Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted. Black Version fabrics are listed in () where different.

From the Harvest Gathering Panel - Cream (Harvest Gathering Panel - Black) (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 22 1/2" x 42 1/2" panel.

From the Folio - Red (B), cut:

- (2) 2 1/2" x 42 1/2" WOF strips, piece as needed.
- (2) 2 1/2" x 26 1/2" WOF strips.
- (2) 2 1/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (24) 2 1/8" squares.
- (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Paisley - Forest (C), cut:

- (3) 4 1/4" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 1/4" x 45" strips.
- (2) 4 1/4" x 33" WOF strips.

From the Folio - Gold (D), cut:

- (2) 2 1/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (24) 2 1/8" squares.

From the Harvest Blocks - Cream (E), fussy cut:

- (26) 5 5/8" blocks.

From the Leaves - Black (F), cut:

- (3) 5 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 1/2" x 65 1/2" strips.
- (3) 5 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 1/2" x 56" strips.

From the Folio - Off White (Folio - Black) (G), cut:

- (8) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (52) 1 1/2" x 5 5/8" strips.
- (11) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut strips into (52) 1 1/2" x 7 5/8" strips.
- (1) 3 3/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (16) 2 1/8" x 3 3/4" strips.
- (1) 2 1/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut strip into (16) 2 1/8" squares.

Sunflowers - Cream (Sunflowers - Black) (Backing), cut:

- (2) 64" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 64" x 83" back.

Sewing Instructions

1. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 42 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the 22 1/2" x 42 1/2" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 26 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure 25 1/2" x 45" to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).



2. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 5 5/8" Fabric G strip to each side of (1) 5 5/8"

Fabric E block. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 7 5/8" Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric E block. Trim the block to measure 7" square to make (1) Block One (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (26) Block Ones total.



3. Sew (2) 2 1/8" Fabric D squares and (2) 2 1/8" Fabric B squares together to make (1) Unit 1 block (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (4) Unit 1 blocks total.



4. Place (1) $2\frac{1}{8}$ " Fabric D square on the left side of (1) $2\frac{1}{8}$ " x $3\frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric G strip, right sides together (Fig. 4). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 4). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 5). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.



5. Place (1) $2\frac{1}{8}$ " Fabric B square on the right side of the $2\frac{1}{8}$ " x $3\frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric G strip, right sides together (Fig. 6). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 6). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 2 strip (Fig. 7).

6. Repeat Steps 4-5 to make (16) Unit 2 strips total.

7. Sew (1) Unit 2 strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 block. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{8}$ " Fabric G square to each end of (1) Unit 2 strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 block to make (1) Block Two (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (4) Block Twos. Pay attention to the orientation of the strips.



Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling.)

8. Sew (1) $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x 45" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x 33" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

9. Sew (8) Block Ones together. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) strip to each side of the Center Block.


10. Sew (5) Block Ones together. Sew (1) Block Two to each end of the strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

11. Sew (1) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $65\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x 56" Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

12. Layer and quilt as desired.

13. Sew the (7) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

14. Bind as desired.
