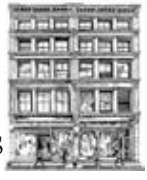


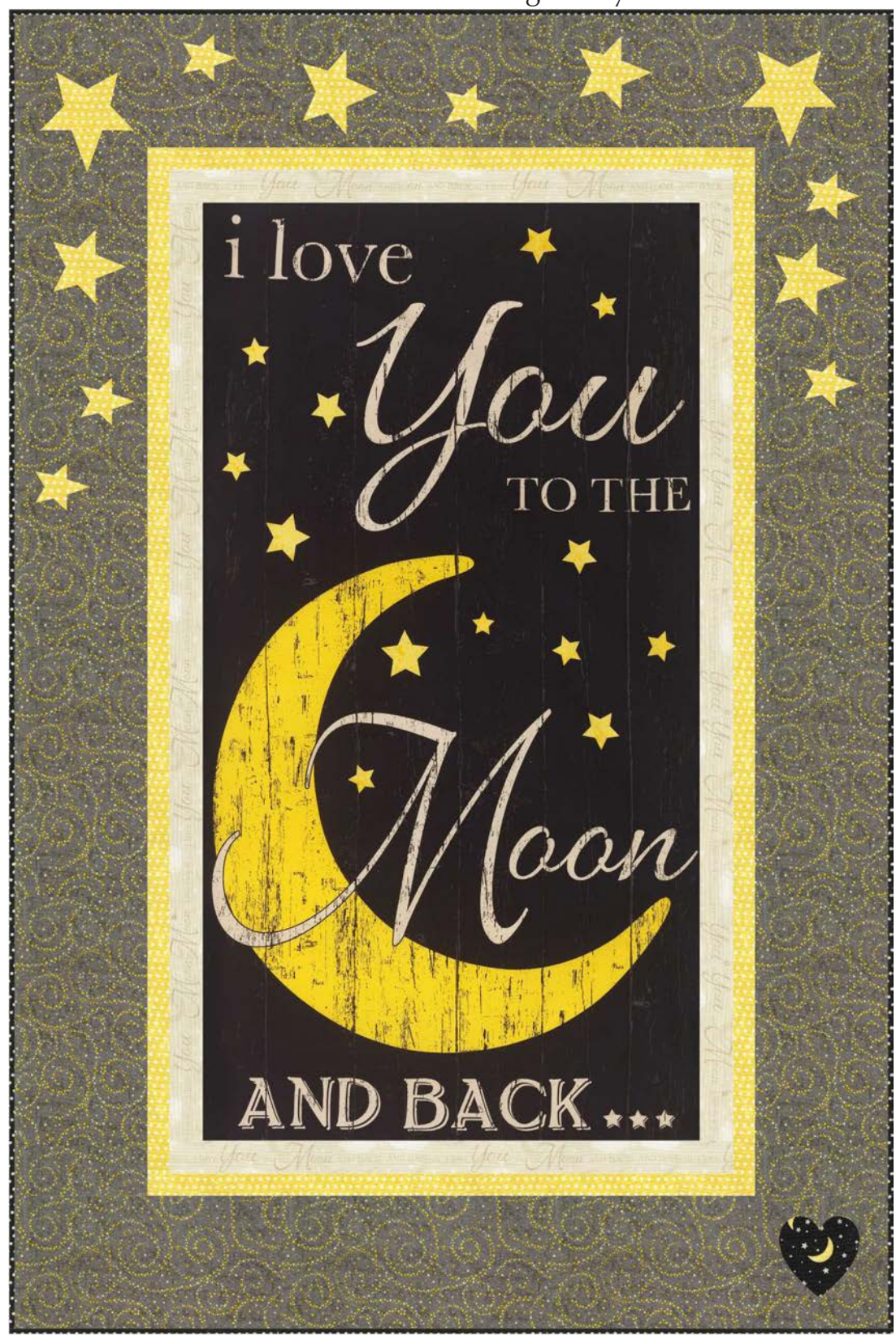

Finished quilt size: 40" x 60"

Fabric Requirements

One panel ($\frac{2}{3}$ yard) Moon-C5157 Noir
 $\frac{1}{3}$ yard Moon-C5527 Cream
 $\frac{1}{2}$ yard Ophelia-C1973 Yellow
1 yard Moon-C5526 Smoke
 $\frac{1}{8}$ yard Moon-C5530 Noir
 $\frac{1}{2}$ yard Ophelia-C1973 Black (binding)
 $2\frac{2}{3}$ yards backing fabric of your choice

Other supplies:

48" x 68" batting
Paper-back fusible web

Cutting

From Moon-C5157 Noir:

- Trim the panel to 23" x 43".

From Moon-C5527 Cream:

- Fussy-cut four 2" x width-of-fabric (WOF) strips for inner border.

From Ophelia-C1973 Yellow:

- Cut four 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for middle border.
- Save the remaining fabric for star appliqués.

From Moon-C5526 Smoke:

- Cut five 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for outer border.

From Ophelia-C1973 Black:

- Cut six 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for binding.

