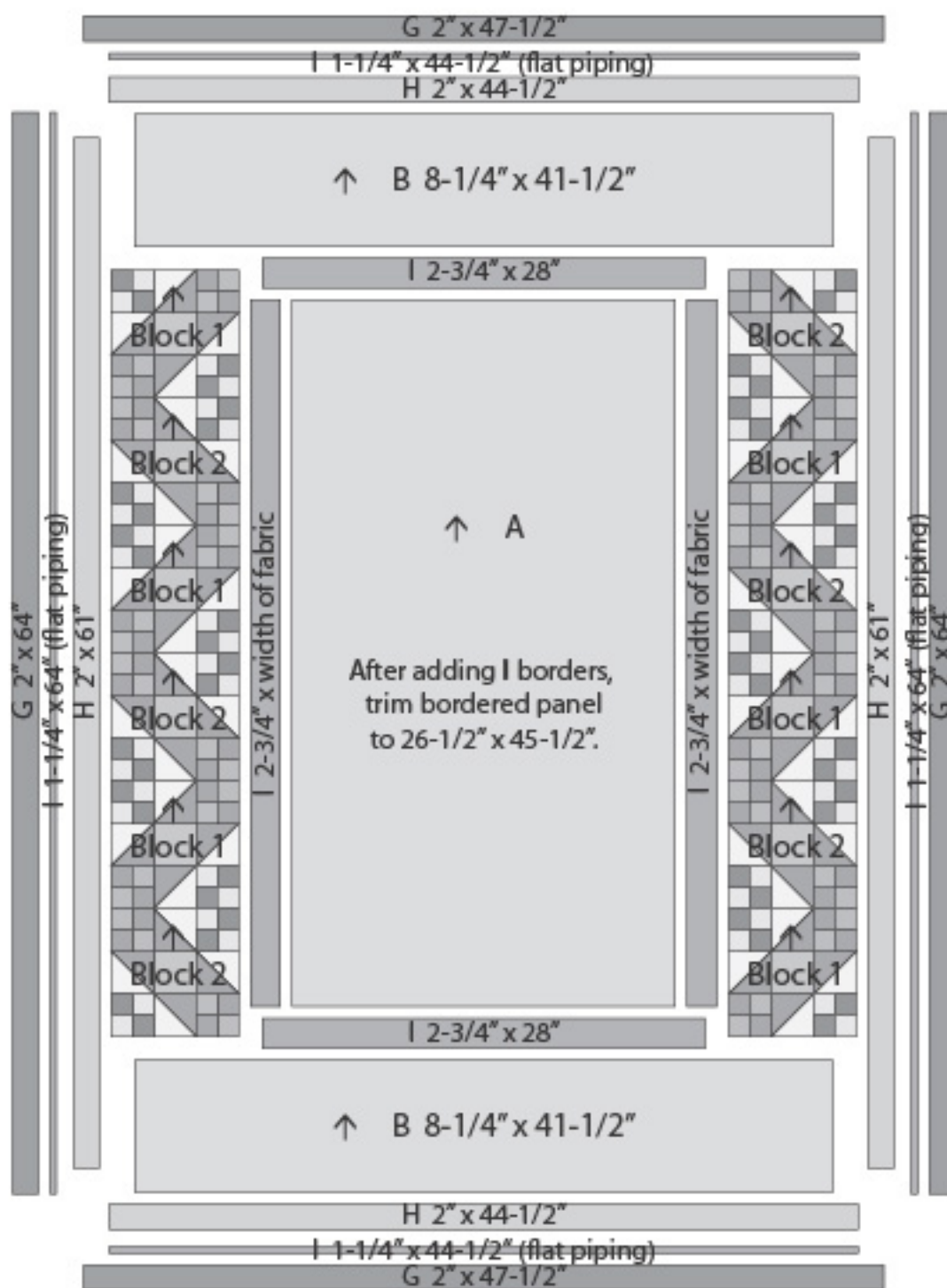
15. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric J**) and enjoy!!

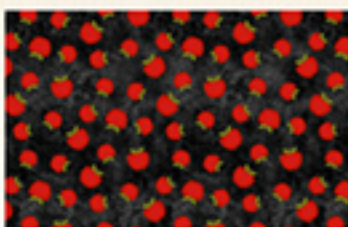
