


Fabric Requirements
$3 / 8$ yard of each:
Fun-C8224 Jade
Hatch-C2959 Tomato
Hatch-C2959 Citrus
Pop-C3904 Latte
21⁄8 yards Row-C5060 Map
$1 / 2$ yard Fun-C8224 Ocean
1/4 yard Row-C5061 Multi
25/8 yards Row-C5058 Multi
3/4 yard Hatch-C2959 Tomato (binding)
$71 / 4$ yards backing fabric of your choice

## Other supplies:

$86^{\prime \prime} \times 106^{\prime \prime}$ batting
8 unfinished Row by Row Experience 2017 rows of your choice ( $36^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}} \times 9^{1 / 21}$ unfinished; one must be vertical or non-directional)

## Cutting

From each Fun-C8224 Jade, Hatch-C2959 Tomato and Hatch-C2959 Citrus:

- Cut seven $1^{1 / 21} \times$ width-of-fabric (WOF) strips. Sub-cut four $1^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 36^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips, four $1^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 11^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and two $1^{1 / 21} \times 16^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
From Pop-3904 Latte:
- Cut seven $1 \frac{1}{1 / 2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut four $1^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}} \times 36^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}}$ strips, four $1^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}} \times 11^{1 / 21}$ " strips, two $1^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 16^{1 / 2 "}$ " strips and one $1^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}} \times 18^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}}$ strip.


## From Row-C5060 Map:

Note: This is a directional fabric.

- Cut one $5^{1 / 211 " \prime} \times$ length-of-fabric (LOF) strip. Sub-cut two $5^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 18^{1 / 21}$ strips and two $5^{1 / 21} \times 16^{1 / 21}$ strips. Set aside for the vertical row.
- Cut one $1 \frac{1}{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ LOF strip.

From the remaining fabric width:

- Cut seven $5^{1 / 21} \times$ X WOF strips. Sub-cut fourteen $5^{1 / 21} \times 16^{1 / 21} 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut ten $1^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}} \times 35^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strips.
- Cut one $11^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}}$ WOF rectangle.


## From Fun-8224 Ocean:

- Cut eight 2" x WOF strips for the inner border.

From Row-C5058 Multi and following the quilt photo for motif placement:

- Fussy-cut two luggage rows $4^{3 / 4} 4^{11} \times$ LOF for outer side borders.
- Fussy-cut two cars with license plates rows with plates $6^{\prime \prime} \times$ LOF for outer top/bottom rows.


## From Row-C5061 Multi:

- Fussy-cut four $4^{3} / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles with the license plates running across the $43 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle width.


## From Hatch-C2959 Tomato:

- Cut ten $2^{1 / 21} \times$ WOF strips for binding.


## Quilt Top Assembly

All seam allowances are $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ unless otherwise noted.

1. Following the quilt photo, lay out your seven horizontal rows and one vertical row in a pleasing order.
2. Sew $1^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 36^{1 / 2 "}$ C8224 Jade strips to top and bottom of a row. Sew $1^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}} \times 11^{1 / 2 "}$ C8224 Jade strips to each side of the row. Repeat to frame all seven horizontal rows using the remaining C8224 Jade, C2959 Tomato and C2959 Citrus strip pairs, and the C3904 Latte strips to frame the vertical row. (figure 1)

3. Noting the print direction, sew a $5^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}} \times 16^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}}$ C5060 Map strip to each long edge of a $1^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}} \times 16^{1 / 2 "}$ C8224 Jade strip. Repeat to make another set. (figure 2)

Make 2.
4. Repeat Step 3 to make two sets each using $1^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}} \times 16^{1 / 2 "}$ C2959 Tomato and C3959 Citrus strips; and one C3904 Latte strip. The sets will measure $11^{1 / 2 "} \times 16^{1 / 2 "}$.
5. Noting the print direction, sew $5^{1 / 21} \times 18^{1 / 2 "}$ LOF C5060 Map strips to each long edge of a
$1^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}} \times 18^{1 / 2 \text { " }}$ C3904 Latte strip. Repeat using the $5^{1 / 21} \times 16^{11} 2^{\prime \prime}$ LOF C5060 Map and $1^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 16^{1 / 2 \text { " }}$ C3904 Latte strips.
6. Sew matching frame color strip sets to one side of the seven horizontal rows, alternating left and right sides. Rows will measure $11^{1 / 21} \times 54^{1 / 21} 2^{\prime \prime}$. (figure 3) Fig. 3

7. Sew the $1^{1 / 21} \times$ WOF C5060 Map strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Sub-cut six $1^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 54^{1 / 2 "}$ strips. Sew a $1^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 54^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip between each of the seven horizontal rows.
8. Sew the $11^{1 / 2 "} \times 16^{1 / 2 "}$ C3904 Latte strip set to the top and the $11^{1 / 21} \times 18^{1 / 2 " 1}$ C3904 Latte strip set to the bottom of the vertical row. (figure 4) The vertical row will measure $11^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 72^{1 / 2 "}$.

9. Using the $1 \frac{1}{1 / 2} \times$ LOF C5060 Map strip, trim to $1^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}} \times 72^{1 / 2^{\prime \prime}}$ and sew the strip to the left of the vertical row.
10. Sew the $11^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}} \times 12^{1 / 22^{\prime \prime}}$ C5060 Map piece to the top of the vertical row.
11. Sew the vertical section to the right side of the seven horizontal rows.
12. Sew the eight 2 " x WOF C8224 Ocean strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Measure the quilt center length and cut two strips that measurement. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt.
13. Measure the quilt center width and cut two strips that measurement from the pieced C8224 Ocean strip. Sew one strip to the top and the other to the bottom of the quilt.
14. Measure the quilt center length and cut the two C5058 Multi luggage strips that length. Measure the
quilt center width and cut two C5058 Multi cars with licenses plates strips that length.
15. Sew one C5058 Multi luggage strip to each side of the quilt.
16. Sew a $4^{3 / 4} 4^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ C5061 Multi rectangle to each end of the C5058 Multi cars with licenses plates strips. Sew one border to the top and the other to the bottom of the quilt.

## Finishing

17. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing and quilt as desired.
18. Stitch the binding strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Fold and press the resulting long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together. Stitch to the quilt front, matching raw edges and mitering the corners.
19. Fold the binding to the quilt underside and handstitch the folded edge to the quilt back.
20. If you want to personalize the quilt with the date, use hand embroidery, hand appliqué or press-on numbers above the vertical row.
