





Quilt Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 24" Panel - Black (A), fussy cut:

• (1) 23 ½" x 43" panel.

From the Modern Melody - Black (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x 43" WOF strips (piece as needed)
- (2) 2 ¹/₂" x 26 ¹/₂" WOF strips.
- (3) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ¹/₂" x 55 ¹/₂" strips.
- (2) 1 ¹/₂" x 39 ¹/₂" WOF strips.
- (7) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Grave Stones - Black (C), cut:

• (16) Template 1's using the template provided.

From the Black Cats - Gray (D), cut:

• (32) Template 4's using the template provided.

From the Dancing Skeletons - Black (E), cut: • (8) Template 1's using the template provided.

From the Candy Corn - Black (F), cut:

• (8) Template 1's using the template provided.

From the Spiders and Webs - Orange (G), cut: • (16) Template 3's using the template provided.

From the Bats - Green (H), cut: • (8) Template 2's using the template provided.

From the Dots - Green (I), cut:

• (16) Template 2's using the template provided.

From the Spiders and Webs - Purple (J), cut:

• (16) Template 3's using the template provided.

From the Bats - Orange (K), cut:

• (8) Template 2's using the template provided.

From the Dots - Orange (L), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 57 ¹/₂" strips.
- (2) 2" x 42 ½" WOF strips.

From the Large Stripe - Black/Multi (M), cut:

- (2) 7 ¹/₂" x 78" LOF strips.
- (2) 7 ¹/₂" x 60" LOF strips.

From the Pumpkins - Black/Orange (Backing), cut:

• (2) 64" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 64" x 82" back.

Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) 2" x 43" Fabric B strip to each side of the 23 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 43" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 26 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure 25 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 45 $\frac{1}{2}$ " to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).

2. Place (1) Fabric C-Template 1 component on top of (1) Fabric I-Template 2 triangle, right sides together, aligning the left sides (Fig. 2). Sew the two components together along the left side. Press to the darker fabric to make (1) CI unit (Fig. 2).









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3. Place (1)

Fabric G-Template 3 triangle on top of (1) Fabric D-Template 4 component, right sides together, aligning the right sides (Fig. 3). Sew the (2) components together along the right side. Press to the darker fabric to make (1) DG unit (Fig. 3). Fig. 3



4. Sew (1) CI unit to the left side of (1) DG unit to make (1) Block One (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (16) Block Ones total.

5. Repeat Step 2 using (8) Fabric E-Template 1 components and (8) Fabric H-Template 2 components to make (8) EH units.

6. Repeat Step 3 using(8) Fabric D-Template 4components and (8)Fabric J-Template 3 componentsto make (8) JD units.

7. Sew (1) EH unit to the left side of (1) JD unit to make (1) Block Two (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (8) Block Twos total.

8. Repeat Step 2 using (8) Fabric F-Template 1 components and (8) Fabric K-Template 2 components to make (8) FK units.

9. Repeat Step 3 using(8) Fabric D-Template 4components and (8)Fabric J-Template 3 componentsto make (8) JD units.

10. Sew (1) FK unit to the left side of (1) JD unit to make (1) Block Three (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (8) Block Threes total.





Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

11. Sew (3) Block Twos, (4) Block Ones and (2) Block Threes together. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) strip to each side of the Center Block. Pay attention to the orientation and position of the blocks.

12. Sew (4) Block Ones, (2) Block Threes and (1) Block Two together. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block. Pay attention to the orientation and position of the blocks.

13. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 55 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 39 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

14. Sew (1) 2" x 57 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric L strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric L strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

15. Center (1) $7\frac{1}{2}$ " x 78" Fabric M strip on (1) side of the quilt top and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the top edge of the quilt top and stop a $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.


16. Repeat Step 15 to sew (1) 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 60" Fabric M strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top, making sure to stop and start $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each end of the quilt top. To miter each corner, fold the quilt top on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 7).

17. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 7), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a ¹/₄" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners.


18. Layer and quilt as desired.


19. Sew the (7) $2\frac{1}{2}$ x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

20. Bind as desired.



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