Quilt Top Assembly

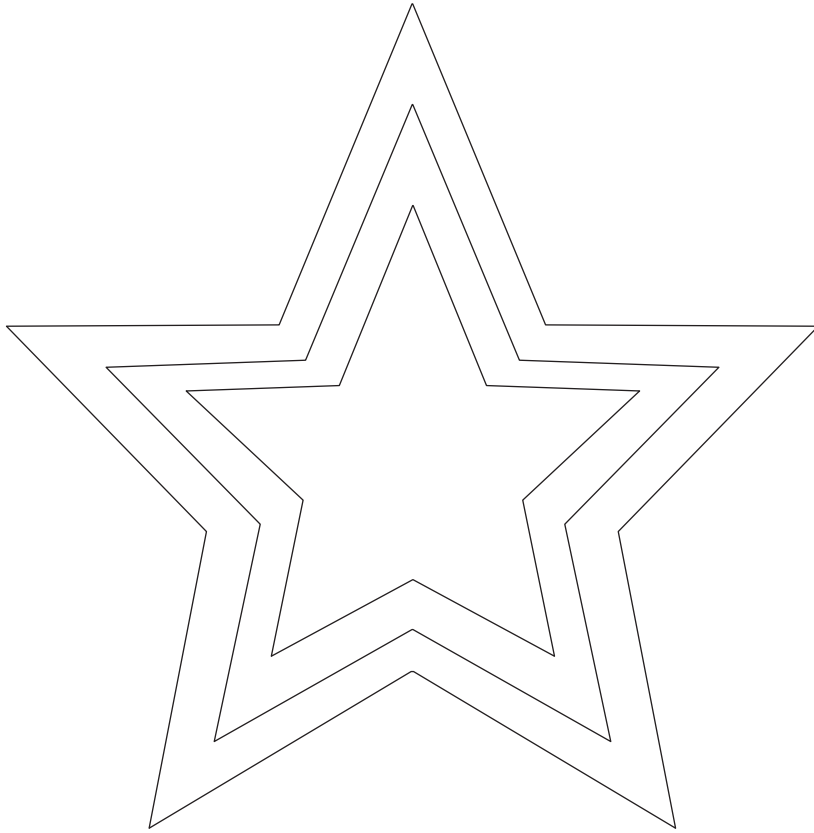
All seam allowances are $\frac{1}{4}$ " and pieces are sewn right sides together.

1. Sew together the four 2" x WOF C5527 Cream strips end to end using diagonal seams. Measure the length of the panel and cut two strips that measurement. Sew one to each side of the center panel.
2. Measure the width of the quilt top and cut two strips that length from the remaining C5527 Cream pieced strip. Sew one strip to the top and the other to the bottom of the quilt.
3. Repeat steps 1 and 2 using four 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF C1973 Yellow strips.
4. Repeat steps 1 and 2 using five 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF C5526 Smoke strips.
5. Trace two large, four medium, and six small stars, and one heart appliqué shape onto the paper side of the fusible web. Follow the manufacturer's instructions, fuse the stars to the wrong side of the remaining C1973 Yellow fabric and the heart to the C5530 Noir fabrics.
6. Cut out appliqués on the drawn lines and arrange in a pleasing arrangement on the quilt top outer borders. Fuse the appliqués in place, then stitch the outer edges in place using a straight, zigzag or decorative stitch.

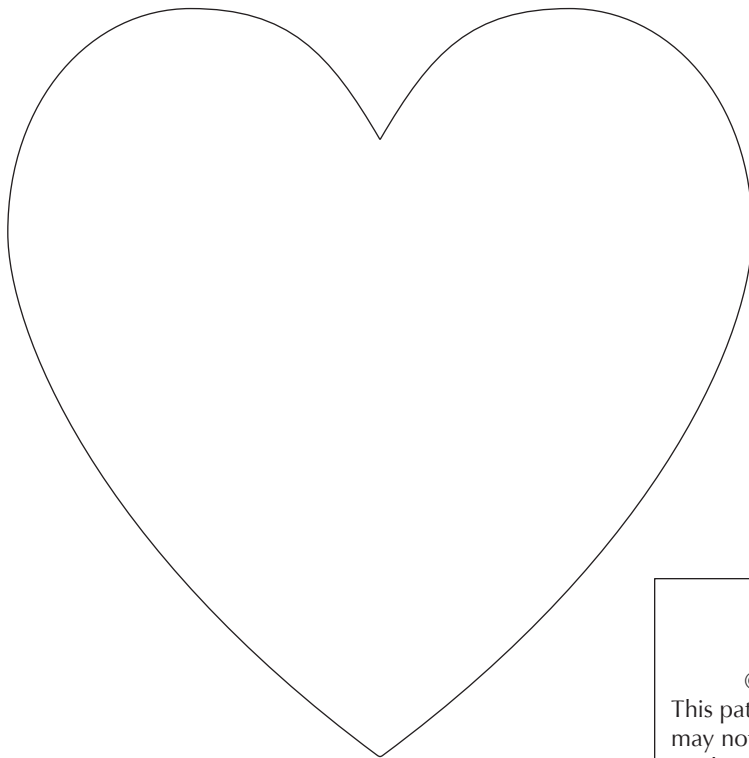
Finishing

7. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing, and quilt as desired.
8. Stitch the binding strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Fold and press the resulting long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together. Stitch to the quilt front, matching raw edges and mitering the corners.
9. Fold the binding to the quilt underside and hand-stitch the folded edge to the quilt back.
